# **Big Carrot**

#### **MATERIALS**

2 skeins of Amigo Chunky color 45 1 skein of Amigo Chunky color 40 1 skein of Amigo Chunky color 28

Crochet hook 7 mm (US 10.5) Yarn needle Stuffing Stitch marker

# **YARN QUALITY**

**Amigo Chunky**, Hobbii 100% HB acrylic 100 g (3.5 oz) = 100 m (109 yds)

#### **GAUGE**

 $4" \times 4" (10 \times 10 \text{ cm}) = 11 \text{ stitches } \times 12 \text{ rows}$ 

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

ch = chain sc = single crochet flo = front loop only blo = back loop only inc = single crochet increase dec = single crochet decrease sl st = slip stitch

#### SIZE

One size

#### **MEASUREMENTS**

Height: Approx. 34" (86 cm)

#### **INFO AND TIPS**

This pattern is worked in the round, use a stitch marker to indicate the first sc of each round. I recommend you stuff as you go! Bold sections indicate the color of the stripes.

#### **CARROT**

Work with orange:

Rnd 1: 5 sc in mr (5)

Rnd 2: inc 1, sc 4 (6)

Rnd 3: inc 1, sc 5 (7)

Rnd 4: inc 1, sc 6 (8)

Rnd 5: inc 1, sc 7 (9)

Rnd 6: inc 1, sc 8 (10)

Rnd 7: inc 1, sc 1, Rust: sc 5, Orange: sc 3 (11) \*see instructions below on how to color change\*

Rnd 8: inc 1, sc 10 (12)

Rnd 9: inc 1, sc 11 (13)

Rnd 10; inc 1, sc 5, **R: sc 3**, O: sc 4 (14)

Rnd 11: inc 1, sc 13 (15)

Rnd 12: inc 1, sc 14 (16)

Rnd 13: inc 1, sc 7, **R: sc 7**, O: sc 1 (17)

Rnd 14: inc 1, sc 16 (18)

Rnd 15: inc 1, sc 17 (19)

Rnd 16: inc 1, sc 13, **R: sc 3**, O: sc 2 (20)

Rnd 17: inc 1, sc 19 (21)

Rnd 18: inc 1, sc 20 (22)

Rnd 19: inc 1, sc 13, **R: sc 8** (23)

Rnd 20: inc 1, sc 4, O: sc 18 (24)

Rnd 21: inc 1, sc 23 (25)

Rnd 22: inc 1, sc 20, **R: sc 4** (26)

Rnd 23: **inc 1, sc 1**, O: sc 24 (27)

Rnd 24: inc 1, sc 26 (28)

Rnd 25: inc 1, sc 22, **R: sc 5** (29)

Rnd 26: inc 1, sc 7, O: sc 21 (30)

Rnd 27: inc 1, sc 29 (31)

Rnd 28: inc 1, sc 22 R: sc 8 (32)

Rnd 29: inc 1, sc 15, O: sc 16 (33)

Rnd 30: inc 1, sc 32 (34)

Rnd 31: inc 1, sc 22, **R: sc 11** (35)

Rnd 32: inc 1, sc 16, O: sc 18 (36)

Rnd 33: inc 1, sc 35 (37)



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Rnd 34: inc 1, sc 29 R: sc 7 (38)
Rnd 35: inc 1, sc 14, O: sc 23 (39)
Rnd 36: inc 1, sc 38 (40)
Rnd 37: inc 1, sc 28, R: sc 11 (41)
Rnd 38: inc 1, sc 22, O: sc 18 (42)
Rnd 39: inc 1, sc 41 (43)
Rnd 40: inc 1, sc 37, R: sc 5 (44)
Rnd 41: inc 1, sc 19, O: sc 24 (45)
Rnd 42: inc 1, sc 44 (46)

Rnd 59: inc 1, sc 44, O: sc 17 (63)
Rnd 60: inc 1, sc 62 (64)
Rnd 61: inc 1, sc 56 R: sc 7 (65)
Rnd 62: inc 1, sc 50, O: sc 14 (66)
Rnd 63: inc 1, sc 65 (67)
Rnd 64: sc around (67)
Rnd 65: sc 7, R: sc 42, O: sc 18 (67)
Rnd 66: sc around (67)
Rnd 67: (sc 10, dec 1) x5, sc 7 (62)
Rnd 68: R:(sc 8, dec 1) x5, O: sc 8, dec 1, sc 2 (56)
Rnd 69: sc around (56)
Rnd 70: sc 54, R: sc 2 (56)
Rnd 71: (sc 5, dec 1) x7, O: sc 5, dec 1 (48)
Rnd 72: (sc 4, dec 1) x8 (40)
Rnd 73: (sc 3, dec 1) x8 (32)
Stuff
Rnd 74: (sc 2, dec 1) x8 (24)
Rnd 75: R:(sc 1, dec 1) x8 (16)
Rnd 76: GREEN: dec in each around (8)
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Rnd 77: **Leaf A.):** flo sc 1, ch 40, in the second ch from the hook \* sl st and ch 7, starting from the second ch from the hook sl st 6\* Repeat \* to \* 18 more times (total of 19 leaves), sl st in the remaining 20 chains, sl st flo in the next stitch, (*If your leaves are not curling, size down a hook size or two*)

**Leaf B.)** flo sc 1, ch 30, in the second ch from the hook \* sl st and ch 7, starting from the second ch from the hook sl st 6\* Repeat \* to \* 13 more times (total of 14 leaves), sl st in the remaining 15 chs, sl st flo in the next stitch

# Repeat Leaf A.) and B.) one more time each,

Rnd: 79: In the first stitch, flo sc 1, ch 40, in the second ch from the hook \* sl st and ch 7, starting from the second ch from the hook sl st 6\* Repeat \* to \* 18 more times, sl st in the remaining 20 chs, now we are done with the crocheting part, leave a long tail for sewing \*see instructions below\*

# How to color change



1. In your last sc of orange, yarn over and pull 2. Add your new color through





3. Pull the yarn through and continue crocheting in the new color

# Round 77 Leaf A.)



1. Leaf A.) Flo sc 1, ch 40



2. In the second ch from the hook, sl st and ch 7





3. starting from the second ch from the hook sl st 6



4. SI st in the next ch, ch 7, starting from the second ch from the hook sI st 6



5. repeat step #8 18 more times (total of 19 leaves) and sl st in the remaining 20 chs



6. SI st flo in the next stitch, (then start leaf B)

# Round 79, The last leaf



1. In the first stitch, flo sc 1, ch 40, in the second ch from the hook \* sl st and ch 7, starting from the second ch from the hook sl st 6\* Repeat \* to \* 19 times, sl st in the remaining chs,



2. Leave a 16 inch tail and thread it through a needle. Insert your needle in the blo directly across from the stitch marker, this will bring the last leaf to the center of the leaf cluster.





3. This is what it should look like when you pull on the tail



4. Insert your needle 2 stitches over



5. Insert your needle through the bottom of the last leaf and into the stitch directly behind it, this will keep the leaf centered



6. Continue sewing around into the blo stitches to close up any gaps, exit out the side and weave in the end. Tada!
