



CROCHET PATTERN

Candy Stripes

Baby Cowl

MATERIALS

1 skeins of Rainbow Cotton 8/4, Olive (072)
1 skeins of Rainbow Cotton 8/4, Petrol Blue (035)

Crochet hook 2,5 mm

YARN QUALITY

 **Rainbow Cotton 8/4**, Hobbii
100 % Cotton
50 g (1.75 oz) = 170 m (186 yds)

GAUGE

Ribbing worked in sc through back loop only:
10 x 10 cm (4 x 4 inches) = 35 sc x 48 rows

When stretched the number of rows on 10 cm (4 inches) will be approx. 30 rows.

ABBREVIATIONS

Sc = single crochet
Sl st = slip stitch
Ch = chain

SIZE

6-12 months (1-2 years)

MEASUREMENTS

Length: 13 (15) cm/ 5 (6) inches

PATTERN INFORMATION

Candy Stripes is a cowl with vertical stripes made in cotton which makes it perfect for spring and chilly summer evenings. It is worked with a tight ribbing around the neck and a wider ribbing along the yoke, which gives it an interesting structure and a very aesthetic look. So cute you could just eat it up.

The neck is high and can be folded according to preferences.

TIPS AND INFO

Unless otherwise instructed all rows will end with a ch-1 turning chain.

COWL

Start with Olive (072). Ch 38 (46) + ch-1 turning chain.

Row 1: Work 14 (18) sc followed by 24 (28) sl st (38 (46) sts).

Row 2: Work 24 (28) sl sts through back loop only, work 14 (18) sc through back loop only.

After row 6, change to Petrol Blue (035), you will keep alternating between the two colors every 6 rows throughout.

The remaining rows will be worked the same as row 1-2 until you have a total of 132 (144) rows.

FINISHING

Fold the work so that the last row is aligned with the first row and sc them together with right side facing up.
