### MATERIALS

1 skein of Rainbow Cotton 8/4, Red (058) 1 skein of Rainbow Cotton 8/4, Ochre Yellow (082)

Crochet hook 2,5 mm

# **YARN QUALITY**

Rainbow Cotton 8/4, Hobbii
100 % Cotton
50 g (1.75 oz) = 170 m (186 yds)

# GAUGE

Worked in sc through back loop only:  $10 \times 10 \text{ cm} (4 \times 4 \text{ inches}) = 25 \text{ sc} \times 28 \text{ rows}$ 

# **ABBREVIATIONS**

Sc = single crochet Sl st = slip stitch Ch = chain Tbl = through back loop

#### SIZE

3-6 months (6-12 months) 1-2 years

#### **MEASUREMENTS**

Length: approx. 16 (18) 20 cm/6.3 (7.1) 7.8 inches Width: approx. 15 (17) 19 cm/6 (6.7) 7.5 inches

# **PATTERN INFORMATION**

Candy Stripes baby bonnet is a sweet little bonnet worked in cotton, making it perfect for the springtime or chilly summer evenings. It is worked in ribbing, giving it an interesting surface structure and a delicious and aesthetic look. So cute you could just eat it up.

# **TIPS AND INFO**

The Candy Stripes bonnet is worked in one piece, shaping the bonnet, while the ribbing and tie strings are worked separately and then joined.

Unless otherwise instructed all rows will end with a ch-1 turning chain.

#### BONNET

Start with Red (058). Ch 70 (80) 90 + ch-1 turning chain.

Row 1-5: sc tbl in each ch until end of row (70 (80) 90 sts).

Chance color to Ochre Yellow (082), keep alternating between the two colors every 5 rows throughout.

Work in sc tbl until you have a total of 35 (40) 45 rows. Fasten off and cut yarn.

Fold the piece in half along the longer side, aligning half the starting chain with the other half, now crochet them together by working 35 (40) 45 scs through both layers. This will be the back of the head on the bonnet.

#### RIBBING

All ribbing edges will be worked in Ochre Yellow (082).

#### **Ribbing 1**

Ch 1 + ch-1 turning chain (6 sts). Row 1: Work 1 sc in each st across (6 sts) Continue working sc tbl across all sts until you have 70 (80) 90 rows.

#### **Ribbing 2**

Ch 1 + ch-1 turning chain (6 sts). Row 1: Work 1 sc in each st across (6 sts). Continue working sc tbl across all sts until you have 82 (92) 102 rows.

#### **TIE STRINGS**

Ochre Yellow (082).

Ch 45 (45) 50 + ch-1 turning chain.



Row 1-3: Sc in each st across (45 (45) 50 sts). Fasten off and cut yarn, leaving a tail long enough for joining.

# JOINING

Place ribbing 1 along the lower edge of the bonnet with right sides facing, it will lie horizontal to the vertical stripes. Now, working from the wrong side, join ribbing 1 to the bonnet with 1 sc in each row.

Now place ribbing 2 along the front edge of the bonnet, pointing the same direction as the stripes on the bonnet. With wrong side facing, join ribbing 2 to the bonnet by working 1 sc into every row on the ribbing and through every st of the bonnet.

The tie strings will be attached end to end with ribbing 2, pointing vertically downwards same direction as the stripes. Sew or crochet them in with wrong side facing.
