The Pumpkin Dress

MATERIALS

1 (2) 2 (2) 2 (2) skein(s) of Unicorn Solid col Saffron (18)

1 (1) 1 (1) 1 (1) skein of Unicorn Solid col Army Green (25)

Circular needle 3 mm (US 2.5) - 40 cm (16") and 60 cm (24")

Circular needle 2.5 mm (US 1.5) - 40 cm (16") or 60 cm (24")

DPN 3 mm (US 2.5)

DPN 2.5 mm (US 1.5)

YARN QUALITY

 **Unicorn Solid**, Hobbii

75 % Merino Wool, 25 % Polyamide

100 g (3.5 oz) = 400 m (437 yds)

GAUGE

28 sts x 40 rows = 10 cm (4")

ABBREVIATIONS

st(s) = stitch(es)

k = knit

p = purl

tbl = through the back loop

rnd(s) = round(s)

yo(s) = yarnover(s)

sl1k = slip 1 stitch knitwise

k2tog = knit 2 stitches together

SIZES

0-3 months (3-6 months) 6-9 months (9-12 months) 1-2 years (2-4 years)

MEASUREMENTS

Bust circumference (sweater): Approx. 48.5 (51.5) 54 (57) 60 (63) cm / 19.1" (20.3") 21.3" (22.4") 23.6" (24.8")

Length (without the green part of the neckline): Approx. 34 (36) 38 (40) 43 (48) cm / 13.4" (14.2") 15" (15.7") 16.9" (18.9")

Sleeve length: Approx. 14 (16) 18 (21) 24 (26) cm / 5.5" (6.3") 7.1" (8.3") 9.4" (10.2")

ABOUT THE PATTERN

The dress is worked top down in rib pattern, resulting in a pumpkin-like look. The edges of the dress are worked in 1x1 rib, and the neckline (the pumpkin's stalk) is worked in green. The dress is fairly simple to knit.

INFORMATION AND TIPS

The Pumpkin Dress is worked top down in rib pattern. Increases and decreases are worked to shape the dress. The edge of the dress are worked in 1x1 rib, and the neckline is worked in green to resemble the stalk on a pumpkin.

YOKE

Co 84 (90) 96 (102) 108 (116) sts with the green yarn and DPN 2.5 mm (US 1.5). Repeat *k1, p1 to the end of the rnd and place a sm at the BOR (midway on the back). Work 2.5 cm (1") of rib pattern (k1, p1). The neckline is now finished.

On the next rnd, increase 24 (22) 28 (26) 24 (28) sts evenly on the rnd by means of yos = 108 (112) 124 (128) 132 (144) sts.

Change to the orange yarn and needle 3 mm (US 2.5) - 40 cm (16"). The rnds are counted from here.

On this rnd, alternate between k2, p2 and work the yos by means of k tbl or p tbl depending on the rib pattern.

Then work another 3 (3) 3 (5) 5 (5) rnds in rib pattern (k2, p2).

Now increases are worked over 4 rnds on the yoke. Change to circular needle 3 mm (US 2.5) - 60 cm (24") to accommodate the growing number of sts.

Increase rnd 1:

On the 5th (5th) 5th (7th) 7th (7th) rnd, increase like this: *K1, yo, k1, p2, repeat from * to end. On the next rnd, the yos are k tbl, and the remaining sts are worked in rib pattern as established like this: *K1, k1tbl, k1, p2, repeat from * to end.

Work the following 6 (6) 7 (7) 7 (8) rnds as established.

Increase rnd 2:

On the 13th (13th) 14th (16th) 16th (17th) rnd, increase like this: *K2, yo, k1, p2, repeat from * to end. On the next rnd, the yos are k tbl, and the remaining sts are worked in rib pattern as established like this: *K2, k1tbl, k1, p2, repeat from * to end.

Work the following 8 (9) 9 (9) 10 (10) rnds as established.

Increase rnd 3:

On the 23rd (23rd) 25th (27th) 28th (29th) rnd, increase like this: *K2, yo, k2, p2, repeat from * to end. On the next rnd, the yos are k tbl and the remaining sts are worked in rib pattern as established like this: *K2, k1tbl, k2, p2, repeat from * to end.

Work the following 8 (9) 9 (9) 10 (10) rnds as established.

Increase rnd 4:

On the 33rd (35th) 36th (38th) 40th (41st) rnd, increase like this: *K2, yo, k3, p2, repeat from * to end. On the next rnd, the yos are k tbl and the remaining sts are worked in rib pattern as established like this: *K2, k1tbl, k3, p2, repeat from * to end.

Work the following 8 (8) 9 (9) 9 (10) rnds as established.

DIVIDING THE WORK INTO BODY AND SLEEVES

You now have 216 (224) 248 (256) 264 (288) sts on the needle, and the work is to be divided into body and sleeves like this:

Work 30 (32) 34 (36) 38 (40) sts in rib pattern (= first half of the back piece), put 48 (48) 56 (56) 56 (64) sts on hold (= sleeve), co 8 new sts using the backward loop or the knitted cast on technique, work 60 (64) 68 (72) 76 (80) sts in rib pattern (= front piece), put 48 (48) 56 (56) 56 (64) sts on hold (= sleeve), co 8 new sts using the backward loop or the knitted cast on technique, work 30 (32) 34 (36) 38 (40) sts in rib pattern (second half of the back piece).

BODY AND SKIRT

There are now 136 (144) 152 (160) 168 (176) sts on the needle. The rnds and measurements are counted/taken from here.

Work 4 (4) 6 (6) 6 (6) rnds as established while fitting the 8 new sts below each sleeve into the rib pattern. 3 increase rnds are worked followed by 1 decrease rnd at the bottom of the dress.

Increase rnd 1:

On the 5th (5th) 7th (7th) 7th (7th) rnd after dividing the work into body and sleeves, increase like this: *K3, yo, k3, p2, repeat from * to end. On the next rnd, the yos are k tbl, and remaining sts are worked as established.

Work until the work measures 5 (6) 6 (6) 7 (7) cm / 2" (2.4") 2.4" (2.4") 2.8" (2.8") from the place where the work was divided into body and sleeves. Increase again on the next rnd.

Increase rnd 2:

Increase like this: *K3, yo, k4, p2, repeat from * to end. On the next rnd, the yos are k tbl, and remaining sts are worked as established.

Work until the work measures 10 (11) 12 (13) 14 (16) cm. / 3.9" (4.3") 4.7" (5.1") 5.5" (6.3") from the place where the work was divided into body and sleeves. Increase again on the next rnd.

Increase rnd 3:

Increase like this: *K4, yo, k4, p2, repeat from * to end. On the next rnd, the yos are k tbl, and remaining sts are worked as established.

Work until the work measures 15 (16) 17 (19) 20 (23) cm. / 5.9" (6.3") 6.7" (7.5") 7.9" (9.1") from the place where the work was divided into body and sleeves. **Decrease** on the next rnd.

Decrease rnd

Decrease like this: *K4, k2tog, k3, p2, repeat from * to end. Work the next rnd as established.

Continue like this until the dress **reaches a total length from top to bottom (without the green part of the neckline)** of 31 (33) 35 (37) 40 (45) cm / 12.2" (13") 13.8" (14.6") 15.7" (17.7"). On the next rnd, begin to work the bottom ribbing of the dress.

Ribbing

There are now 170 (180) 190 (200) 210 (220) sts on the needle. Change to circular needle 2.5 mm (US 1.5) and work 1x1 rib (k1, p1) to end. Work 3 cm (1.2") like this and bo as established.

SLEEVES

Place the 48 (48) 56 (56) 56 (64) sts of the first sleeve on DPN 3 mm (US 2.5). Pick up sts in the 8 new sts below the sleeve. Fit these sts into the rib pattern of the sleeve. You now have 56 (56) 64 (64) 64 (72) sts.

Work in rib pattern as established until the sleeve measures 11 (13) 15 (18) 21 (23) cm / 4.3" (5.1") 5.9" (7.1") 8.3" (9.1") **while** decreasing every 1.5 (1.5) 1.5 (2) 2.5 (2.5) cm / 0.6" (0.6") 0.6" (0.8") 1" (1"). The first decrease rnd is the third rnd of the sleeve. Decrease like this: K2tog at the beginning of the rnd, k2tog tbl (or sl1k, k1, pass over the loose st) at the end of the rnd. Work a total of 7 (7) 8 (8) 8 (9) decrease rnds, resulting in 42 (42) 48 (48) 48 (54) sts on the rnd.

When the sleeve measures 11 (13) 15 (18) 21 (23) cm / 4.3" (5.1") 5.9" (7.1") 8.3" (9.1"), decrease 6 (4) 8 (6) 4 (8) sts evenly on the rnd by k2tog. The rest of the rnd is worked as established. You now have 36 (38) 40 (42) 44 (46) sts on the rnd.

Work 3 cm (1.2") in 1x1 rib (k1, p1) and bo as established.
Work the second sleeve following the same procedure.

FINISHING

Weave in the ends and sew the dress together below the sleeves. Wash the dress and block it into shape. Place it under gentle pressure and let it dry flat. The dress is now finished and ready to be used.
