Pansy Flower

MATERIALS

1 skein of Rainbow Cotton 8/4 color 82
1 skein of Rainbow Cotton 8/4 color 67
1 skein of Rainbow Cotton 8/4 color 39
1 skein of Rainbow Cotton 8/4 color 01
1 skein of Rainbow Cotton 8/4 color 84

Crochet hook 2,5 mm
Scissors
Tapestry needle
Sewing thread and needle (for 2 stitches)
Wire cable 2 mm × 5 m/ 0.03 inch x 5.46 yrd
(30 à 35 cm/ 11.82 to 13.78 inch)
1 glue stick
1 glue gun

YARN QUALITY

 **Rainbow Cotton 8/4**, Hobbii
100% Cotton
50 g/1.75 oz = 170 m/186 yds

ABBREVIATIONS

sc = single crochet
st(s) = stitch(es)
ch = chain
sl st = slip stitch
R = row
inc = increase
() = total number of stitches
/ = repeat

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Diameter approx. 9 cm/3.55 inch

PATTERN INFORMATION

This pattern is seamless. It is important to read the notes carefully, before making the petals. This flower can be used as a table decoration. You can also make an eternal bouquet to offer or keep it.

HEART OF THE FLOWER

In Rainbow Cotton 8/4 color 82 Ochre Yellow

R 1 : 10 sc in a magic ring, 1 sl st to join the round.
Fasten off and weave in ends.

PETALE 1

In Rainbow Cotton 8/4 color 67 Baby Purple

Work flat.

R 1 : 5 sc in the back loop of the heart of the flower (loops outside of the work) + ch 1 to turn
R 2 : 5 inc (10 sts) + ch 1 to turn
R 3 : 10 inc (20 sts) + ch 1 to turn
R 4 : *1 sc, 1 inc* 10 times (30 sts) + ch 1 to turn
R 5 to 11 : 7 rows with 30 sc (30 sts) + ch 1 in each end of each row (except for row 11)

At the end of row 11, continue to work sc in the side of the petal (10 sc) then 5 sc in the back of the loop of the heart of the flower, 10 sc on the second side of the petal **see images 1, 2, 3 and 4.**

1 sl st, Fasten off and weave in ends.

PETALES 2 and 3

In Rainbow Cotton 8/4 color 39 Purple

Work flat.

Note: Start row 1 in the front loops of the heart of the flower, on the side, leaving 3 front loops free in the middle of petal 1. Petal 2 will be on the right and petal 3 on the left.

R 1 : 2 sc in the front loops (loops inside the work) of the heart of the flower on the side **see image 5 below** + ch 1 to turn

R 2 : 2 inc (4 sts) + ch 1 to turn

R 3 : 4 sc (4 sts) + ch 1 to turn

R 4 : 1 inc, 2 sc, 1 inc (6 sts) + ch 1 to turn

Change yarn for Rainbow Cotton 8/4 color 001 White (cut the yarn color 39 and weave it in ends)

R 5 : 1 inc, 4 sc, 1 inc (8 sts) + ch 1 to turn

R 6 : 8 sc (8 sts) + ch 1 to turn

R 7 : 3 sc, 2 inc, 3 sc (10 sts) + ch 1 to turn

R 8 : 4 sc, 2 inc, 4 sc (12 sts) + ch 1 to turn

R 9 : *2 sc, 2 inc* 3 times (18 sts) + ch 1 to turn

R 10 to 11 : 2 rows with 18 sc (18 sts) + ch 1 to turn (except for row 11)

1 sl st, cut the yarn and weave in ends.



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What it looks like with petals 2 and 3

PETALE 4

In Rainbow Cotton 8/4 color 39 Purple

Work flat.

Note: Before beginning, hold the work leaving the empty heart of its 4th petal facing you.

R 1 : 5 sc in the front loops of the heart of the flower (1 sc in the front loop used for row 1 from petal 3, 3 loops remains empty, 1 sc in the front loops used for petal 2 = 5 sc in total)

see images below 6 and 7 + ch 1 to turn

R 2 : 5 inc (10 sts) + ch 1 to turn

R 3 : 1 inc, *2 sc, 1 inc* from * to * 3 times (14 sts) + ch 1 to turn

R 4 : 5 sc, 3 inc, 6 sc (17 sts) + ch 1 to turn

R 5 : 7 sc, 3 inc, 7 sc (20 sts) + ch 1 to turn

Change yarn for Rainbow Cotton 8/4 color 001 White (cut the yarn color 39 and weave in ends)

R 6 : 20 sc (20 sts) + ch 1 to turn

R 7 : *1 sc, 1 inc* 10 times (30 sts) + ch 1 to turn

R 8 : 30 sc (30 sts) + ch 1 to turn

R 9 : *2 sc, 1 inc* 10 times (40 sts) + ch 1 to turn

R 10 to 11 : 2 rows with 40 sc (40 sts) + ch 1 to turn (except for row 11)

1 sl st, cut the yarn and weave in ends.



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FINISHING

Weave in all ends.

Make a small stitch between petal 2 and petal 1, so that the petals do not fall when the flower is vertical. Do the same for petal 3.

For the stem: Cut a cable length of about 30 to 35 cm/ 11.82 to 13.78 inch.

Take your glue stick and put it along the length of the cable.

Wrap the entire cable with Rainbow Cotton 8/4 color 84 Green.

Using the glue gun, glue one end of the stem behind the heart of the flower.

Let it dry, and repeat to make other flowers to get a beautiful eternal bouquet.
