# Design: Pop Culture Crochet | Hobbii Design 

## MATERIALS

5 (6) $6(7) 8$ skeins of Fluffy Day colour 11

Crochet hook 5 mm (US H/8)
Yarn needle

## YARN QUALITY

(4) Fluffy Day, Hobbii

100\% acrylic
100 g / 3.8 oz. $=285 \mathrm{~m} / 312 \mathrm{yds}$

## GAUGE

$10 \mathrm{~cm} \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}\left(4^{\prime \prime} \times 4\right.$ " $)=13$ sts $\times 15$ rounds of single crochet with a 5 mm hook

## ABBREVIATIONS

** $=$ repeat
St = stitch
ch = chain
ss = slip stitch
sc = single crochet
hdc = half double crochet
sc2tog = single crochet two together sc3tog = single crochet three together blo = back loop only
flo = front loop only bobble = *yarn over, insert hook into stitch, and pull up a loop. Yarn over and pull through the first two loops on the hook* six times, then yarn over and pull through all seven loops on the hook

## INFO AND TIPS

The cardigan is constructed of granny squares that are joined together before ribbing is added. Make sure to "pop out" the bobbles. This can be done by pulling them slightly so that they face the right side.

## GRANNY SQUARES (MAKE 62)

Round 1: Ch 12 (14) 16 (18) 20, turn. Beginning in the $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from the hook, sc in each ch across. (11 (13) 15 (17) 19 sts
Round 2: Ch 1, turn. Sc in each st across. (11 (13) 15 (17) 19 sts)
Repeat previous round 0 (1) 2 (3) 4 times
Round 3 (4) 5 (6) 7: Ch 1, turn. Sc in 5 (6) 7 (8) 9 sts. Bobble. Sc in 5 (6) 7 (8) 9 sts. (11 (13) 15 (17) 19 sts)

Round 4 (5) 6 (7) 8: Ch 1, turn. Sc in each st across. (11 (13) 15 (17) 19 sts)
Round 5 (6) 7 (8) 9: Ch 1, turn. Sc in 3 (4) 5 (6) 7 sts. *Bobble, sc,* x 2, bobble. Sc in 3 (4) 5 (6) 7 sts. 11 (13) 15 (17) 19 sts)
Round 6 (7) 8 (9) 10: Ch 1, turn. Sc in each st across. (11 (13) 15 (17) 19 sts)
Round 7 (8) 9 (10) 11: Ch 1, turn. Sc 1 (2) 3 (4) 5. *Bobble, sc* x 4. Bobble, sc 1 (2) 3 (4) 5. (11 (13) 15 (17) 19 sts)

Round 8 (9) 10 (11) 12: Ch 1, turn. Sc in each st across. (11 (13) 15 (17) 19 sts)
Round 9 (10) 11 (12) 13: Ch 1, turn. Sc in 3 (4) 5 (6) 7 sts. *Bobble, sc,* $\times 2$, bobble. Sc in 3 (4) 5 (6) 7 sts. (11 (13) 15 (17) 19 sts)
Round 10 (11) 12 (13) 14: Ch 1, turn. Sc in each st across. (11 (13) 15 (17) 19 sts)
Round 11 (12) 13 (14) 15: Ch 1, turn. Sc in 5 (6) 7 (8) 9 sts. Bobble. Sc in 5 (6) 7 (8) 9 sts. (11 (13) 15 (17) 19 sts)

Round 12 (13) 14 (15) 16: Ch 1, turn. Sc in each st across. (11 (13) 15 (17) 19 sts)

Repeat previous round 0 (1) 2 (3) 4 times
Round 13 (15) 17 (19) 21 : Ch 1, turn. Sc in each st across. To finish off the square, *ch 2, rotate the piece $90^{\circ}$ and work 11 (13) 15 (17) 19 sc along the edge* a total of 3 times along each of the two sides and the bottom. Ss into the first stitch of Round 13 and fasten off.

## RIGHT HALF SQUARE (make 1)

Round 1: Ch 12 (14) 16 (18) 20, turn. Beginning in the $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from the hook, sc in each ch across. (11 (13) 15 (17) 19 sts)
Round 2: Ch 1, turn. Sc in each st across until last 2 sts. Sc2tog. (10 (12) 14 (16) 18 sts)
For size XS : skip next section and proceed directly to round 3 as listed for this size.
For sizes (S), M, (L), XL:
Round (3) 3 (3) 3: Ch 1, turn. Sc2tog, sc in remaining sts across. ((11) 13 (15) 17 sts)
For sizes $\mathbf{M}, \mathbf{( L ) , ~ X L : ~}$
Round 4 (4) 4: Ch 1, turn. Sc in each st across until last 2 sts. Sc2tog. (12 (14) 16 sts)
For sizes (L), XL:
Round (5) 5: Ch 1, turn. Sc2tog, sc in remaining sts across. ((13) 15 sts)
For size XL:
Round 6: Ch 1, turn. Sc in each st across until last 2 sts. Sc2tog. (14 sts)
You should have (10 (11) 12 (13) 14 sts)

## All sizes:

Round 3 (4) 5 (6) 7: Ch 1, turn. Sc2tog. Sc 2. Bobble. Sc 5 (6) 7 (8) 9. (9 (10) 11 (12) 13 sts)
Round 4 (5) 6 (7) 8: Ch 1, turn. Sc in each st across until last 2 sts. Sc2tog. (8 (9) 10 (11) 12 sts)
Round 5 (6) 7 (8) 9: Ch 1, turn. Sc2tog. Bobble, sc, bobble. Sc 3 (4) 5 (6) 7. (7 (8) 9 (10) 11 sts)
Round 6 (7) 8 (9) 10: Ch 1, turn. Sc in each st across until last 2 sts. Sc2tog. (6 (7) 8 (9) 10 sts)
Round 7 (8) 9 (10) 11: Ch 1, turn. Sc2tog. Bobble, sc, bobble, sc 1 (2) 3 (4) 5. (5 (6) 7 (8) 9 sts)
Round 8 (9) 10 (11) 12: Ch 1, turn. Sc in each st across until last 2 sts. Sc2tog. (4 (5) 6 (7) 8 sts)
Round 9 (10) 11 (12) 13: Ch 1, turn. Sc2tog, sc in remaining sts across. (3 (4) 5 (6) 7 sts)
Round 10 (11) 12 (13) 14: Ch 1, turn. Sc in each st until last 2 sts. Sc2tog. (2 (3) 4 (5) 6 sts)
For size XS : skip next section and proceed directly to round 11 as listed for this size.
For sizes (S), M, (L), XL:
Round (12) 13 (14) 15: Ch 1, turn. Sc2tog, sc in remaining sts across. ((2) 3 (4) 5 sts)
For sizes M, (L), XL:
Round 14 (15) 16: Ch 1, turn. Sc in each st across until last 2 sts. Sc2tog. (2 (3) 4 sts)
For sizes (L), XL:
Round (16) 17: Ch 1, turn. Sc2tog, sc in remaining sts across. ((2) 3 sts)
For size XL:
Round 18: Ch 1, turn. Sc in each st across until last 2 sts. Sc2tog. (2 sts)
You should have 2 sts left for all sizes.
Row 11 (13) 15 (17) 19: Ch 1, turn. Dec. To finish off the square, *ch 2, rotate the piece $90^{\circ}$ and work 11 (13) 15 (17) 19 sc along the edge* a total of 3 times along each of the two sides and the bottom. Ss into the first stitch of Round 11 (13) 15 (17) 19and fasten off.

## LEFT HALF SQUARES (make 1)

Round 1: Ch 12 (14) 16 (18) 20, turn. Beginning in the $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from the hook, sc in each ch across. (11 (13) 15 (17) 19 sts)
Round 2: Ch 1, turn. Sc2tog. Sc in remaining sts across. (10 (12) 14 (16) 18 sts)
For size XS : skip next section and proceed directly to round 3 as listed for this size.
For sizes (S), M, (L), XL:
Round (3) 3 (3) 3: Ch 1, turn. Sc in each st until last 2 sts. Sc2tog. ((11) 13 (15) 17 sts)
For sizes M, (L), XL:
Round 4 (4) 4: Ch 1, turn. Sc2tog, sc in remaining sts across. (12 (14) 16 sts)
For sizes (L), XL:
Round (5) 5: Ch 1, turn. Sc in each st until last 2 sts. ((13) 15 sts)
For size XL:
Round 6: Ch 1, turn. Sc2tog. Sc in each remaining . (14 sts)
You should have (10 (11) 12 (13) 14 sts)

Round 3 (4) 5 (6) 7: Ch 1, turn. Sc 5 (6) 7 (8) 9. Bobble. Sc 2. Sc2tog. (9 (10) 11 (12) 13 sts)
Round 4 (5) 6 (7) 8: Ch 1, turn. Sc2tog. Sc in remaining sts across. (8 (9) 10 (11) 12sts)
Round 5 (6) 7 (8) 9: Ch 1, turn. Sc 3 (4) 5 (6) 7. Bobble, sc, bobble. Sc2tog. (7 (8) 9 (10) 11 sts)
Round 6 (7) 8 (9) 10: Ch 1, turn. Sc2tog. Sc in remaining sts across. (6 (7) 8 (9) 10 sts)
Round 7 (8) 9 (10) 11: Ch 1, turn. Sc 1 (2) 3 (4) 5. Bobble, sc, bobble. Sc2tog. (5 (6) 7 (8) 9 sts)
Round 8 (9) 10 (11) 12: Ch 1, turn. Sc2tog. Sc in remaining sts across. (4 (5) 6 (7) 8 sts)
Round 9 (10) 11 (12) 13 : Ch 1, turn. Sc 2 (3) 4 (5) 6, sc2tog. (3 (4) 5 (6) 7 sts)
Round 10 (11) 12 (13) 14: Ch 1, turn. Sc2tog. sc in remaining sts across. (2 (3) 4 (5) 6 sts)
For size XS : skip next section and proceed directly to round 11 as listed for this size.
For sizes (S), M, (L), XL:
Round (12) 13 (14) 15: Ch 1, turn. Sc in each st across until last 2 sts. Sc2tog. ((2) 3 (4) 5 sts)
For sizes M, (L), XL:
Round 14 (15) 16: Ch 1, turn. Sc2tog, sc in remaining sts across. (2 (3) 4 sts)
For sizes (L), XL:
Round (16) 17: Ch 1, turn. Sc in each st across until last 2 sts. Sc2tog. ((2) 3 sts)
For size XL:
Round 18: Ch 1, turn. Sc in each st across until last 2 sts. Sc2tog. (2 sts)
You should have 2 sts left for all sizes.

Row 11 (13) 15 (17) 19: Ch 1, turn. Dec. To finish off the square, *ch 2, rotate the piece $90^{\circ}$ and work 11 (13) 15 (17) 19 sc along the edge* a total of 3 times along each of the two sides and the bottom. Ss into the first stitch of Round 11 (13) 15 (17) 19 and fasten off.

## ASSEMBLY

To join granny squares, line up edges with wrong sides facing out. Attach yarn to corner ch. Ch 1, Sc in flo of front piece and blo of back piece across. Make sure to work in one of the chs from each corner. (11 (13) 15 (17) 19 sts)

Granny squares should be attached in the following format as one flat panel:


Do not join squares along the red line. The triangles represent the half granny squares. Once you have created the panel, fold along the black line and join along the green lines (make sure the wrong side is facing out).

## RIBBING

## Wrist Cuffs

Make sure that the right side of the piece is facing out.
Join yarn to any part of the wrist.
Ch 1, sc3tog in blo in each st and ch around (as well as in the side spaces created by the joined granny squares). Ss to first st of row.
The next part of the ribbing is worked in vertical rows.
Row 1: Ch 11, turn. Beginning in the $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from the hook, hdc in each ch. Ss to the st at the base of the chs, ss in next st. (10 sts)
*Round 2: Turn, skip over the 2 ss, and hdc in the third loop only across. (10 sts) Round 3: Ch 1, turn. Hdc in the third loop only across. Ss in next 2 sts. ( 10 sts )* Repeat rounds 2-3 until ribbing goes all the way around the wrist.
To finish off, ch 1, turn. Hdc together the third loop of the last row and the back bumps of the chs in the first vertical row. Bind off.

Repeat this section on the other side.

## Sides

With the right side of the piece facing out, join yarn to the corner of the bottom left granny square at the front of the cardigan. Ch 1 . Working up the side, around the neck, and down the other side, (sc2tog, sc in next 2 sts) in the BLO of each st and ch (as well as the side of the spaces created by the joined granny squares) until you reach the corner of the bottom right granny square at the front.

The next part of the ribbing is worked in vertical rows.
Round 1: Ch 6, turn. Beginning in the $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from your hook, hdc in each ch. Ss to the st at the base of the chs, then ss in the next st. (5 sts)
*Round 2: Turn, skip over the two ss, hdc in the third loop only across. (5 sts)
Round 3: Ch 1, turn. Hdc in the third loop only across. Ss in next 2 sts. ( 5 sts)*
Repeat rows 2 and 3 until you reach the corner of the bottom left granny square, where you started your work. Bind off.

## Bottom

With the right side of the sweater facing out, join your yarn to the corner of the bottom right part of the ribbing you just made (at the front of the cardigan). Ch 1. Working along the edge of the ribbing and the bottom edge along the back of the cardigan, (sc2tog, sc in next 2 sts) in the BLO of each st and ch (as well as the side of the spaces created by the joined granny squares) until you reach the corner of the bottom right granny square at the front (make sure to work along the edge of the ribbing as well).
The next part of the ribbing is worked in vertical rows.
Round 1: Ch 6, turn. Beginning in the $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from your hook, hdc in each ch. Ss to the st at the base of the chs, then ss in the next st. (5 sts)
*Round 2: Turn, skip over the two ss, hdc in the third loop only across. (5 sts)
Round 3: Ch 1, turn. Hdc in the third loop only across. Ss in next 2 sts. ( 5 sts)*

Repeat rounds 2-3 until you reach the corner of the bottom left corner of the top ribbing, where you started your work. Bind off. Weave in all of the ends.
