Sweater

MATERIALS

7 (7, 8, 9) 10, 11, 13, 15, 17 skeins of Evergreen color 15

Crochet hook 3.5 mm (US E/4)
Crochet hook 4.0mm(US G/6)

YARN QUALITY

 **Evergreen**, Hobbii
100 % Organic Wool
50 g / 1.75 oz. = 230 m / 252 yds

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 21 sts x 11 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain
sc = single crochet
dc = double crochet
Fpdc = front post double crochet
Bpdc = back post double crochet
Fptr = front post treble/triple crochet
Inc-2 = double crochet in the same st
Dc2tog = 2 double crochet together
SM = stitch marker

SIZE

XS (S, M, L) XL, 2XL, 3XL, 4XL, 5XL

MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: 81 (91, 102, 112) 122, 132, 142, 152, 163 cm / 32" (36",40",44") 48", 52", 56", 60", 64",

Length: 76 (79, 79, 81) 81, 84, 84, 86, 86 cm / 30" (31", 31", 32") 32", 33", 33", 34", 34"

PATTERN INFORMATION

This pattern is made with 2 panels, bottom up then crocheted together. The sleeves are done in the round for minimal construction. The finished garment should have 2" positive ease for cozy comfort.

INFO AND TIPS

Basic knowledge of crochet cables is recommended. Sweater is crocheted bottom up in 2 panels then crocheted together. Sleeves and cowl are crocheted in the round.

BODY

BACK PANEL

Crochet back and forth

CH 84(96,106,118)128,140,150,162,172

(RS)DC into the 3rd chain from the hook, DC across

82(94,104,116)126,138,148,160,170 sts

Row (INC)1: CH 2, BPDC and FPDC in the 1st st, *alternate BPDC, FPDC ,REPEAT from * to last st, BPDC and FPDC in last st,CH 2, TURN

Row 2(WS): Working in the coordinating pattern, alternate BPDC, FPDC across, CH 2, TURN

Row 3: Working in the coordinating pattern, alternate BPDC, FPDC across, CH 2, TURN

Row 4: Working in the coordinating pattern, alternate BPDC, FPDC across, CH 2, TURN

Row (INC)5: Working in the coordinating pattern, alternate BPDC, FPDC in the 1st st, *alternate BPDC, FPDC, REPEAT from * to last st, BPDC and FPDC in last st,CH 2, TURN

REPEAT Rows 2-5; 2 times TOTAL then 2-4; 1 more time

88(100,110,122)132,144,154,166,176 sts

Row 5: DC across to the end, CH 2,TURN

Row 6: DC across to the end, CH 2,TURN

REPEAT Rows 5-6 until garment measures 76(79,79,81)81,84,84,86,86 cm,

30"(31",31",32")32",33",33",34",34" or 98(101,101,104)104,107,107,111,111 ROWS

FRONT PANEL

CH 84(96,106,118)128,140,150,162,172

(RS)DC into the 3rd chain from the hook, DC across



Row (INC)1: CH 2, BPDC and FPDC in the 1st st, *alternate BPDC, FPDC ,REPEAT from * to last st, BPDC and FPDC in last st, CH 2, TURN

Row 2(WS): Working in the coordinating pattern, alternate BPDC, FPDC across, CH 2, TURN

Row 3: Working in the coordinating pattern, alternate BPDC, FPDC across, CH 2, TURN

Row 4: Working in the coordinating pattern, alternate BPDC, FPDC across, CH 2, TURN

Row (INC)5: Working in the coordinating pattern, alternate BPDC, BPDC in the 1st st, *alternate BPDC, FPDC ,REPEAT from * to last st, BPDC and FPDC in last st, CH 2, TURN

REPEAT Rows 1-5, 2 time TOTAL

88(100,110,122)132,144,154,166,176 sts

Row 5(RS): DC the next 13(13,13,14)14,16,16,18,18 sts across* BPDC in next st,[skip next 3 sts, FPTR in the next 3 sts, going back to the skipped sts, behind the 3 sts just made and continuing in order, FPTR in the skipped sts], in next 6 sts[skip 1st 3 sts, FPTR in next 3 sts, going back to the skipped sts, in front of the 3 sts just made and continuing in order, FPTR in the skipped sts] BPDC in next st**, DC in the next 33(46,56,66)76,84,94,102,112 sts or to last 27(27,27,28)28,30,30,32,32, REPEAT from * to ** 1 time, DC to end CH 2,TURN

Row 6(WS): DC in the next 13(13,13,14)14,16,16,18,18 sts, FPDC, [BPDC in next 12 sts, careful to work in correct order], FPDC, DC in the next 33(46,56,66)76,84,94,102,112 sts or to last 27(27,27,28)28,30,30,32,32, REPEAT from * to ** 1 time, DC to end the end, CH 2,TURN

REPEAT Rows 5-6 until garment measures 63(66,69,66)66,69,69,71,71 cm, 25"(27",28",28",)28",29",29",30",30" or 87(90,93,93) 93,97,97,100,100 ROWS.

Right shoulder (when wearing the sweater)

Starting from outer edge of panel

Row 1: DC in the next 29(34,38,43)48,53,58,63,68 sts, CH 2, TURN

Row 2: DC in 1st st, DC2TOG, DC to end, CH 2 TURN

REPEAT Rows 1-2 a TOTAL of 5(5,5, 6)6,6,6,6,6 or APPROX 8(8,8,9)9,9,9,9,9 cm or 3"(3",3",4")4",4",4",4",4"

Cut yarn, sew in ends.

Left shoulder

Skip 30(32,34,36)36,38,38,40,40 sts

Row 1: DC in the next 29(34,38,43)48,53,58,63,68 sts, CH 2, TURN

Row 2: DC across to last 3 sts, DC2TOG, DC to end, CH 2, TURN

REPEAT Rows 1-2 a TOTAL of 5(5,5, 6)6,6,6,6,6 or APPROX 8(8,8,9)9,9,9,9,9 cm or 3"(3",3",4")4",4",4",4",4"

Cut yarn, sew in ends.

Your FRONT Panel should measure APPROX 73(76,76,78)78,81,81,83,83 cm or 29"(30",30",31")31",32",32",33",33"

Now, for construction,

Place back and front panels RS facing each other. Line up the shoulder edges SC across the right and left shoulders.

Measure 23(25,27,28)29,30,32,33,34 cm or 9"(10", 10.5", 11")11.5",12",12.5", 13",13.5" from the top place SM through both panels. SC to the ribbing of the front panel. Cut yarn, sew in ends and turn sweater right side out.

COWL (IN Round)

Switch to 4MM hook

Starting in right corner of the back of the neck, CH 2, DC 30(32,34,38)38,37,38,38,41 sts across the back, 13(13,13,16)16,16,16,16,16 sts down the side, 41(43,45,48)48,49,49,51,51 sts across the front and 13(13,13,16)16,16,16,16,16 sts up the side. Sl st in top of CH 2.
97(101,105,118)118,118,119,121,124sts

Round 1 (INC): CH 2, *(DC 8(9,9,9)9,9,9,9 sts, INC) REPEAT from * a total of 8(10,9,11)11,11,10,11,11 times *then, DC to end*, sl st into top of ch 2

105(111,114,129)129,129,129,132,135 sts

Round 2: CH 4(counts as DC and CH 1), *Skip 1 st, in next st, DC CH1 DC(V-stitch), skip next st, REPEAT from * around, sl st into the top of CH 2

Round 3: CH 2, DC in same st, *DC, CH 1, DC in CH 1 space of previous row(V-stitch), REPEAT from * around

REPEAT Round 3 until COWL measures 25(27,27,27)27,30,30,33,33 cm or 10"(11",11",11")11",12",12",13",13"

Cut yarn, sew in ends.

¾ SLEEVES (WORKED IN THE ROUND)

Turn your sweater sideways attach yarn, CH 2, DC **99(110,110,121)121,132,132,143,143** stitches along the arm hole or **49,50(55,55;55,55;60,61)60,61;66,66;66,66;71,72;71,72 sts on each side**

Round 1-2: CH 2, DC around, sl st into top of ch 2

Round 3: CH 2, DC2TOG in 1st and Next st, DC around to last 3 sts, DC2TOG, DC, sl st into top of ch 2

REPEAT ROUNDS 1-3; 3(3,3,4)4,4,4,5,5 TIMES TOTAL **THEN**, REPEAT ROUND 3

26(27,27,28)28,29,29,30,30 more times and a TOTAL of 41(50,50,57)57,66,64,73,73 sts

or until sleeve measures 24(28,28,30)30,30,30,35,35 cm or 10"(11",11",12")12",12",12",14",14"

Continue on

***STOP HERE:** Decide if you want more length the cuff will add 4 cm/1.5". If you do continue in the round until desired length if not CONTINUE below.

CUFF

DEC ROUND: **(For sizes L-5XL ONLY)**

CH 2, *DC (12)12,9,9,5,5 DC2TOG Repeat from * around sl st into top of CH 2
(53)53,60,60,63,63 sts

Continue on

Round 1-4: CH2, FPDC BPDC around, SL ST into top of CH 2

Cut yarn, sew in ends.

¾ Sleeve should measure APPROX 29(32,32,34)34,34,34,37,37 cm or 11.5"(12.5",12.5",13.5")13.5",13.5",13.5", 14.5",14.5"
