

CROCHET PATTERN

Safi the Dino

MATERIALS

3 skeins of Friends Cotton 8/4, col Pastel Green (100)

1 skein of Friends Cotton 8/4, col Silver (118) 1 skein of Friends Cotton 8/4, col Dusty Mauve (58)

Crochet hook 2.5 mm Small pieces of black and white scrap yarn. Safety eyes 5 mm Fiberfill

YARN QUALITY

Friends Cotton 8/4, Hobbii 100% cotton / 50 g = 160 m

ABBREVIATIONS

mr = magic ring ch = chain sc = single crochet sl st(s) = slip stitch(es) dc = double crochet inc = increase - 2 stitches in the same st dec = decrease - 2 stitches together rnd(s) = round(s) (xx) = number of stitches after ended round

MEASUREMENTS

Height: approx. 35 cm / 14"

INFO AND TIPS

Always stuff the head and body firmly. Always stuff between head and body as you sew the head on to avoid a wobbly head. Sew the head on with small firm stitches to avoid that it tilts. Work tightly to avoid holes between the stitches.

All pieces are worked in a spiral.

BODY

In Pastel Green

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a mr

Rnd 2: (inc) x 6 (12)

Rnd 3: (1 sc, inc) x 6 (18)

Rnd 4: (2 sc, inc) x 6 (24)

Rnd 5: (3 sc, inc) x 6 (30)

Rnd 6: (4 sc, inc) x 6 (36)

Rnd 7: (5 sc, inc) x 6 (42)

Rnd 8: (6 sc, inc) x 6 (48)

Rnd 9: (7 sc, inc) x 6 (54)

Rnd 10: (8 sc, inc) x 6 (60)

Rnd 11: (9 sc, inc) x 6 (66)

Rnd 12: (10 sc, inc) x 6 (72)

Rnds 13-24: 1 sc in each st (72)

Rnd 25: (10 sc, dec) x 6 (66)

Rnds 26-28: 1 sc in each st (66)

Rnd 29: (9 sc, dec) x 6 (60)

Rnds 30-31: 1 sc in each st (60)

Rnd 32: (8 sc, dec) x 6 (54)

Rnds 33-34: 1 sc in each st (54)

Rnd 35: (7 sc, dec) x 6 (48)

Rnds 36-37: 1 sc in each st (48)

Rnd 38: (6 sc, dec) x 6 (42)

Rnd 39: 1 sc in each st (42)

Rnd 40: (5 sc, dec) x 6 (36)

Rnd 41: 1 sc in each st (36)

Rnd 42: (4 sc, dec) x 6 (30)

Rnd 43: 1 sc in each st (30)

Rnd 44: (3 sc, dec) x 6 (24)

Rnds 45-51: 1 sc in each st (24)

Rnd 52: (6 sc, dec) x 3 (21)



Rnds 53-59: 1 sc in each st (21)

Fasten off and leave a tail long enough for sewing.

THE WHITE PART AROUND THE EYE

In white

Make 2.

Rnd 1: 4 sc in a mr, 1 sl st

DON'T tighten the loop as you will have to place it around the safety eyes first.

Fasten off and leave a tail long enough for assembling.

HEAD

In Pastel Green

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a mr Rnd 2: (inc) x 6 (12) Rnd 3: (1 sc, inc) x 6 (18) Rnd 4: (2 sc, inc) x 6 (24) Rnd 5: (3 sc, inc) x 6 (30) Rnd 6: (4 sc, inc) x 6 (36) Rnd 7: (5 sc, inc) x 6 (42) Rnd 8: (6 sc, inc) x 6 (48) Rnds 9-14: 1 sc in each st (48) Rnd 15: (7 sc, inc) x 6 (54) Rnd 16: (8 sc, inc) x 6 (60)

Rnd 17: (9 sc, inc) x 6 (66) Rnds 18-27: 1 sc in each st (66)

Attach the safety eyes between rounds 13-14 with 7 sc in between.

Now, place the white piece around the eye and tighten the magic ring so that it fits tightly, pull the threads through to the inside and secure them.

Embroider the eyebrows right above the eye, it is easier to do it now. You can split the yarn into 2 to get a thinner thread or use a thinner yarn than the one you use for crocheting.

Stuff the head with fiberfill as you work.

Rnd 28: (9 sc, dec) x 6 (60) Rnd 29: (8 sc, dec) x 6 (54) Rnd 30: (7 sc, dec) x 6 (48) Rnd 31: (6 sc, dec) x 6 (42) Rnd 32: (5 sc, dec) x 6 (36) Rnd 33: (4 sc, dec) x 6 (30) Rnd 34: (3 sc, dec) x 6 (24) Rnd 35: (2 sc, dec) x 6 (18) Rnd 36: (1 sc, dec) x 6 (12) Rnd 37: (2 sc, dec) x 3 (9)

Fasten off and leave a tail long enough for gathering the last 9 stitches.

Use a needle to gather the last 9 front loops and tighten the yarn gently to close the hole nicely.



LEG

Make 2. Begin with Silver.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a mr Rnd 2: (inc) x 6 (12) Rnd 3: (1 sc, inc) x 6 (18) Rnd 4: (2 sc, inc) x 6 (24) Rnd 5: (3 sc, inc) x 6 (30) Rnd 6: (4 sc, inc) x 6 (36) Rnd 7: 1 sc in each st (36)

Switch to Pastel Green

Rnds 8-11: 1 sc in each st (36) Rnd 12: 12 sc, dec x 6, 12 sc (30) Rnd 13: 12 sc, dec x 3, 12 sc (27) Rnd 14: 1 sc in each st (27) Rnd 15: (7 sc, dec) x 3 (24) Rnd 16: (6 sc, dec) x 3 (21) Rnd 17: (5 sc, dec) x 3 (18) Rnds 18-27: 1 sc in each st (18) Rnd 28: (4 sc, dec) x 3 (15)

Fasten off and leave a tail long enough for sewing.

Stuff the legs with fiberfill as you work.

ARM

Make 2 in Pastel Green

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a mr Rnd 2: (inc) x 6 (12)

Stuff the arm very lightly with fiberfill as you work.

Rnds 3-30: 1 sc in each st (12)

Fasten off and leave a tail long enough for sewing.

SPIKES

Make 7 in Silver

Rnd 1: 3 sc in a mr Rnd 2: (inc) x 3 (6) Rnd 3: (1 sc, inc) x 3 (9) Rnd 4: (2 sc, inc) x 3 (12) Rnd 5: (3 sc, inc) x 3 (15) Rnd 6: 1 sc in each st (15) Rnd 7: (4 sc, inc) x 3 (18) Rnd 8: 1 sc in each st (18)

Fasten off and leave a tail long enough for sewing.



HEADPHONES

Outside

Make 2 in Dusty Mauve

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a mr Rnd 2: (inc) x 6 (12) Rnd 3: (1 sc, inc) x 6 (18) Rnd 4: (2 sc, inc) x 6 (24) Rnd 5: (3 sc, inc) x 6 (30) Rnd 6: (4 sc, inc) x 6 (36) Rnd 7: (5 sc, inc) x 6 (42) Rnds 8-9: 1 sc in each st (42)

Fasten off.

Inside

Make 2 in Silver

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a mr Rnd 2: (inc) x 6 (12) Rnd 3: (1 sc, inc) x 6 (18) Rnd 4: (2 sc, inc) x 6 (24) Rnd 5: (3 sc, inc) x 6 (30) Rnd 6: (4 sc, inc) x 6 (36) Rnd 7: (5 sc, inc) x 6 (42)

Fasten off.

Now, place one outside piece and one inside piece with the wrong sides facing each other and make a border of 42 sc in Silver, stuff with a bit of fiberfill as you work.

STRAP FOR THE HEADPHONES

In Silver

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a mr

Rnds 2-32: 1 sc in each st (6)

Fasten off and use a needle to gather all 6 front loops and tighten the yarn, then sew the strap on in the middle between the ear pads.

TAIL

In Pastel Green

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a mr Rnd 2: 2 sc, inc x 2, 2 sc (8) Rnd 3: 1 sc in each st (8) Rnd 4: 3 sc, inc x 2, 3 sc (10) Rnd 5: 1 sc in each st (10) Rnd 6: 4 sc, inc x 2, 4 sc (12) Rnd 7: 1 sc in each st (12) Rnd 8: 5 sc, inc x 2, 5 sc (14) Rnd 9: 1 sc in each st (14) Rnd 10: 6 sc, inc x 2, 6 sc (16) Rnd 11: 1 sc in each st (16)



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Rnd 12: 7 sc, inc x 2, 7 sc (18)
Rnd 13: 1 sc in each st (18)
Rnd 14: 8 sc, inc x 2, 8 sc (20)
Rnd 15: 9 sc, inc x 2, 9 sc (22)
Rnd 16: 10 sc, inc x 2, 10 sc (24)
Rnd 17: 11 sc, inc x 2, 11 sc (26)
Rnd 18: 12 sc, inc x 2, 12 sc (28)
Rnd 19: 13 sc, inc x 2, 13 sc (30)
Rnd 20: 14 sc, inc x 2, 14 sc (32)
Rnd 21: 15 sc, inc x 2, 15 sc (34)
Rnd 22: 16 sc, inc x 2, 16 sc (36)
Rnd 23: 17 sc, inc x 2, 17 sc (38)
Rnd 24: 18 sc, inc x 2, 18 sc (40)
Rnd 25: 19 sc, inc x 2, 19 sc (42)
Rnd 26: 20 sc, inc x 2, 20 sc (44)
Rnd 27: 21 sc, inc x 2, 21 sc (46)
Rnd 28: 22 sc, inc x 2, 22 sc (48)
Rnd 29: 23 sc, inc x 2, 23 sc (50)
Rnd 30: 24 sc, inc x 2, 24 sc (52)
Rnd 31: 25 sc, inc x 2, 25 sc (54)
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Fasten off and leave a tail long enough for sewing.

ASSEMBLING

- · Stuff the spikes lightly with fiberfill and sew the first onto the head over rounds 24-30 and sew the other 2 onto the head with 4 rounds in between.
- · Embroider nostrils over rounds 5-6 with 3 sc in between, with approx. 3-4 stitches.
- Position the body on the head over rounds 17-22 and sew them together, it is important to sew with small stitches and stuff well between head and body as you work to avoid a wobbly head. You can also stiffen the head and body using for instance a piece of cable, 20 cm (8") long and a with diameter of 0.5 cm (0.2"), which you push through the head and body.

For the amigurumi on the pictures, I did not use any I only sewed with small stitches and stuffed well in between.

- · Sew the legs on diagonally on round 4 of the body with 4 sc in between.
- Stuff the tail lightly and position the bottom edge of the tail on round 8 of the body and the top edge of the tail on round 31, pin it on, sew it on and stuff lightly as you work.
- · Sew the first spike onto the body over rounds 6-13 and sew the last 3 spikes on with approx. 4 rounds in between.

Sew the arms onto the body on round 45.

· Embroider the stripes on the belly while tying a knot after each stripe and pushing the knot through to the inside to hide it.

1st stripe: between rounds 19-20 across 16 sc 2nd stripe: between rounds 23-24 across 16 sc 3rd stripe: between rounds 27-28 across 14 sc 4th stripe: between rounds 31-32 across 9 sc 5th stripe: between rounds 35-36 across 9 sc

· Sew the headphones onto the head.


