# Flower Fairy <br> Top

## MATERIALS

Baby Cotton Organic
(2) 4 (5) 5 skeins of Silver Gray (03)
(1) 2 (2) 2 skein(s) of Jade (29)
(2) 2 (3) 3 skeins of Powder Blue (37)
(1) 1 (1) 1 skein of Blush (20)
(1) 1 (1) 1 skein of Arctic (32)
(1) 1 (1) 1 skein of Pastel Yellow (27)

Crochet hook 3 mm (US C/2)

## YARN QUALITY

(10) Baby Cotton Organic, Hobbii

100\% Egyptian Cotton
$50 \mathrm{~g} / 1.75 \mathrm{oz} .=170 \mathrm{~m} / 186 \mathrm{yds}$

## GAUGE

$10 \mathrm{~cm} \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}\left(4^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}\right)=12$ sts $\times 16$ rows

## ABBREVIATIONS

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ch = chain
sc = single crochet
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dc = double crochet
tc = triple crochet
popcorn st - popcorn stitch
Popcorn stitch: make 5 double crochet in the stitch indicated in the pattern. Pull the loop on the hook a little larger. Drop that same loop from the hook. Count back to the first double crochet stitch. Insert the hook from back to front through the first double crochet stitch. Place the dropped look back on the hook, and draw that loop through the first stitch.

## SIZE

(XS-S) M, (L-XXL), XXXL

## MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: (84-93 cm), 94-110 cm, (111-120 cm), 121-150 cm / (33-36.5"), 37-43", (43.5-47"), 47.5-59"

Length: $50 \mathrm{~cm} / 19.5^{\prime \prime}$

## INFO AND TIPS

Measure the fullest part of your chest and start crocheting according to your measurement: XS-S (84-93 cm), M (94-110 cm), L-XXL (111-120 cm), XXXL (121-150 cm)

XS-S - 12 squares x 3 rows of " 4 -rounds squares " $=36$ squares ( 9 of each color (pink, yellow, light blue, turquoise),

M-12 squares x 3 rows of " 5 -rounds squares " $=36$ squares ( 9 of each color (pink, yellow, light blue, turquoise),

L-XXL - 16 squares x 4 rows of " 4-rounds squares " = 64 squares (16 of each color (pink, yellow, light blue, turquoise),

XXXL - 16x4 " 5-rounds squares " 64 squares (16 of each color (pink, yellow, light blue, turquoise)
" 4 -rounds square " $=7 \mathrm{~cm}$ (2 3/4 in), " 5 -rounds square " $=9 \mathrm{~cm}$ (3 1/2 in)

## FLOWER SQUARE PATTERN

With pink, light blue, yellow or turquoise yarn ch-4, join with sl st to the 1st ch
Round 1: ch-1, 8 sc into the circle, join with sl st to the 1st sc
Round 2: ch-3 (count as the 1st dc), 4 dc in same stitch, finish popcorn st, ch-2, * popcorn st in next sc, ch-2 **, rep from * to ** to the end of the round, join with sl st to top of the 1st popcorn st, cut the yarn (8 popcorn sts). Change the color of the yarn (green), connect to any ch-2 space

Round 3: ch-3 (count as the 1st dc), 2 dc in same space, ch-2, 3 dc in same space, ch- $1,3 \mathrm{dc}$ in next ch-2 space, ch-1, * 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 3 dc in same space, ch-1, 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch-1 **, rep from * to ** twice, join with sl st to top of ch-3 Change the color of the yarn (gray), connect to any ch-2 space

Round 4: ch-3 (count as the 1st dc), 2 dc in same space, ch-2, 3 dc in same space, ch-1, ( 3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch-1) rep once, * 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 3 dc in same space, ch-1, (3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch-1) rep once **, rep from * to ** twice, join with sl st to top of ch-3

NOTE: Crochet 5-rounds squares only for sizes $M$ and $X X X L$
Round 5: sl st in next 2 dc , sl st in next ch-2 space, ch-3 (count as the 1 st dc ), 2 dc in same space, ch-2, 3 dc in same space, ch-1, (3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch-1) rep twice, * 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 3 dc in same space, ch-1, (3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch-1) rep twice **, rep from * to ** twice, join with sl st to top of ch-3

## JOINING

NOTE: you need only one finished square, join other squares to the first finished square while crocheting the final round

## How to join " 4-rounds squares ":

Change the color of the yarn (gray), connect to any ch-2 space
Round 4: ch-3 (count as the 1st dc), 2 dc in same space, ch-1, sc in any corner of the finished square, 3 dc in same ch- 2 space of the unfinished square, (sc in next ch-1 space of the finished square, 3 dc in next ch-2 space of the unfinished square) rep once, sc in next ch- 1 space of the finished square, 3 dc in next ch-2 space of the unfinished square, sc in the $2 n d$ corner of the finished square, ch-1, 3 dc in same ch-2 space of the unfinished square, ch-1, (3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch-1) rep once, * 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 3 dc in same space, ch-1, (3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch-1) rep once **, rep from * to ** twice, join with sl st to top of ch-3

## How to join " 5-rounds squares ":

Round 5: sl st in next 2 dc , sl st in next ch-2 space, ch-3 (count as the 1 st dc ), 2 dc in same space, ch-1, sc in any corner of the finished square, 3 dc in same ch- 2 space of the unfinished square, (sc in next ch-1 space of the finished square, 3 dc in next ch-2 space of the unfinished square) rep twice, sc in next ch-1 space of the finished square, 3 dc in next ch-2 space of the unfinished square, sc in the $2 n d$ corner of the finished square, ch-1, 3 dc in same ch- 2 space of the unfinished square, ch-1, (3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch-1) rep twice, * 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 3 dc in same space, ch-1, (3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch-1) rep twice **, rep from * to ** twice, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Join 12 or 16 squares in the circle, after that connect the 1 st square of the 2 nd round of squares, then start joining the 2 nd square from the right side of the 1 st square. I will show you how to connect 3 corners of the square

## How to join 3 corners of "4-rounds squares":

Change the color of the yarn (gray), connect to any ch-2 space

Round 4: ch-3 (count as the 1st dc), 2 dc in same space, ch-1, sc in the 1st corner of the upper square, 3 dc in the same space (the 1st corner) of the unfinished square, sc in next ch-1 space of the upper square, (3 dc in next ch-1 space of the unfinished square, sc in next ch-1 space of the upper square) rep once, 3 dc in the 2 nd corner of the unfinished square,
sc in the 2 nd corner of the upper square, sc in the 1 st corner of the left square, 3 dc in the 2 nd corner of the unfinished square,
sc in next ch-1 space of the left square, ( 3 dc in next ch-1 space of the unfinished square, sc in next ch-1 space of the left square) rep once, 3 dc in the 3 rd corner of the unfinished square, sc in the $2 n d$ corner of the left square, ch-1, 3 dc in the 3 rd corner of the unfinished square, ch-1, (3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch-1) rep once, 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 3 dc in same space, ch-1, (3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch-1) rep twice, join with sl st to top of ch-3

## How to join 3 corners of " 5 -rounds squares":

Round 5: sl st in next 2 dc , sl st in next ch-2 space, ch-3, 2 dc in same space, ch- 1 , sc in the 1 st corner of the upper square, 3 dc in the same space (the 1st corner) of the unfinished square, sc in next ch-1 space of the upper square, ( 3 dc in next ch- 1 space of the unfinished square, sc in next ch-1 space of the upper square) rep twice, 3 dc in the 2 nd corner of the unfinished square, sc in the 2 nd corner of the upper square, sc in the 1 st corner of the left square, 3 dc in the 2 nd corner of the unfinished square,
sc in next ch-1 space of the left square, (3 dc in next ch-1 space of the unfinished square, sc in next ch-1 space of the left square) rep twice, 3 dc in the 3rd corner of the unfinished square, sc in the $2 n d$ corner of the left square, ch-1, 3 dc in the 3 rd corner of the unfinished square, ch-1, (3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch-1) rep twice, 3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 3 dc in same space, ch-1, (3 dc in next ch-1 space, ch-1) rep twice, join with sl st to top of ch-3
Connect all the squares in 3 or 4 rows.

## The color scheme of flowers from the left to the right:

The 1st row of flower - pink -> light blue -> yellow -> turquoise
The 2nd row of flower - light blue -> yellow -> turquoise -> pink
The 3rd row of flower - yellow -> turquoise -> pink -> light blue
The 4th row of flower - turquoise -> pink -> light blue -> yellow

## THE UPPER PART OF THE TOP

Connect the yarn (gray) to any space between 2 squares and start crocheting granny stitches: Round 1: ch-3, 2 dc in same space, 3 dc in each ch-1 space and spaces between two squares around, join with sl st to top of ch-3
Round 2-3: sl st in next 2 dc , sl st in next space, ch-3, 2 dc in same space, 3 dc in each space around, join with sl st to top of ch-3

## SHOULDERS STRAPS

Mark places for the shoulders straps (5 spaces width) on the front and the back parts.
Row 1: connect the yarn to the 1st marked space of the front part (right side), ch-3, 3 dc in next 3 spaces, dc in the last marked space

Row 2: ch-3, turn, 2 dc in the space between dc and next 3 dc, 3 dc in next 3 spaces

Row 3: ch-3, turn, 3 dc in next 3 spaces, dc in the last dc

Repeat Rows 2-3 until you reach the desired length. Finish with the 2nd row

XS - 28 rows ( 24 cm 9 in )

S,M - 32 rows ( 28 cm 11 in )
L-36 rows (32 cm 12 1/2 in)

XL, XXL, XXXL - 40 rows ( 40 cm 15 3/4 in)

The last row: put the strap and the marked place of the back part with right sides facing each other, ch-3, sc in the 1st marked space,
3 dc in the 1st space of the back strap, sc in next space of the marked space,
3 dc in the 2 nd space of the back strap, sc in next space of the marked space,
3 dc in the 3 rd space of the back strap, sc in next space of the marked space,
dc in the last dc of the strap, sc in the last marked space of the back part.

## WINGS

Crochet a row of granny stitches around the armholes (gray)

Round 1: connect yarn to any space, ch-3, 2 dc in same space, 3 dc in each space around, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Change the color of yarn (light blue)
Round 2: connect yarn to any dc, ch-3, 2 dc in same $\mathrm{dc}, 3 \mathrm{dc}$ in each dc to the end of the round, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Round 3: ch-4, tc in each dc to the end of the round, join with sl st to top of ch-4
Round 4: ch-1, sc in same st, ch-1, * sc in next tc, ch-1 **, repeat from * to ** to the end of the round, join with sl st to the 1st sc

## NECKLINE

Crochet a row of granny stitches around the neckline (gray). Repeat the 1st round of "Wings" pattern.

Round 1: ch-1, sc in same st, ch-1, * sc in next dc, ch-1 **, repeat from * to ** to the end of the round, join with sl st to the 1st sc

## BOTTOM

Connect the yarn (gray) to any space between 2 squares and start crocheting granny stitches: Round 1: ch-3, 2 dc in same space, 3 dc in each ch-1 space and spaces between two squares around, join with sl st to top of ch-3
Round 2-3: sl st in next 2 dc , sl st in next space, ch-3, 2 dc in same space, 3 dc in each space around, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Repeat Round 2 until you reach the desired length. I crocheted 3 rounds of each color - 18 rounds (gray -> green -> light blue -> turquoise -> pink -> yellow).

The last round: ch-1, sc in same st, ch-1, * sc in next dc, ch-1 **, repeat from * to ** to the end of the round, join with sl st to the 1st sc, cut the yarn
