

KNITTING PATTERN

Highland Cardi

Cardigan

MATERIALS

(8) 9 (11) 13 (15) skeins of Snowstorm colour 07

Circular needle 10 mm (US 15), 40 cm (15.75")

Circular needle 12 mm (US 17), 80 cm (31.5")

5 Wooden buttons 2.5 cm diameter (1") 4 Stitch markers

YARN QUALITY

Snowstorm, Hobbii 100 % Wool 50 g (1.75 oz) = 50 m (54 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4'' x 4'') = 9 sts x 14 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit

P = Purl

C/on = Cast on

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Dec c/off = Decrease cast off - K2tog from the back of the loop then slip the stitch back to the left needle, repeat to the end of the row

YIF = Yarn in the front of your work

PM = Place your marker

RM = Remove your marker

SM = Slide your marker

M = Marker

Kf&b = Knit in the front and then the back of the same stitch with the yarn at the back of the work

K2tog = Knit two stitches together

K3tog = Knit three stitches together

SIZE

(S) M (L) XL (XXL)

MEASUREMENTS

Width: (47) 52 (55) 58 (60) cm / (18.50") 20.47"

(21.65") 22.83" (23.62")

Length: (56) 60 (63) 67 (70) cm / (22.05") 23.62"

(24.80") 26.38" (27.56")

PATTERN INFORMATION

This project is knitted flat on circular needles from the top down and in the round for the sleeves

INFO AND TIPS

This is a quick and easy knitting pattern for beginners and intermediate knitters.

YOKE

C/on (42) 44 (46) 48 (50) sts on 10 mm (US 15) circular needles Row 1 – (K1, P1) repeat until the end of the row Now create your first buttonhole: Row 2 – K1, P1, YIF K2tog, (K1, P1) repeat until the end of the row Repeat row 1 twice

Change to 12mm (US 17) needles

Row 5 – K1, P1, K1, P1, K (5) 5 (6) 6 (7), PM, K5, PM, K (14) 16 (16) 18 (18), PM, K5, PM, K (5) 5 (6) 6 (7), K1, P1, K1, P1

Row 6 - K1, P1, K1, P1, P until the last 4 sts, K1, P1, K1, P1

Row 7 – K1, P1, K1, P1, (K until the last st before the M, Kf&b, SM, Kf&b) \times 4, K until the last 4 sts K1, P1, K1, P1

Continue to create buttonholes regularly on row 6 every (9) 10½ (11) 11½ (12) cm / (3.54) 4.13 (4.33) 4.53 (4.72) " as follow:

Buttonhole row - K1, P1, YIF K2tog, P until the last 4 sts, K1, P1, K1, P1

Continue to increase your sts by repeating row 6 and 7, (13) 14 (15) 16 (17) times finishing on row 6. (146) 156 (166) 176 (186) sts.

For the next step we are going to separate our sleeves sts from the body

Next row - K1, P1, K1, P1, K (18) 19 (21) 22 (24), RM, slide the (31) 33 (35) 37 (39) sleeves sts on a spare strand of yarn, RM, c/on 4 sts, K (40) 44 (46) 50 (52), RM, slide the (31) 33 (35) 37 (39) sleeves sts on a spare strand of yarn, RM, c/on 4 sts, K (18) 19 (21) 22 (24), K1, P1, K1, P1 (92) 98 (104) 110 (116) sts

LOWER BODY

Next row – K1, P1, K1, P1, P until the last 4 sts, K1, P1, K1, P1 Next row – K1, P1, K1, P1, K until the last 4 sts, K1, P1, K1, P1 Next row – K1, P1, K1, P1, P until the last 4 sts, K1, P1, K1, P1



Repeat the last two rows until your piece measure (22) 24 (26) 28 (30) cm / (8.66) 9.45 (10.24) 11.02 (11.81) " from that point

Continue to create buttonholes regularly on row 6 every (9) 10½ (11) 11½ (12) cm / (3.54) 4.13 (4.33) 4.53 (4.72) " as follow: Buttonhole row - K1, P1, YIF K2tog, P until the last 4 sts, K1, P1, K1, P1

Next row – K1, P1 repeat until the end of the row Repeat this last row (6) 7 (7) 8 (8) times

Dec c/off all your sts, cut the yarn and make secure

SLEEVES

(Sleeves are worked in the round)

Re-join the (31) 33 (35) 37 (39) sts from the spare strand of yarn on 12 mm (US 17) circular needles

Pick up 3 sts from one side of the underarms, K (31) 33 (35) 37 (39), pick up 3 sts from the other side of the underarms. Place a M to show the start/end of your round and make sure not to twist before working your first round (37) 39 (41) 43 (45) sts

Continue by knitting every round until your sleeve measures (36½) 38 (39½) 41 (42½) cm / (14.37) 14.96 (15.55) 16.14 (16.73) "from the underarms

Change to 10mm (US 15) needles

Size 1

(K2tog, K2) x 8, K2tog, K3tog (26 sts)

Size 2

(K2tog, K2) x 8, K2tog, K2, K3tog (28 sts)

Size 3

(K2tog, K2) x 9, K2tog, K1, K2tog (30 sts)

Size 4

(K2tog, K2) x 10, K2tog, K1 (32 sts)

Size 5

(K2tog, K2) x 10, K2tog, K3tog (32 sts)

Next round – (K1, P1) repeat until the end of the row Repeat this last row (6) 7 (7) 8 (8) times

Dec c/off all your sts, cut the yarn and make secure

There are no seams to sew, so just weave in all ends
