# Penny the Panda

## MATERIALS

2 skeins of Friends Cotton 8/4, col White (001)  
1 skein of Friends Cotton 8/4, col Black (124)

Crochet hook 2.5 mm  
Scrap of pink yarn for the bow  
Filling

## YARN QUALITY

 **Friends Cotton 8/4**, Hobbii  
100% Cotton / 50 g (1.75 oz) = 160 m (175 yds)

## ABBREVIATIONS

mr = magic ring  
ch = chain  
sc = single crochet  
sl st = slip stitch  
dc = double crochet  
inc = increase – work 2 sts in the same st  
dec = decrease – work 2 sts together  
BO = bind off  
(xx) = parenthesis at the end of round = total number of sts on this round

## PATTERN INFORMATION

Penny the Panda is the sweetest baby comforter, bringing joy and comfort to anyone holding her.

# Pattern



## TIPS AND INFO

Head should always be stuffed firmly.

Make sure you work all your stitches firmly so as to not have any gaps between them.

All parts are worked in rounds without joining, except for the bow.

## BODY

With 001

- Round 1: 6 sc in mr
- Round 2: inc x 6 (12)
- Round 3: (1 sc, inc) x 6 (18)
- Round 4: (2 sc, inc) x 6 (24)
- Round 5: (3 sc, inc) x 6 (30)
- Round 6: (4 sc, inc) x 6 (36)
- Round 7: (5 sc, inc) x 6 (42)
- Round 8: (6 sc, inc) x 6 (48)
- Round 9: (7 sc, inc) x 6 (54)
- Round 10: (8 sc, inc) x 6 (60)
- Round 11: (9 sc, inc) x 6 (66)
- Round 12: (10 sc, inc) x 6 (72)
- Round 13: (11 sc, inc) x 6 (78)
- Round 14-28: 1 sc in each st (78)
- Round 29: (11 sc, dec) x 6 (72)
- Round 30: (10 sc, dec) x 6 (66)
- Round 31: (9 sc, dec) x 6 (60)
- Round 32: (8 sc, dec) x 6 (54)
- Round 33: (7 sc, dec) x 6 (48)
- Round 34: (6 sc, dec) x 6 (42)
- Round 35: (5 sc, dec) x 6 (36)
- Round 36: (4 sc, dec) x 6 (30)
- Round 37: (3 sc, dec) x 6 (24)
- Round 38: (2 sc, dec) x 6 (18)

Fold and crochet the opening together with approx. 9 sc. BO leaving a tail long enough for joining the head to the body.

## HEAD

With 001

Round 1: 6 sc in mr  
Round 2: inc x 6 (12)  
Round 3: (1 sc, inc) x 6 (18)  
Round 4: (2 sc, inc) x 6 (24)  
Round 5: (3 sc, inc) x 6 (30)  
Round 6: (4 sc, inc) x 6 (36)  
Round 7: (5 sc, inc) x 6 (42)  
Round 8: (6 sc, inc) x 6 (48)  
Round 9: (7 sc, inc) x 6 (54)  
Round 10-12: 1 sc in each st (54)  
Round 13: (7 sc, dec) x 6 (48)  
Round 14-16: 1 sc in each st (48)  
Round 17: (6 sc, dec) x 6 (42)  
Round 18-20: 1 sc in each st (42)  
Round 21: (5 sc, dec) x 6 (36)  
Round 22: 1 sc in each st  
Round 23: (4 sc, dec) x 6 (30)  
Round 24: 1 sc in each st  
Round 25: (3 sc, dec) x 6 (24)  
Round 26: (2 sc, dec) x 6 (18)  
Round 27: (1 sc, dec) x 6 (12)  
Round 28: (1 sc, dec) x 3 (9)

BO leaving a long tail for joining the last 9 sts. Using a tapestry needle, pull yarn through the outer loops of the remaining 9 sts and pull tight so they come together nicely. Fasten the yarn.

## HIND LEGS

Make 2 with 124

Round 1: 6 sc in mr  
Round 2: inc x 6 (12)  
Round 3: (1 sc, inc) x 6 (18)  
Round 4: (2 sc, inc) x 6 (24)  
Round 5: (3 sc, inc) x 6 (30)  
Round 6-8: 1 sc in each st (30)  
Round 9: dec x 4, 22 sc (26)  
Round 10: 1 sc in each st  
Round 11: dec x 3, 20 sc (23)  
Round 12: 1 sc in each st  
Round 13: dec x 2, 19 sc (21)  
Round 14: 1 sc in each st  
Round 15: dec, 19 sc (20)  
Round 16: 1 sc in each st  
Round 17: dec, 18 sc (19)  
Round 18: 1 sc in each st  
Round 19: dec, 17 sc (18)  
Round 20-24: 1 sc in each st (18)

BO leaving a tail long enough for sewing.

## FRONT LEGS/ARMS

Make 2 with 124

Round 1: 6 sc in mr  
Round 2: inc x 6 (12)  
Round 3: (1 sc, inc) x 6 (18)  
Round 4: (2 sc, inc) x 6 (24)

Round 5-7: 1 sc in each st (24)  
Round 8: dec x 3, 18 sc (21)  
Round 9: 1 sc in each st  
Round 10: dec x 2, 17 sc (19)  
Round 11: 1 sc in each st  
Round 12: dec, 17 sc (18)  
Round 13: 1 sc in each st  
Round 14: dec, 16 sc (17)  
Round 15: 1 sc in each st  
Round 16: dec, 15 sc (16)  
Round 17: 1 sc in each st  
Round 18: dec, 14 sc (15)  
Round 19-25: 1 sc in each st (15)

BO leaving a long tail for joining.

## **SNOUT/NOSE**

With 001

Round 1: 6 sc in mr  
Round 2: inc x 6 (12)  
Round 3: (1 sc, inc) x 6 (18)  
Round 4-6: 1 sc in each st (18) 1 sl st.

BO leaving a long tail for joining.

## **EYES**

Make 2 with 124

Row 1: ch 4  
Row 2: 1 sc in 2. ch from the hook and 1 sc in each st until end, ch 1, turn (3)  
Row 3: inc x 3, ch 1, turn (6)  
Row 4: inc x 6, ch 1, turn (12)

BO leaving a long tail for joining.

## **EARS**

Make 2 with 124

Round 1: 6 sc in mr  
Round 2: inc x 6 (12)  
Round 3: (1 sc, inc) x 6 (18)  
Round 4-6: 1 sc in each st  
Round 7: (1 sc, dec) x 6 (12)

BO leaving a long tail for joining.

## **TAIL**

With 001

Round 1: 6 sc in mr  
Round 2: inc x 6 (12)  
Round 3: (1 sc, inc) x 6 (18)  
Round 4: (2 sc, inc) x 6 (24)  
Round 5: 1 sc in each st

Round 6: (2 sc, dec) x 6 (18)  
 Round 7: 1 sc in each st  
 Round 8: (1 sc, dec) x 6 (12)  
 Round 9-10: 1 sc in each st

Stuff the tail with filling and BO leaving a tail long enough for joining.

## BOW

With pink scrap yarn.

Round 1: Make a mr with 1 sc, ch 2, 3 dc, ch 2, 1 sl st. Do not close the ring but continue:  
 Round 2: ch 2, 3 dc, ch 2, 1 sl st

Pull the magic ring tight to make the shape of a bow. Now wind the yarn 3 times around the middle. Cut yarn leaving enough for joining.

## FINISHING

- Stuff the legs and arms. Fold the opening so that the end of the last round falls in the middle, bending the arms and legs inwards towards the stomach.
- Attach the hind legs on round 7 counting from the bum,
- Attach the arms on round 7 counting from the neck.
- Place the ears on round 9 counting from the crown, 6 sc sts apart.
- Attach the bow in front of one ear.
- Attach the snout on round 9 counting from the lower part of the head. Tightly embroider a nose with the black yarn.
- Place the eyes with the curved part aligned with the snout, the wider part of the eyes facing downwards.
- Attach the tail on round 10 counting from the behind. Sewing the tail from the inside and then turning it will make it stand up slightly.
- Attach the head on round 6 counting from the bottom of the head.
