



CROCHET PATTERN

Captain Cat

Cat house

Design: Knit Gang | Hobbii Design



MATERIALS

4 skeins of Bungee Mini color 11 1 skein of Bungee Mini color 02 1 skein of Bungee Mini color 17

Crochet hook 10 mm (US 17) Stitch markers Tapestry needle

YARN QUALITY

Bungee Mini, Hobbii 42% cotton, 58% polyester 200 g (7.1 oz) = 60m (66 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4'' x 4'') = 8 sts x 8 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

MR = Magic Ring st/s = stitch/es ch = chain sl st = slip stitch x sc = x stitch single crochet (amigurumi) hdc = half double crochet dc = double crochet inc = increase, 2 sts in the same st dec = decrease, 2 sts together

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Width: approx. 50 cm / 19.6" Height: approx. 30 cm / 11.8" Hole width: 17x17 cm / 6.6 " x 6.6"

INFO AND TIPS

The house is worked in one piece, all around and in rows, with x sc- typical for amigurumi. To make the house stiff, work the sts very tightly.

As you start to work in rounds, remember to place the stitch marker and replace it after each round.

SUBMARINE

With color 11

Round 1 into a MR: 6 sc

Round 2: (place the stitch marker) inc around = 12 sts.

Round 3: (1 sc, inc) around = 18 sts.

Round 4: (2 sc, inc) around = 24 sts.

Round 5: (3 sc, inc) around = 30 sts.

Round 6: (4 sc, inc) around = 36 sts.

Round 7: (5 sc, inc) around = 42 sts.

Round 8: 1 sc around = 42 sts.

Round 9: (6 sc, inc) around = 48 sts.

Round 10: (7 sc, inc) around = 54 sts.

Round 11: (8 sc, inc) around = 60 sts.

Round 12: (9 sc, inc) around = 66 sts.

Round 13-19: 1 sc around.

Now you will start to form a hole for the entrance.

Round 20: ch 1, turn and start crocheting with sc (from the inside of the house) up to 12 sts before the end of the round, ch 1 and turn.

Rounds 11-30: sc till the end, ch 1, turn.

Round 31: sc up to the opening, ch 12, 1 sc, place stitch marker- it will be your first st of the round.

Round 32: 1 sc around, change to color 02

Round 33: (9 sc, dec) around = 60 sts.

Round 34: (8 sc, dec) around = 54 sts.

Round 35: (7 sc, dec) around = 48 sts.

Round 36: (6 sc, dec) around = 42 sts.

Round 37: (5 sc, dec) around = 36 sts.

Round 38: (4 sc, dec) around = 30 sts.

Round 39: (3 sc, dec) around = 24 sts.

Round 40: 1 sc around = 24 sts.



Round 41: 1 sc around = 24 sts.

Round 42: (2 sc, dec) around = 18 sts.

Round 43: (1 sc, dec) around = 12 sts.

Round 44: dec around, join with sl st = 6 sts.

Fasten off.

With color 17, make 1 sc round around the hole.

Weave in the ends.

WINDOW

With color 17

Round 1: into a MR: 6 sc

Round 2: (place the stitch marker) inc around = 12 sts.

Round 3: (1 sc, inc) around =18 sts.

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

Determine how the entrance will be laid out, in my case the boat is tilted back a bit so that the entrance is laid out a bit upwards. Then, sew on the window next to the entrance hole.

Weave in the ends.

SAIL

With color 11

Round 1 into a MR: 6 sc

Round 2: (place the stitch marker) inc around = 12 sts.

Round 3: (2 sc, 2 inc) around =18 sts.

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

Sew the sail to the top of the submarine, above the entrance hole.

Weave in the ends.

PERISCOPE

With color 11

Make 6 sc between the sts in a MR on the top of the sail.

Work sc around until the periscope measures 17 cm / 6.6", close the round with a sl st.

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.

Pull the thread through the center of the periscope and bend it forward halfway and sew in position with a stitch.

Fasten off and weave in the ends.

RUDDERS

With color 02

Ch 7, 2 sc starting from the second ch from the hook, 2 hdc, 1 dc, 5 dc in the same st, now start working on the other side of the chain, 1 dc, 2 hdc, 2 sc, close with a st st. Fasten off and leave a long tail in one rudder for sewing. Make three rudders in total. Sew all

three rudders to the end of the submarine.

Weave in the ends.
