# Sodra Oland

**Blanket** 

Design: Studio hip en kleurig | Hobbii Design



#### **MATERIALS**

11 skeins of Fluffy Day XL col. 03

Crochet hook 8 mm (US L-11)

### YARN QUALITY

Fluffy Day XL, Hobbii 100 % acrylic 100 g (3.8) oz) = 140 m (153 yds)

#### **GAUGE**

10 sts x 8 rows, worked in pattern

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

ch = chain
st(s) = stitch(es)
sc = single crochet

**sl st** = slip stitch

**bobble stitch**= 4 unfinished dc into the same st. Worked from the wrong side, they will pop out on the right side of the work.

**dc** = double crochet

#### SIZE

One size

#### **MEASUREMENTS**

Approx. 105 x 140 cm/41 x 55 inches

#### **PATTERN INFORMATION**

The blanket is worked in sc, dc and bobble stitches giving it a pretty texture and making it a fun project to do.

## **Pattern**







#### **TIPS AND INFO**

The blanket is worked in a stitch multiple of 3.

Each row is turned with a ch1 or ch2 – these do not count as a stitch.

Every even row will end with ch2 and turn, every odd row will end with ch1 and turn.

Every odd row: 105 dc.

The blanket is made with 2 different rows of bobble stitch:

**Bobble stitch row A:** 4 sc, \*bobble stitch, 3 sc\*, repeat \* - \* 24 times until 4 sts remain, 4 sc. **Bobble stitch row B:** 3 sc, \*3 sc, bobble stitch\*, repeat \* - \* 24 times until 6 sts remain, 6 sc.

#### **BLANKET**

With crochet hook 8 mm (US L-11), chain 105.

Row 1: chain 2 more. Starting in the 3. Ch from the needle, make 1 dc in each ch across. (105), ch

Row 2: 1 sc in each st across (105), ch 2, turn.

Row 3 and every odd row from now on: 1 dc in each st across (105), ch 1, turn.

Row 4: 1 sc in each st across. (105)

Row 6: 1 sc in each st across. (105)

Row 8: Bobble stitch row A.

Row 10: Bobble stitch row B.

Row 12: Bobble stitch row A.

Row 14: Bobble stitch row B.

Row 16: 1 sc in each st across. (105)

Row 18: 1 sc in each st across. (105)

Row 20: Bobble stitch row A.

Row 22: Bobble stitch row B.

Row 24: Bobble stitch row A.

Row 26: Bobble stitch row B.

Row 28: 1 sc in each st across. (105)

Row 30: 1 sc in each st across. (105)

Row 32: 1 sc in each st across. (105)

Row 34: 1 sc in each st across. (105)

Row 36: 1 sc in each st across. (105)

Row 38: Bobble stitch row A.

Row 40: Bobble stitch row B.



Row 42: 1 sc in each st across. (105) Row 44: 1 sc in each st across. (105) Row 46: Bobble stitch row A. Row 48: Bobble stitch row B. Row 50: 1 sc in each st across. (105) Row 52: 1 sc in each st across. (105) Row 54: Bobble stitch row B. Row 56: Bobble stitch row A. Row 58: 1 sc in each st across. (105) Row 60: 1 sc in each st across. (105) Row 62: Bobble stitch row B. Row 64: Bobble stitch row A. Row 66: 1 sc in each st across. (105) Row 68: 1 sc in each st across. (105) Row 70: 1 sc in each st across. (105) Row 72: 1 sc in each st across. (105) Row 74: 1 sc in each st across. (105) Row 76: Bobble stitch row B. Row 78: 1 sc in each st across. (105) Row 80: 1 sc in each st across. (105) Row 82: 1 sc in each st across. (105) Row 84: 1 sc in each st across. (105) Row 86: 1 sc in each st across. (105) Row 88: Bobble stitch row A. Row 90: 1 sc in each st across. (105) Row 92: 1 sc in each st across. (105) Row 94: 1 sc in each st across. (105) Row 96: 1 sc in each st across. (105) Row 98: 1 sc in each st across. (105) Row 100: Bobble stitch row B. Row 102: 1 sc in each st across. (105) Row 104: 1 sc in each st across. (105) Row 106: 1 sc in each st across. (105) Row 108: 1 sc in each st across. (105) Row 110: 1 sc in each st across. (105) Row 112: 1 sc in each st across. (105) Row 114: 1 sc in each st across. (105) Row 115: 1 dc in each st across. (105) Do not cut yarn.

#### **EDGE**

The edge is made up of one round of sc and one round of dc.

Start on the left side next to the last dc from row 115.

Work alternately 1 and 2 sc in the side of each dc. In the side of each sc work 1 sc.

(This should ensure a neat and even edge.)

Along the top and bottom, work 1 sc in each st across. In the corners work 3 sc in one st. SI st in the first st to join.

Work one round of dc with 3 dc in the middle sc in the corners.

Fasten off and cut yarn.
