



CROCHET PATTERN

Cornelius

Children's Cardigan

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MATERIALS

Baby Cotton Organic:
2 (2) 2 skeins of Lemon (26)
2 (2) 2 skeins of Blush (20)
1 (1) 1 skein of Powder Blue (37)

Diablo:


1 (1) 1 skein of Limoncello (19)
1 (1) 1 skein of Syringa (34)
1 (1) 1 skein of Pastel Blue (33)

Crochet hook 4 mm

6 x Coconut button, Flower, 18 mm - Bright Blue (64)

YARN QUALITY

 **Baby Cotton Organic**, Hobbii
100% Egyptian Cotton
50 gr = 170 m

 **Diablo**, Hobbii
40% Acrylic, 30% Mohair, 30% Polyamide
25 g (0.9 oz) = 225 m (246 yds)

GAUGE

10 x 10 cm (4" x 4") = *19 sts* x 20 rows
Worked through back loop only

ABBREVIATIONS

Sc = single crochet
Sl st = slip stitch
Ch = chain

SIZE

3-6 months (6-12 months) 12-18 months

MEASUREMENTS

Length: 32 (34) 36 cm/
Width: 25,5 (27,5) 29,5 cm

PATTERN INFORMATION

The Cornelius Children's Cardigan is a soft and comfy cardigan worked in one strand of Baby Cotton Organic and one strand of Diablo, giving it a look that is both soft and firm.

TIPS AND INFO

The Cornelius Children's Cardigan is worked in multiple parts that are then joined to make up the finished garment.

Unless otherwise instructed all rows end with a ch-1 turning chain.

BACK PANEL

Start with Baby Cotton Organic, Lemon (26) + Diablo, Limoncello (19).

chain 48 (52) 56 + a ch-1 turning chain

Rows 1-5: 1 sc through back loop only in each st across (48 (52) 56 sts).

Change to Baby Cotton Organic, Blush (20) + Diablo, Syringa (34), from this point you will change color every 5. row.

Work 1 sc through back loop only in each st across until and including row 44 (49) 54.

Row 45 (50) 55: Work 10 (12) 14 sc through back loop only to shape one shoulder. Break yarn, skip 28 (28) 28 sts, work 10 (12) 14 sc through back loop only to shape the other shoulder. Fasten off and break yarn.

RIGHT FRONT PANEL

Start with Baby Cotton Organic, Lemon (26) + Diablo, Limoncello (19).

Chain 24 (26) 28 + ch-1 turning chain.

Rows 1-5: 1 sc through back loop only in each st across (24 (26) 28 sts).

Change to Baby Cotton Organic, Blush (20) + Diablo, Syringa (34), from this point on you will change color every 5. row.

Work 1 sc through back loop only in each st across until and including row 42 (47) 52. Break yarn, turn work, skip 14 (14) 14 sts, start new row and work 3 rows of 10 (12) 14 sc through back loop only to shape the other shoulder. Fasten off and break yarn.

LEFT FRONT PANEL

Start with Baby Cotton Organic, Lemon (26) + Diablo, Limoncello (19).

Chain 24 (26) 28 + ch-1 turning chain.

Rows 1-5: 1 sc through back loop only in each st across (24 (26) 28 sts).

Change to Baby Cotton Organic, Blush (20) + Diablo, Syringa (34), from this point you will change color every 5. row.

Work 1 sc through back loop only in each st across until and including row 42 (47) 52.

Then work 3 rows of 10 (12) 14 sc through back loop only to shape the left shoulder. Fasten off and break yarn.

SLEEVES (MAKE 2)

Start with Baby Cotton Organic, Blush (20) + Diablo, Syringa (34).

Chain 36 (38) 40 + ch-1 turning chain.

Rows 1-5: 1 sc through back loop only in each st across (36 (38) 40 sts).

Change to Baby Cotton Organic, Blush (20) + Diablo, Syringa (34), from this point you will change color every 5. row.

Work 1 sc through back loop only in each st across until and including row 30 (35) 40. Fasten off and break yarn.

RIBBING

Cuffs (make 2)

Chain 4 (4) 4 + ch-1 turning chain.

Work 36 (38) 40 rows of 1 sl st through back loop only in each st across (4 sts).

Finally, you will crochet the ends together along the 4 sts to make a ring, continue to joining.

Bottom hem

Chain 12 (12) 12 + ch-1 turning chain.

Work 96 (104) 112 rows of 1 sl st through back loop only in each st across (12 (12) 12 sts). Continue to joining.

Collar

Chain 10 (11) 12 + ch-1 turning chain.

Work 64 (64) 64 rows of sl st through back loop only in each st across (10 (11) 12 sts). + ch-1 turning chain.

BUTTON BANDS

Button band (right)

Chain 4 (4) 4 + ch-1 turning chain.

Work 64 (70) 76 rows of 1 sl st through back loop only in each st across (4 sts). Continue to joining.

Buttonhole band (left)

Chain 4 (4) 4 + ch-1 turning chain.

Work 3 (4) 4 rows of 1 sl st through back loop only in each st across (4 sts).

Work one buttonhole: sl st, ch 2 and skip 2 sts, sl st.

*Work 12 (13) 14 rows of sl st through back loop only

Work one buttonhole: sl st, ch 2 and skip 2 sts, sl st*

REPEAT 4 times.

Work 4 (5) 6 rows of sl st through back loop only in each st across.

Work one buttonhole: sl st, ch 2 and skip 2 sts, sl st.

Work 3 (3) 4 rows of sl st through back loop only in each st across. Continue to joining.

JOINING

Place the two front panels on top of the back panel, right sides touching and working from the wrong side, sl st together across the shoulders.

Now align the sleeves with the main body, making sure the starting chain of each sleeve is placed under the arm and the rest of the stitches are divided evenly, the shoulder seam being the middle point. Working from the wrong side, sl st the sleeves onto the main body, placing one sl st in every row.

Then crochet along back and front panels together along the sides with a sl st in each row and continue along the sleeves, also with a sl st in each row.

Place the cuffs around the edge of each sleeve, right sides facing and join with one sl st in each row/st all around.

The bottom hem is placed on top of the main body, right sides facing, and openings aligned. Working from the wrong side, join with a sl st in each row/st.

Join the collar to the neck opening using the same procedure.

The button bands are joined to the front panels with a sl st in each row worked from the wrong side, placing the band with the buttonholes on the left, and the other on the right. Attach the buttons on the button band parallel with the buttonholes on the opposite side.
