MATERIALS

3 (4) skein(s) of Bungee Mini color 11 or Bungee Mini color 02

Straight needle 10 mm (US 15) Circular needle 12 mm (US 17), 80 cm (31.5")

Handbag handles 60 cm (23.6"), color Apricot *or* Brown

YARN QUALITY

Bungee Mini, Hobbii 42 % Cotton, 58 % Polyester 200 g (7.0 oz) = 62 m (68 yds)

GAUGE 10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 7 sts x 13 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit P = PurlSt(s) = Stitch(es)C/on = Cast on C/off = Cast off Dec c/off = Decrease cast off - K2tog from the back of the loop then slip the stitch back to the left needle, repeat to the end of the row PM = Place your marker RM = Remove your marker SM = Slide your marker M = Marker Kf&b = knit in the front and then the back of the same stitch with the yarn at the back of the work

SIZE Small (Large)

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 57 (65) cm / 22.4" (25.6") Height: 25 (33) cm / 9.8" (13")

PATTERN INFORMATION

The perfect bag for a day at the market. The base is knitted flat and the body in the round.

INFO AND TIPS

The base is the same for both sizes, the larger size is a continuity of the smaller size.

BASE (worked flat)

C/on 10 (10) sts on 10mm (US 15) straight needles Rows 1 to 35 – Knit 35 rows C/off all the sts and make secure, cut the yarn and leave a 50 cm (19.6") tail Fold the piece lengthwise in half and sew all three sides with their opposite with the tail

BODY (worked in the round)

12mm (US 17) circular needles

Starting at one corner of the base going towards a longer side, pick up 19 sts, PM on the corner, pick up 3 sts on the shorter side, PM on the other corner, pick up another 19 sts on the other long side, PM on the third corner, pick up 4 sts on the last side and PM (make sure your last M is different to highlight the end of your round)

You now have 45 sts on your circular needles and you are going to build up the body for your basket from there:

Row 1 – (P1, K1) repeat up to the last st, P1 Row 2 – (K1, P1) repeat up to the last st, K1 Row 3 – (P1, K1) repeat up to the last st, P1 Row 4 – (K1, P1) repeat up to the last st, K1

Row 5 – Kf&b (K1, P1) repeat up to 2 sts before M, K1, Kf&b, SM, Kf&b, P1, Kf&b, SM, Kf&b, (K1, P1) repeat up to 2 sts before M, K1, Kf&b, SM, Kf&b, P1, K1, Kf&B, SM (53 sts)

Rows 6 to 9 – Repeat row 1 to 4

Row 10 – Kf&b (P1, K1) repeat up to 2 sts before M, K1, Kf&b, SM, Kf&b, (P1, K1) repeat up to 2 sts before M, P1, Kf&b, SM, Kf&b, (K1, P1) repeat up to 2 sts before M, K1, Kf&b, SM, Kf&b, (P1, K1) repeat up to 3 sts before M, P1, K1, Kf&b, SM (61 sts)



Rows 11 to 14 - Repeat row 1 to 4

SMALL SIZE

Repeat rows 10 to 14 three more times (85 sts)

LARGE SIZE

Repeat rows 10 to 14 five more times (101 sts) Next row – (P1, K1) repeat up to the last st, P1 Next row – (K1, P1) repeat up to the last st, K1 Next row – (P1, K1) repeat up to the last st, P1 Next row – (K1, P1) repeat up to the last st, K1

ALL SIZES

Dec/off all the sts and RM, cut the yarn and make secure

Weave in all ends and add the handles in the centre of your basket 27 cm (10.6 ") apart for the large size and 13 cm (5.1") apart for the small size

TIP: At the end of your tail cut 1cm off the inside white filling (only) so you won't see it when you weave in your ends
