Design: Knit Gang | Hobbii Design

MATERIALS

11 (11) 12 skeins of Rainbow Cotton 8/8
color Dark Powder Rose 064

Knitting needles 4 mm (US 4), 5 mm (US 8)
Tapestry needle

YARN QUALITY

 **Rainbow Cotton 8/8**, Hobbii
100% cotton,
50 g (1.8 oz) = 75 m (82 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 21 sts x 28 rows
(leaf pattern)

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 24 sts x 28 rows
(trinity stitch)

ABBREVIATIONS

st/s = stitch/es
k = knit
p = purl
k3tog = knit 3 sts together
p3tog = purl 3 sts together
dec = decrease
inc = increase
CO = Cast On
BO = Bind Off

SIZE

S (M) L

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 50 (54) 58 cm / 19.6" (21.2") 22.8"
Length: 52 (56) 60 cm / 20.4" (22") 23.6"
Armhole, circumference (all sizes): 55 cm/21.6"

PATTERN INFORMATION

Loose top with interesting texture, made of cotton. Perfect for warm summer evenings! The stitches used in the pattern seem difficult but their repetitive nature makes you a pro in no time!

INFO AND TIPS

The blouse consists of two identical parts, sewn together at the end.

NOTE: The stitches used in the pattern seem difficult but their repetitive nature makes you a pro in no time!

Stitches used in the pattern

Rib stitch: k2, p2.

Stockinette stitch: purl in odd rows, knit in even rows.

Trinity stitch:

row 1: k across,

row 2: make 3 sts from one st (k, YO, k), p3tog- repeat to the last st, k in the last st,

row 3: p across,

row 4: p3tog, 3 sts from one st (k, YO, k)- repeat to the last st, k in the last st,

row 5: p across.

Repeat rows 2-5.

Leaf pattern: see the chart at the end of the pattern.

BODY

The back and front are made the same way.

CO 114 (132) 147 sts on 5 mm needle. Work 12 rows in a rib stitch (k2, p2).

In the 13th row start to work the leaf pattern (lp) and the trinity stitch (ts) as follows:

Size S: 1 edge st, 22 ts, 23 lp, 22 ts, 23 lp, 22 ts, 1 edge st;

Size (M): 1 edge st, 28 ts, 23 lp, 28 ts, 23 lp, 28 ts, 1 edge st;

Size L: 1 edge st, 33 ts, 23 lp, 33 ts, 23 lp, 33 ts, 1 edge st.

Work until the leaf pattern is complete, a total of 7 (7) 8 times.

Then, to change the arrangement of the patterns, i.e. to put the leaf pattern in the middle, work as follows:

Size S: 1 edge st, 44 ts, 23 lp, 45 ts, 1 edge st;

Size (M): 1 edge st, 53 ts, 23 lp, 54 ts, 1 edge st;

Size L: 1 edge st, 61 ts, 23 lp, 61 ts, 1 edge st.

Work until the leaf pattern is complete, a total of 6 (7) 8 times, and change to 4 mm needles.

Knit 10 rows in rib stitch (k2, p2). BO all sts.

Make the second piece in the same way.

Neckline

Sew the two pieces together on the shoulders, leaving approx. 26 cm / 10.2" for the neckline.

Armholes

Sew the sides together leaving approx. 28 cm/10" for the armholes.

Make the armhole ribbing like this: Pick up 150 sts with the 4 mm needle and work 10 rounds in rib stitch (k2, p2), BO

↑ - slip 1 st, k2tog, pass the slipped stitch over the knitted stitch

In even rows work YO sts as a purl sts.
