## **MATERIALS**

1 skein of Amigo XL col. Dark Beige (A04)

1 skein of Amigo XL col. Sand (A03)

1 skein of Amigo col. Royal Blue (A19)

1 skein of Amigo col. Chocolate (A06)

1 skein of Amigo col. Sunflower (A36)

Crochet hook 4 mm (US G-6) Crochet hook 2.75 mm (US C-2)

Yarn needle Stuffing Sewing pins Stitch markers

# YARN QUALITY

**Amigo XL**, Hobbii 100% HB acrylic 50 g (1.8 oz) = 100 m (109 yds)

**Amigo**, Hobbii 100% HB acrylic 50 g (1.8 oz) = 175 m (191 yds)

# **ABBREVIATIONS**

Mc = magic circle ch = chain sc = single crochet inc = single crochet increase dec = single crochet decrease sl st = slip stitch

## SIZE

One size

### **MEASUREMENTS**

Height: Approx. 5" (12.7 cm)

# **Pattern**







## **INFO AND TIPS**

This pattern is worked in the round, unless otherwise indicated. Use a stitch marker to indicate the first stitch of each round.

### **Pancake**

Work with Amigo XL - Dark Beige (A04) and a size 4mm hook:

Start: 8 sc in mc (8)

Rnd 1: inc in each (16)

Rnd 2: (inc 1, sc 1)x8 (24)

Rnd 3: (sc 2, inc 1)x8 (32)

Rnd 4: (inc 1, sc 3)x8 (40)

Rnd 5: (sc 4, inc 1)x8 (48)

Rnd 6: sc 2, inc (sc 5, inc 1)x7, sc 3 (56)

Rnd 7: (sc 6, inc 1)x8 (64)

Rnd 8: sc 4, inc (sc 7, inc 1)x7, sc 3 (72)

Rnd 9: Change to Amigo XL (Sand), sl st, ch 1, sc around

Rnd 10: sc around (72)

Rnd 11: Change to <u>Amigo XL- Dark Beige</u>, sl st, ch 1, sc 3, dec, (sc 7, dec)x7, sc 3 (64)

Rnd 12: (sc 6, dec) x8 (56)

Rnd 13: sc 2, dec, (sc 5, dec)x7, sc 3 (48)

Rnd 14: (sc 4, dec 1)x8 (40)

Rnd 15: (dec 1, sc 3)x8 (32)

Rnd 16: (sc 2, dec 1)x8 (24)

Add stuffing

Rnd 17: (dec 1, sc 1)x8 (16)

Rnd 18: Dec in each (8)

Sew the hole shut and weave in the end.

# **Maple Syrup**

Work with Amigo - Chocolate and a 2.75mm hook

Start: 6 sc in a mc (6)

Round 1: Inc in each sc (12)

R2: (Inc, sc) x6 (18)

R3: (Inc, sc 2) x6 (24)

R4: (Inc, sc 3) x6 (30)



R5: SI st, ch 10, in the second ch from the hook sc 9 back to the base (From here on out **scBB means sc back to the base**. The A.) B.) C.)'s are to help you keep track of where you are),

- A.) sl st 2, ch 5, scBB, sl st, ch 8, scBB,
- B.) sl st 2, ch 10, scBB, sl st, ch 8, scBB, sl st 2,
- C.) ch 5, scBB, sl st, ch 8, scBB, sl st 2, ch 10, scBB, sl st,
- D.) ch 5, scBB, sl st 2, ch 8, scBB, sl st, ch 10, scBB, sl st 2,
- E.) ch 5, scBB, sl st, ch 8, scBB, sl st 2, ch 10, scBB, sl st,
- F.) ch 5, scBB, sl st 2, ch 8, scBB, sl st 2,
- G.) ch 10, scBB, sl st 1, ch 5, scBB, sl st 2, ch 8, scBB, sl st, leave a long tail and finish off

## **Blueberries**

Work with <u>Amigo - Royal Blue</u> and a 2.75mm hook Make 5
Start: 6 sc in a mc (6)
Round 1: sc around (6)
Finish off leaving a tail for sewing

## **Butter**

Work with <u>Amigo - Sunflower</u> and a 2.75mm hook. We will be working in rows, be sure to ch 1 and turn at the end of each row.

Row 1: ch 8, in the second ch from the hook, sc across (7)

Row 2-3: sc across (7)

Row 4: sc across and work 3 sc in the last stitch, rotate your work and crochet along the other 3 sides of the butter, placing 3 sc in each of the remaining 3 corners, finish off and leave a long tail, fold the rectangle in half and sew it shut on the 3 sides.

Assemble the pancake by viewing the assembly instructions below.

# **INSTRUCTIONS**

# How to color change



1. In your last sc of dark beige, yarn over and pull through



2. Add your new color by pulling the new color through the two loops to complete the last sc on the round












5. The ch 1 will count as a stitch and this is where you will put your stitch marker to indicate the first stitch of the round

# **Assembly**



1. Here's what the pancake and maple syrup will look like



2. Pin the maple syrup down to the pancake



3. Pin the butter to the centre of the pancake 4. Sew or glue the maple syrup, butter, and and the blueberries equally around the butter
