



CROCHET PATTERN

Primrose Pixie

Bonnet

MATERIALS

1 skein of Rainbow Bamboo color 03

Crochet hook 3mm (US D/3)

YARN QUALITY

Rainbow Bamboo, Hobbii 60 % bamboo, 40 % cotton 100 g (3.5 oz) = 250 m (273 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4'' x 4'') = 23 dc x 10 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain
sc = single crochet
dc = double crochet
slst = slip stitch
[] = in the same stitch
* * = repeat

SIZE

Preemie (Newborn) 0-3 Months (3-6 Months) 6-12 Months (1-2 Years) 3-4 Years

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 13 (13.5) 14 (15) 16 (18) 19 cm / 5 (5.25) 5.5 (5.75) 6.5 (7) 7.5 inches

Length, top to bottom, when folded in half: 13 (14) 15 (16.5) 18 (19) 20cm / 5 (5.5) 6 (6.5) 7 (7.5) 8 inches

PATTERN INFORMATION

This bonnet is made by crocheting a rectangle, then folding in half and sewing up the first row to make a pixie style bonnet.

INFO AND TIPS

This bonnet is made using the primrose stitch.

The ch2 and ch3 at the start of the row counts as a stitch.

Start with a long end (this will be used to sew up the back of the bonnet) so that you can continue with the ties without having to cut the yarn.

There is a photoguide on the last page. My example is a size newborn.

After completing row 1 and 2, ensure the length is 25.5 (28) 30.5 (33) 35.5 (38) 41 cm / 10 (11) 12 (13) 14 (15) 16 inches.

Beanie, all sizes

Starting with a long end, chain 59 (65) 71 (77) 83 (89) 95 stitches.

Row 1: starting in the third chain from hook, * [sc, ch2, sc in the same chain], skip 2 chains] * repeat to the last two chains, skip 1, hdc in the last. Turn

Row 2: ch3, [3 dc] in the ch2 space in the row below, [3 dc] in each ch2 space to end, ending with a dc in the top of the turning chain from the end of the previous row. Turn.

Row 3: ch2, skip 1 * [sc, ch2, sc], skip 2 sts] * repeat to the last two stitches, skip 1, hdc in the last. Turn

Repeat rows 2 and 3 until work measures the correct width (front to back for the size you are making): 13 (13.5) 14 (15) 16 (18) 19 cm / 5 (5.25) 5.5 (5.75) 6.5 (7) 7.5 inches

Joining

Fold in half and sew up the first row, using the long end from the start. (This will be the back of the bonnet). Continue from where you left off and chain 52 (56) 60 (64) 68 (72) 76 to make the first tie.

Sc in the second chain from the hook and each chain back to the bonnet, sc around the back of the bonnet, decreasing a few along the middle to taper the bonnet in at the back.



When you reach the other side, chain 52 (56) 60 (64) 68 (72) 76 to make the second tie, sc in the second chain from hook then each chain back to the bonnet, slst to the bonnet.

Fasten off and sew in the ends.
