# Winter Shells

**Poncho - Child**

#### **MATERIALS**

2 (3, 3, 4) skeins of Light Gray (12) 2 (3, 3, 4) skeins of Super Kid Silk, Light Gray (07

Crochet hook 6 mm (US J)

# **YARN QUALITY**

Evergreen Organic Wool, Hobbii 100% Wool/ 50 g (1.75 oz) = 230 meter (252 yds)

**Super Kid Silk**, Mayflower 76% Mohair, 24% Silk 25 g (0,9 oz) = 195 m (213 yards)

#### **GAUGE**

10 cm x 10 cm (4'' x 4'') = 16 sts x 1 rows

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

Ch - chain
Sc - single crochet
Sl st - slip stitch
St(s) - stitch (es)
DC- Double crochet
HDC - Half double crochet

#### SIZE

3/4 (5/6) 7/8 (9/10) years

#### **MEASUREMENTS**

Each Section measures approx: 9½x17 (10½x19) 12x21 (13x13) Inches/ 24x44 (27x49) 30x54 (33x59) cm

Measurements - finished poncho Length from neck opening to front point 14 (15½) 17 (19) inches/ 36 (40) 44 (48) cm

Length from neck opening to end of sleeve 10 (11½) 12½ (13½) inches/ 26 (29) 32 (35) cm

#### **ABOUT THE PATTERN**

Pattern is worked holding 1 strand of Evergreen and 1 strand of Super Kid Silk together.

Pattern is repeatable with 6+5

#### **INFO AND TIPS**

#### **PATTERN**

- **1.** Ch 41(47)53(59). Sc 1 in the second ch from the hook. Sc the remainder of the row. 40(46)52(58)
- 2. Ch 3 and turn. Dc 2 in first st. "Skip 2, sc 1 in next st. Skip 2, dc 5 in next st". Repeat from " to " until you have 3 st left. Sc 1 in last st.
- **3.** Ch 3 and turn. Dc 2 in first st. "Skip 2, sc 1 in next st. Skip 2, dc 5 in next st". Repeat from " to " until you have 3 st left. Sc 1 in last st.

Repeat row 3 until your work measures 17(19)21(23) inches.

## Finish with this row:


Ch 1 and turn. "Sc 1 in the next 5 st, hdc 1 in next st". Repeat from " to " until you have 3 st left. Sc 1 in the last 3 st. Fasten off and weave in ends.

Crochet one more piece exactly the same.



# **ASSEMBLY**

Sew your work as illustrated in the picture below. The red lines indicate where the pieces should be sewn together.



# **NECK**

Note: Start every round with ch 1 and finish it with sl st 1.

Sc two rounds around the edge of the neck. Fasten off and weave in ends.





# **EDGING**

**Note**: Start every round with ch 1 and finish it with sl st 1. Sc one round around the edge of the poncho. In the point st, sc 3. Sc another round, but with only sc 2 in the points. Fasten off and weave in ends.





# **GUIDE - PATTERN**

### Row 1



1. Make your chain.

#### Row 2



1. Sc 1 in the second ch from the hook. Sc the remainder of the row.

#### Row 3



1. Ch 3 and turn.



2. In the first stitch (marked here by the needle),



3. dc 2.



4. Skip 2 st,





5. sc 1 in next st.



6. Skip 2 st,



7. dc 5 in the next st.



8. Skip 2 st.,



9. sc 1 in next st.



10. Skip 2 st,





11. dc 5 in next st.



12. Repeat like this the rest of the row until you have 3 st left.



13. In the last st (marked here by the needle),



14. sc 1.

# Row 4



1. Ch 3 and turn.



2. In the first st (as marked by the needle),







3. dc 2.

4. Skip 2 st,





5. sc 1 in next st.

6. Skip 2 st,





7. dc 5 in next st.

8. Skip 2 st,





9. sc 1 in next st.

10. Skip 2 st,





11. dc 5 in next st.



12. Repeat like this the rest of the row until you have 3 st left.



13. In the last st (marked here by the needle),



14 .sc 1. Repeat row 3 as described in the pattern.

# **GUIDE - FINISHING ROW**



1. Ch 1 and turn.



2. Sc 1 in the next 5 st.





3. In the next st (marked here by the needle),



4. hdc 1.



5. Sc 1 in the next 5 st.



6. In the next st (marked here by the needle),



7. hdc 1.



8. Repeat this for the rest of the row. Fasten off and weave in ends.
