### **MATERIALS**

To make 4 placemats:

Yarn A: 2 skeins of Twister Solid color 121

Yarn B: 1 skein of Twister Solid color 105

Crochet hook 4 mm (US G/6) Tapestry needle

# **YARN QUALITY**

Twister Solid, Hobbii

55% Cotton, 45% Acrylic 100 g = 400 m

#### **GAUGE**

Exact gauge is not needed for this pattern but try to keep your tension consistent throughout.

# **ABBREVIATIONS**

sc = single crochet
dc = double crochet
sl st = slip stitch

### **SIZE**

One size

### **MEASUREMENTS**

Placemat diameter: 26.7cm / 10.5"

# **INFO AND TIPS**

The placemats are worked in tapestry crochet with the yarn held double at all times. Before you begin, you will need to split the 1 skein of Twister solid color 105 into two 50g balls so you can hold the yarn double.

When you are making your first stitch of each round make sure your tension is not too tight.

#### **PLACEMAT**

Make an adjustable ring with Yarn A held double.

**Round 1**: 12dc in ring, pull tight, join with a sl st to first st – 12dc. Fasten off.

**Round 2**: Change to Yarn B, held double. 2dc in first st of Rnd 1, 2dc in each of next 11 sts, sl st to join – 24dc.

**Round 3**: 2dc in first st of Rnd 2, 1dc in next st, [2dc in next st, 1dc in next st] around, sl st to join – 36 dc.

**Round 4**: 1dc in first st of Rnd 3, 2dc in next st, 2dc, 2dc in next st, [change to Yarn A, 1dc working over Yarn B, change to Yarn B, 1dc working over Yarn A, 2dc in next st working over Yarn A, 2dc working over Yarn A, 2dc in next st working over Yarn A] 5 times, change to Yarn A, 1dc working over Yarn B, make last yo in Yarn B and sl st to join – 48dc.

**Round 5**: 1dc in first st of Rnd 4 working over Yarn A, 2dc working over Yarn A, 2dc in next st working over Yarn A, 3dc working over Yarn A, [change to Yarn A, 2dc in next st working over Yarn B, change to Yarn B, 3dc working over Yarn A, 2dc in next st working over Yarn A, 3dc working over Yarn A] five times, change to Yarn A, 2dc in next st working over Yarn B, make last yo in Yarn B and sl st to join – 60dc.



**Round 6**: 1dc in first st of Rnd 5 working over Yarn A, 3dc working over Yarn A, 2dc in next st working over Yarn A, 3dc working over Yarn A [change to Yarn A, 1dc working over Yarn B, 2dc in next st working over Yarn B, change to Yarn B, 4dc working over Yarn A, 2dc in next st working over Yarn A, 3dc working over Yarn A] five times, change to Yarn A, 1dc working over Yarn B, 2dc in next st working over Yarn B, make last yo in Yarn B, sl st to join – 72dc. Pull up a long loop with Yarn B.

**Round 7**: Insert hook into the first st of Rnd 6, Yarn over in Yarn A, pull yarn though and 1dc into first st of Rnd 6 working over Yarn B and the long loop. Instead of making your last yo in Yarn B, use the long loop you have made and pull tight. 3dc working over Yarn A, 2dc in next st working over Yarn A, 3dc working over Yarn A, [change to Yarn A, 2dc working over Yarn B, 2dc in next st working over Yarn B, 2dc working over Yarn B, 3dc working over Yarn A, 2dc in next st working over Yarn A, 3dc working over Yarn A] five times, change to Yarn A, 2dc working over Yarn B, 2dc into next st working over Yarn B, 1dc working over Yarn B, sl st to join. Fasten off Yarn B – 84dc

**Round 8**: 1dc into first st of Rnd 7, 4dc, 2dc into next st, [6dc, 2dc into next st] eleven times, 1dc, sl st to join. – 96dc

**Round 9**: 1dc into first st of Rnd 8, 1dc, 2dc into next st [7dc, 2dc into next st] eleven times, 5dc, sl st to join – 108dc

**Round 10**: 1dc into first st of Rnd 9, 1dc, change to Yarn B, 4dc working over Yarn A, 2dc into next st working over Yarn A, 4dc working over Yarn A [change to Yarn A, 4dc working over Yarn B, 2dc in next st working over Yarn B, 4dc working over Yarn A, change to Yarn B, 4dc working over Yarn B, 2dc into next st working over Yarn A, 4dc working over Yarn A] five times, change to Yarn A, 4dc working over Yarn B, 2dc into next st working over Yarn B, 2dc working over Yarn B, sl st to join – 120dc

**Round 11**: 4dc working over Yarn B, change to Yarn B, 5dc working over Yarn A, 2dc into next st working over Yarn A [change to Yarn A, 9dc working over Yarn B, 2dc into next st working over Yarn B, 4dc working over Yarn, change to Yarn B, 5dc working over Yarn A, 2dc into next st working over Yarn A] five times, change to Yarn A, 9dc working over Yarn B, 2dc into next st, sl st to join – 132dc. Fasten off Yarn B.

**Round 12**: 6dc, 2dc into next st [10dc, 2dc into next st] eleven times, 4dc, sl st to join – 144dc

Round 13: [11sc, 2sc into next st] twelve times, sl st to join – 156 sc

Fasten off and sew in ends.
