



KNITTING PATTERN

Aqua

Sweater

Design: Wolle Rapunzel | Hobbii Design

MATERIALS

2 (2) 3 (3) skeins of Kind Feather, colour 17

Straight needles 4mm (US 6)

YARN QUALITY

 **Kind Feather**

100% Polyacrylic

100g (3.5 oz) = 235 m (257 yd)

GAUGE

21 sts and 30 rows =

10 x 10 cm stockinette stitch with 4,0 mm

(US 6) needles

ABBREVIATIONS

St = stitch

K = knit

P = purl

K1 P1 = knit 1, purl 1 (alternate in each row, to get the seed stitch)

SELV = edge stitch

K3 P3 = Rib stitch knitting (right row: K3, P3 repeat for the whole row, wrong row: P3,

K3 repeat for the whole row)

SIZE

2 (3) 4 (5) Years

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 27 (30) 33 (36) cm / 10,6" (12") 13" (14")

Length: 33 (34) 38 (40) cm / 13" (13,4") 15" (15,7")

PATTERN INFORMATION

The front- and back panel are each worked in one piece with the sleeves.

INFO AND TIPS

At the beginning and end of each row, regardless of the pattern, there is always worked an edge stitch until you start the sleeve increase = first stitch is always K stitch, slipping the last st as if to purl with thread in front of the needle.

When you cast off the st, always cast off the same way you would have knitted them.

Before sewing the front and back panel together, turn them inside out and steam them with a wet towel. Due to the Rib pattern, the sweater will reach its final shape after steaming it.

BACK PANEL

Cars on 56 (62) 68 (74) St with straight needle 4,0 mm.

Wok 2 cm with seed stitch pattern (K1, P1 and alternate in next row).

After that, work in rib stitch (K3, P3).

After 21 (21) 24 (25) cm start to knit the sleeves.

SLEEVES

For the sleeves, increase at the end of the front and back rows with an additional st, you cast on and work in the same way as the pattern in all the following rows, but do not work any edge stitches.

1. Sleeve increase: 1 x 4 (4) 5 (5) st.
2. Sleeve increase: 1 x 6 (6) 6 (6) st.
3. Sleeve increase: 1 x 10 (10) 12 (12) st.

There are now 96 (102) 114 (120) st on the needle.

Work the first 6 st and the last 6 st after the 3rd sleeve increase in seed stitch (K1, P1), start the seed stitch with P1 on the right edge and on the left edge strat sthe seed stitch with K 1. Work the remaining stitches in the same way as the previous rib pattern.

When your peace mesures (9)/(10)/11/(12) cm after the first sleeve increase, start to knit the neckline.

Neckline:

1. Work 26 (29) 35 (38) st in the same way as the previous pattern (6 st in seed stitch, 20 (23) 29 (32) st rib pattern.)
2. Work 44 st with seed stitch (start the row with K1)
3. Work 26 (29) 35 (38) st in the same way as the previous pattern, 20 (23) 29 (32) st in rib stitch, 6 st in seed stitch.

Work another 2 cm in this pattern and then work from the right side as follows:

Work 32 (35) 41 (44) st in the same way as the previous pattern, cast of 32 st, work 32 (35) 41 (44) st in the same way as the previous pattern.

Work each shoulder separately:

Work another cm in seed pattern over the 32 (35) 41 (44) st and then cast off all stitches.

Finish the other shoulder in the opposite way. Cast off all st.

FRONT PANEL

Work the same way as you did in the back panel, but start the neckline already 6 (7) 8 (9) cm after the first increase for the sleeves and work each shoulder up to the same total height of the back piece. Work the pattern for the front panel identical from the back panel.

Finishing touches

Turn the front and back panel inside out and stretch it under a wet towel and steam at the lowest level, let the pieces dry under the towel. Sew shoulder seams, side edges and bottom edge of sleeves and sew up all treads.
