## MATERIALS

To make 4 coasters:

Yarn A: 1 skein of Twister Solid color 121

Yarn B: 1 skein of Twister Solid color 105

Crochet hook 4 mm (US G/6)

## YARN QUALITY

 Twister Solid, Hobbii

55% Cotton, 45% Acrylic

100 g = 400 m

## GAUGE

Exact gauge is not needed for this pattern but try to keep your tension consistent throughout.

## ABBREVIATIONS

sc = single crochet

dc = double crochet

sl st = slip stitch

## SIZE

One size

## MEASUREMENTS

Coaster diameter: 13cm / 5.1"

Homeware inspired by 60s icon Mary Quant and retro monochromatic floral design.

# Pattern



## INFO AND TIPS

The coasters are worked in tapestry crochet with the yarn held double at all times. Before you begin, you will need to split the skeins of Twister Solid into two 50g balls each, so you can hold the yarn double. When you are making your first st of each Round make sure your tension is not too tight.

## COASTER

Make an adjustable ring with Yarn A held double.

Round 1: 12dc in ring, pull tight, join with a sl st to first st – 12dc. Fasten off.

Round 2: Change to Yarn B, held double. 2dc in first st of Rnd 1, 2dc in each of next 11 sts, sl st to join – 24dc.

Round 3: Rejoin Yarn A, in Yarn B 1dc in first st of Rnd 2 working over Yarn A, 2dc in next st working over Yarn A, [change to Yarn A, 1dc working over Yarn B, change to Yarn B, 2dc in next st working over Yarn A, 1dc working over Yarn A, 2dc in next st working over Yarn A] five times, change to Yarn A, 1dc working over Yarn B, change to Yarn B, 2dc in next st working over Yarn A, sl st to join – 36dc

Round 4: 2dc in first st of Round 3 working over Yarn A, 1dc working over Yarn A, change to Yarn A, 1dc working over Yarn B, 2dc in next st working over Yarn B, 1dc working over Yarn B, [change to Yarn B, 1dc working over Yarn A, 2dc in next st working over Yarn A, 1dc working over Yarn A, change to Yarn A, 1dc working over Yarn B, 2dc working over Yarn B, 1dc working over Yarn B] five times, change to Yarn B, 1dc working over Yarn A, sl st to join, Fasten off Yarn B – 48dc

Round 5: Change to Yarn A, [3dc, 2dc in next st] twelve times, sl st to join – 60dc

Round 6: 1sc, 2sc in next st [4sc, 2sc in next st] eleven times, 3sc, sl st to join – 72sc

Fasten off and sew in ends.
