Cloud

Sweater

MATERIALS

(6) 7 (8) 9 (9) skeins of Diablo Multi colour
15

Straight needles 8 mm (US 11)
or circular needles 8 mm (US 11), 80 cm

YARN QUALITY

 **Diablo Multi**, Hobbii

30 % Mohair, 30% Nylon, 40% Acrylic
50 g (1.75 oz) = 90 m (98 yds)

GAUGE

Body:

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 12 sts x 15 rows
in stockinette on 8 mm (US 11) needles

Sleeves:

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 17 sts x 15 rows
in rib (k2 p2) on 8 mm (US 11) needles

ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit

P = Purl

C/on = Cast on

C/off = Cast off

St(s) = Stitch(es)

St st = Stockinette Stitch

Dec c/off = Decrease cast off - K2tog from
the back of the loop then slip the stitch
back to the left needle, repeat to the end of
the row

Kf&b = knit in the front and then the back
of the same stitch with the yarn at the back
of the work

SIZE

(S) M (L) XL (XXL)

MEASUREMENTS

Width: (61) 65 (68) 71 (76) cm / (24") 25.6"
(26.8") 28" (30")

Length: (49) 52 (55) 59 (62) cm / (19.3") 20.5"
(21.7") 23.2" (24.4")

PATTERN INFORMATION

This project is knitted flat, starting from the
bottom of the front, working a long piece, neck
and then down the back. The two sleeves are
added at the end.

INFO AND TIPS

This is a quick and easy knitting pattern for beginner knitters. Note that the size of the jumper in the picture is XXL.

FRONT and BACK

C/on (68) 72 (76) 80 (84) sts on 8 mm (US 11) needles

Row 1 – (K2, P2) repeat until the end of the row

Repeat the first row twice

Continue in st st for (47) 50 (53) 57 (60) cm / (18.5) 19.7 (20.9) 22.4 (23.6) " starting with a K row and finishing with a P row

Now create the opening for the neck:

Next row – K (20) 22 (24) 25 (27), Dec c/off (28) 28 (28) 30 (30), K (20) 22 (24) 25 (27)

Next row – P (20) 22 (24) 25 (27), c/on (28) 28 (28) 30 (30), P (20) 22 (24) 25 (27)

Continue in st st for (47) 50 (53) 57 (60) cm / (18.5) 19.7 (20.9) 22.4 (23.6) " starting with a K row and finishing with a P row.

Next row – (K2, P2) repeat until the end of the row

Repeat that last row twice

Dec c/off loosely all your sts, cut the yarn and make secure

SLEEVES (Make 2)

C/on (28) 32 (32) 36 (36) sts on 8 mm (US 11) needles

Row 1 – (K2, P2) repeat until the end of the row

Repeat the first row until your work measure 15 cm / 5.9 " from the c/on edge

**Next row – Kf&b, K1, (P2, K2) repeat until the last 2 sts, P1, Kf&b (30) 34 (34) 38 (38) sts

Next row – P1, (K2, P2) repeat until the last st, K1

Next 4 rows – Repeat the previous row 4 times

Next row – Kf&b, (K2, P2) repeat until the last st, Kf&b (32) 36 (36) 40 (40) sts

Next row – (P2, K2) repeat until the end of the row

Next 4 rows – Repeat the previous row 4 times

Next row – Kf&b, P1, (K2, P2) repeat until the last 2 sts, K1, Kf&b (34) 38 (38) 42 (42) sts

Next row – K1, (P2, K2) repeat until the last st, P1

Next 4 rows – Repeat the previous row 4 times

Next row – Kf&b, (P2, K2) repeat until the last st, Kf&b (36) 40 (40) 44 (44) sts

Next row – (K2, P2) repeat until the end of the row **

Next 4 rows – Repeat the previous row 4 times

Repeat from ** to ** (1) 1 (1) 2 (2) time(s) (44) 48 (48) 60 (60) sts

Next row – (K2, P2) repeat until the end of the row

Repeat the last row until your sleeve measure (45) 47 (50) 55 (60) cm / (17.7) 18.5 (19.7) 21.7 (23.6) “ from c/on

C/off all your sts loosely, cut the yarn and make secure

FINISHING

Fold the c/off edge of the sleeve in half and align with the collar opening on the body

Sew each side of the sleeve to the body by stretching slightly your work

Then sew the underarms and repeat for the second sleeve

Finish by joining each side of the body

Weave in all ends and give your sleeves a 10cm / 3.9” turn up
