MATERIALS

4 (4, 5, 5, 6, 6) skeins of BabyWool, col 6

Double pointed needles 2.5 mm (US 1.5) and 3 mm (US 2.5)
Circular needles 2.5 mm (US 1.5) and 3 mm (US 2.5) - 60 cm (24")
Crochet hook 2.5 mm for the buttonholes

3-4 buttons (diameter: 15 mm / 0.6")
Stitch markers
Stitch holders

YARN QUALITY

 **BabyWool**, Happy Sheep
100 % Wool / 50 g (1.8 oz) = 165 m (180 yds)

GAUGE

26 sts x 34 rnds/rows with needle 3 mm (US 2.5) = 10 cm (4")

ABBREVIATIONS

st(s) = stitch(es)
k = knit
p = purl
rnd(s) = round(s)
RS = right side
WS = wrong side
M1 = increase 1 stitch by picking up the bar between 2 stitches and knitting it through the back loop
yo(s) = yarnover(s)
k2tog = knit 2 stitches together
co = cast on
bo = bind off
col = color(s)

SIZE

2 (4, 6, 8, 10, 12) years

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 30 (32, 34, 36, 38, 40) cm / 11.8" (12.6", 13.4", 14.2", 15", 15.7")
Length: 36 (38, 40, 42, 44, 46) cm / 14.2", (15", 15.7", 16.5", 17.3", 18.1")

ABOUT THE PATTERN

The body is worked in the round on a circular needle until the armholes. From here, back piece and front piece are worked separately. The sleeves are worked separately and joined onto the sweater. All hems are folded with a small decorative border.

Pattern



PATTERN

Row 1, RS: K2, *p3, k7*, repeat from * to * until 8 sts remain, p3, k5.

Rows 2-6: Work stockinette stitch to end.

Row 7, RS: *K7, p3*, repeat from * to * to end.

Rows 8-12: Work stockinette stitch to end.

Repeat rnds 1-12.

JUMPER

Hem

Co 160 (170, 180, 190, 200, 210) sts with circular needle 2.5 mm (US 1.5).

Work 6 rnds in stockinette stitch in the round.

Rnd with holes: *Yo, k2tog*, repeat from * to * to end.

Change to circular needle 3 mm (US 2.5) and k all sts and yos.

Place a marker at the beginning of the rnd.

Take all measurements for the length from here.

Body

Work 12 rnds in stockinette stitch.

Work in pattern until the work measures 27 (28, 29, 30, 31, 32) cm / 10.6" (11", 11.4", 11.8", 12.2", 12.6") measured from the marker at the edge.

Now the work is divided, and the front piece and back piece are worked separately.

Place a marker at the beginning of the rnd and midway through the rnd = 80 (85, 90, 95, 100, 105) sts for each part.

BACK PIECE

Work the first 80 (85, 90, 95, 100, 105) sts in the flat on the circular needle. Place the remaining sts on a stitch holder.

Make sure that the pattern is placed correctly.

Armholes

Row 1, WS: Bo 6 (7, 7, 8, 8, 9) sts, work to end.

Row 2, RS: Bo 6 (7, 7, 8, 8, 9) sts, work to end = 68 (71, 76, 79, 84, 87) sts.

Work for 2 cm (0.8"). End with a RS row.

Now the back piece is divided for the slit.

Slit, right-hand side

Work 34 (35, 38, 39, 42, 43) sts. Put the remaining 34 (36, 38, 40, 42, 44) sts on hold.

Work until the armhole measures 11 (12, 13, 14, 15, 16) cm / 4.3" (4.7", 5.1", 5.5", 5.9", 6.3").

End with a WS row.

Bo 27 (27, 28, 28, 29, 30) sts knitwise and place the remaining 7 (8, 10, 11, 13, 13) sts on a stitch holder.

Slit, left-hand side

Bo 0 (1, 0, 1, 0, 1) st(s) and work to end = 34 (35, 38, 39, 42, 43) sts.

Work until the armhole measures 11 (12, 13, 14, 15, 16) cm / 4.3" (4.7", 5.1", 5.5", 5.9", 6.3").

End with a RS row.

Bo 27 (27, 28, 28, 29, 30) sts purlwise and place the remaining 7 (8, 10, 11, 13, 13) sts on a stitch holder.

NB The back piece is 2 cm (0.8") shorter than the front piece. Therefore, the place where the pieces are joined is placed 2 cm (0.8") down from the shoulder marker on the front piece.

FRONT PIECE

Work the last 80 (85, 90, 95, 100, 105) sts in the flat on the circular needle

Make sure that the pattern is placed correctly.

Armholes

Row 1, WS: Bo 6 (7, 7, 8, 8, 9) sts, work to end.

Row 2, RS: Bo 6 (7, 7, 8, 8, 9) sts, work to end = 68 (71, 76, 79, 84, 87) sts.

Work in pattern until the armhole measures 6 (6, 7, 7, 8, 8) cm / 2.4" (2.4", 2.8", 2.8", 3.1", 3.1"). End with a WS row.

Neckline and neck

Left-hand side

Row 1, RS: Work 27 (28, 30, 31, 32, 34) sts, place the remaining sts on a stitch holder.

Row 2, WS: Bo 3 (3, 4, 4, 4, 4) sts, work to end.

Row 3: Work pattern to end.

Row 4: Bo 2 (2, 3, 3, 3, 3) sts, work to end.

Row 5: Work pattern to end.

Row 6: Bo 1 (2, 2, 2, 2, 2) st(s), work to end.

Row 7: Work pattern to end.

Bo 1 st on each WS row until 19 (19, 20, 20, 21, 22) sts remain.

Work even until the armhole measures 11 (12, 13, 14, 15, 16) cm / 4.3" (4.7", 5.1", 5.5", 5.9", 6.3").

Place a marker at the sleeve side = middle of the shoulder.
Do not cut off the yarn, but work the neck with increases like this:

Neck

Work 4 rows.

Row 1, RS: Work pattern to end and co 4 new sts at the end of the row = 23 (23, 24, 24, 25, 26) sts.

Row 2, WS: Work pattern to end.

Row 3, RS: Work pattern to end and co 4 new sts at the end of the row = 27 (27, 28, 28, 29, 30) sts.

Row 4, WS: P to end.

Bo.

Neckline and neck

Right-hand side

Place 14 (15, 16, 17, 20, 19) sts on a stitch holder.

Row 1, RS: Work pattern to end.

Row 2, WS: Work pattern to end.

Row 3: Bo 3 (3, 4, 4, 4, 4) sts, work to end.

Row 4: Work pattern to end.

Row 5: Bo 2 (2, 3, 3, 3, 3) sts, work to end.

Row 6: Work pattern to end.

Row 7: Bo 1 (2, 2, 2, 2, 2) st(s), work to end.

Row 8: Work pattern to end.

Bo 1 st on each RS row until 19 (19, 20, 20, 21, 22) sts remain.

Work even until the armhole measures 11 (12, 13, 14, 15, 16) cm / 4.3" (4.7", 5.1", 5.5", 5.9", 6.3").

Place a marker at the sleeve side = middle of the shoulder.

Do not cut off the yarn, but work the neck with increases like this:

Neck

Work 4 rows.

Row 1, WS: Work pattern to end and co 4 new sts at the end of the row = 23 (23, 24, 24, 25, 26) sts.

Row 2, RS: Work pattern to end.

Row 3, WS: Work pattern to end and co 4 new sts at the end of the row = 27 (27, 28, 28, 29, 30) sts.

Row 4, RS: K to end.

Bo.

SLEEVES

Hem

Co 46 (48, 50, 52, 56, 58) sts with double pointed needles 2.5 mm (US 1.5) - or use circular needle 2.5 mm (US 1.5) and the magic loop technique.

Work 6 rnds of stockinette stitch in the round.

Rnd with holes: *Yo, k2tog*, repeat from * to * to end.

Change to needle 3 mm (US 2.5) and k all sts and yos.

Place a marker and take all measurements for the length from here.

Sleeve

Work 12 rnds in stockinette stitch. Place a marker at the beginning of the rnd.

Increases

K1, M1, work until 1 st before marker, M

1, k1 = 2 sts increased.

Work in pattern while increasing on every 14th (14th, 12th, 12th, 12th, 10th) rnd until you have 60 (64, 68, 74, 78, 84) sts. The new sts are worked into the pattern.

Work even until the sleeve measures 30 (33, 35, 36, 38, 40) cm / 11.8" (13", 13.8", 14.2", 15", 15.8"). End with a WS row.

Armhole

From here, work in the flat to create an opening which is later sewn together with the bind off.

Work in pattern for approx 2.5-3.5 cm (1-1.4").

Bo.

Same procedure for the second sleeve.

FINISHING

Neckline

Sew the shoulder seams together.

From the RS, use needle 3 mm (US 2.5) to pick up approx 88 (94, 100, 106, 112, 118) sts along the neckline (including the sts on the stitch holder).

Work 3 rows in stockinette stitch.

Row with holes: *Yo, k2tog*, repeat from * to * to end.

Change to needle 2.5 mm (US 1.5) and p all sts and yos.

Work 2 rows in stockinette stitch.

Bo.

The hems are folded onto the WS along the line and sewn onto the sleeve.

Buttonholes

Work 1 slip stitch by the hole edge on the right side of the back.

Chain 6, 1 single crochet, (skip 1 row, 1 single crochet) 2 times, repeat 3-4 times until the bottom of the slit, work single crochet along the left side.

Sew on buttons opposite the buttonholes.

Sleeves

The sleeves are sewn onto the jumper like this: The bind off edge is sewn along the armhole, the top 2.5-3.5 cm (1-1.4") of the sleeve is sewn along the bind off of the jumper.
