Children's Bathing Towel

MATERIALS

3 (4) 5 skeins of Baby Snuggle Solid, col 02

Circular needle 80 cm (32") / 6 mm (US 10)
Stitch holders

YARN QUALITY

 **Baby Snuggle Solid**, Hobbii
100 % Polyester / 100 g (3.5 oz) = 120 m
(131 yds)

GAUGE

10 sts x 22 rows = 10 cm (4") in double seed
stitch

SIZE

2/3 (4/6) 8/10 years

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 40 (50) 60 cm / 15.7" (19.7") 23.6"
Length: 50 (60) 70 cm / 19.7" (23.6") 27.6"

ABOUT THE PATTERN

The towel wrap begins at the bottom of the front piece and ends at the bottom of the back piece. The front piece is divided for the neck opening. Stitches are picked up for the hood which is sewn together at the top.

Pattern



FRONT PIECE

Co 40 (50) 60 sts and work in the flat like this:

Double seed stitch:

Row 1: *K1, p1*, repeat from * to * to end.

Row 2: "K on k, p on p*", repeat to end.

Row 3: *P1, k1*, repeat from * to * to end.

Row 4: "P on p, k on k*", repeat from * to * to end.

Repeat rows 1-4 until the work measures 40 (50) 60 cm / 15.7" (19.7") 23.6".

Neck opening

Left-hand side

Work 20 (25) 30 sts, turn and place the remaining sts on a stitch holder.

Work until the work measures 50 (60) 70 cm / 19.7" (23.6") 27.6". End with a WS row.

Shoulder

Next row, RS: Work 14 (18) 22 sts, place the remaining 6 (7) 8 sts on a stitch holder for the hood.

Cut off the yarn and place the sts on a stitch holder.

Neck opening

Right-hand side

Work the remaining 20 (25) 30 sts until the work measures 50 (60) 70 cm / 19.7" (23.6") 27.6".

End with a WS row.

Shoulder

Next row, RS: Work 6 (7) 8 sts and place these sts on a stitch holder for the hood, work to end = 14 (18) 22 sts.

Do not cut off the yarn.

BACK

Next row, WS: Work the sts of the right shoulder, co 12 (14) 16 sts in the neck and work the sts of the left shoulder = 40 (50) 60 sts.

Work until the back measures 50 (60) 70 cm / 19.7" (23.6") 27.6".

Bo.

HOOD:

RS: K the 6 (7) 8 sts on the right-hand side stitch holder, inc 1 st (= pick up the bar between the sts and k tbl), repeat *k1, inc1* 6 (7) 8 times along the neck, inc1, k the 6 (7) 8 sts on the left-hand side stitch holder = 32 (37) 42 sts.

Continue working double seed stitch until the hood measures approx 25 (26) 27 cm = 9.8" (10.2") 10.6".

Bo.

Fold the hood in the middle and sew it together.

FINISHING

Once the ends have been weaved in, it is a good idea to burn the ends.
