MATERIALS

2 skeins of Acacia color Curry (16)
1 skein of Rainbow Cotton 8/8
color Greyish Purple (013)

Knitting needles 4 mm (US 6)
Tapestry needle

YARN QUALITY

 **Acacia**, Hobbii
51% acrylic, 49% cotton
100 g (3.5 oz) = 250 m (273 yds)

 **Rainbow Cotton 8/8**, Hobbii
100% cotton
50 g (1.8 oz) = 75 m (82 yds)

GAUGE

Bloomers
10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 24 sts x 34 rows

Blouse
10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 24 sts x 44 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

st/s = stitch/es
k = knit
p = purl
edge st = edge stitch
kfb = increase by knitting in the front and
back of the same stitch
k2tog = knit 2 sts together
CO = Cast On
BO = Bind Off
yo = yarn over

SIZE

0-3 months (3-6 months) 6-9 months

MEASUREMENTS

Bloomers

Waist width: 22 (24) 26 cm / 8.6" (9.4") 10.2"
Legs rib width: 10 (12) 13 cm / 3.9" (4.7") 5.1"
Waist to crotch length: 17 (20) 22 cm / 6.6"
(7.8") 8.6"

Blouse

Width: 24 (26) 28 cm / 9.4" (10.2") 11"
Length: 25 (27) 29 cm / 9.8" (10.6") 11.4"
Sleeve: 10 (12) 14 cm / 3.9" (4.7") 5.5"

INFO AND TIPS

Both pieces consist of two parts, front and back, sewn together at the end.

Stitches used in the pattern:

stockinette stitch: purl in odd rows, knit in even rows,

garter stitch: k in every row.

BLOOMERS

The front and the back are made the same way.

Change the color on the right side of the knitting.

You start working from the legs like this:

With one strand of Rainbow Cotton yarn CO 24 (28) 29 sts for one leg and 24 (28) 29 sts with the other strand for the second leg. Work both legs with separate threads at the same time (without joining), and in the same way. Change to Acacia yarn and work 8 rows in garter stitch. Change to Rainbow Cotton yarn and work 2 rows. Change to Acacia yarn again and start to work in stockinette stitch.

Work 1 row and from the next one, start to increase as follows:

1 edge st, *kfb, 1 st* repeat from * to * across the row, 1 edge st.

Then, work 4 rows in stockinette stitch.

In the next row, work one leg, then CO 20 sts on the needle, and work the second leg.

Work as a one-piece through 51 (61) 67 rows.

In the next row work as follows: 1 edge st, k2tog across, 1 edge st. Change to Rainbow Cotton yarn and work 2 rows in garter stitch.

Change to Acacia yarn and work 6 rows in garter stitch.

Change to Rainbow Cotton yarn again and work 1 row in garter stitch. BO all sts.

Make the second piece in the same way.

Sew two pieces together.

Blouse

BODY

With Rainbow Cotton yarn CO 58 (64) 68 sts.

Change to Acacia yarn and work 110 (120) 130 rows in garter stitch.

BO all sts with Rainbow Cotton yarn.

SLEEVES

With Rainbow Cotton yarn CO 40 (45) 50 sts.

Change to Acacia yarn and work 44 (54) 64 rows in garter stitch.

BO all sts with Rainbow Cotton yarn.

Make the second sleeve in the same way.

Finishing

Sew the two pieces of the blouse together at the shoulders, about 12 sts each, so that they overlap. Then, sew the sleeves to the sweater, and the sides of the sweater and the sleeves together.



Weave all ends.
