# **MATERIALS**

1 skein of Rainbow Cotton 8/6 color Old Rose (046)

1 skein of Rainbow Cotton 8/6 color Plum (080) 2 skeins of Rainbow Cotton 8/6 color Aubergine (036)

2 skeins of Twister Solid color Black (105)

Crochet hook 3.5 mm (US E-4) Crochet hook 4 mm (US G-6) Yarn sewing needle Stitch markers

# **YARN QUALITY**

**Rainbow Cotton 8/6,** Hobbii 100% cotton 50 g (1.75 oz) = 105 m (115 yds)

**Twister Solid,** Hobbii 55% cotton, 45% acrylic 100 g (3.5 oz) = 400 m (437 yds)

#### **GAUGE**

10 cm x 10 cm (4'' x 4'') = 17 sts x 15 rows

# **ABBREVIATIONS**

ch = chain
sc = single crochet
dc = double crochet
dc2tog = 2 dc together
sl st = slip stitch
fo = fasten off

# **SIZE**

S(M)L

# **MEASUREMENTS**

Width: 45 (55) 65 cm / 17.7" (21.6") 25.5" Top length: 45 (55) 65 cm / 17.7" (21.6") 25.5" - Length of the whole dress as desired

# **INFO AND TIPS**

The top of the dress is made of granny squares sewn together, the bottom is made by working dc in the rounds, without joining. When making the squares, weave the ends in on the go - it will save you a lot of time in the end.

The granny squares are made with a 4 mm (US G-6) crochet hook and the rest of the dress with a 3.5 mm (US E-4) crochet hook.

The size of the dress depends on the number of rounds of the black yarn in the granny square, i.e.:

S size: 1 round square = 9 cm / 3.54" M size: 2 rounds square = 11 cm / 4.33" L size: 3 rounds square = 13 cm / 5.11"

# **BODY**

**Granny square** (make 28)

**Round 1:** with Old Rose yarn, ch 3 into a magic ring (counts as 1 dc), 11 dc, join with a sl st to the ch 3, fo = 12 dc.

**Round 2:** attach the Plum yarn between two dc and ch 3, work 1 dc into the same space between sts you started from, 2 dc in every space between sts, join with a sl st to the ch 3, fo = 12 2dc clusters.

**Round 3:** attach the Aubergine yarn between two dc clusters and ch 3, work 2 dc into the same space between clusters, ch 1, then 3 dc in the next space between clusters and ch 1. Continue like this until you get back to the beginning of the round, join with a sl st to the ch 3, fo = 12 3dc clusters.

**Round 4:** attach the Black yarn in any of the ch 1 spaces, and ch 4, 3 dc in the same space (the corner), \*3 dc in the next space between clusters, 3 dc in the next space between clusters, 3 dc in the same space (next corner)\* repeat from \* to \* 3 times in total, 3 dc in next space between clusters, 3 dc in next space between clusters, 2 dc in the space you started from, join with a sl st to the ch 3.



For size S - finish your square here.

**For size M** - repeat round 4 one more time, working 3 dc in the newly created spaces.

**For size L** - repeat round 4 two more times, working 3 dc in the newly created spaces. Block the squares.

## **TOP PIECE**

Sew the squares together with black yarn, arranged as shown in the diagram below, and then fold in half and sew the sides together to a height of 1.5 squares.

# **BOTTOM PIECE**

Attach the black yarn to the corner of the bottom square on the back and ch 20 (30) 40. Change to a 3.5mm crochet hook, turn the piece, ch 2, place a stitch marker and start to work dc without joining the rounds.

Work until you reach the desired length, but remember that you must have enough yarn for the finishing.

## **FINISHING**

Since the bottom of the dress starts very low, you need to make 2 rows of 3dc clusters over the chain. To do that, attach the black yarn with a 4mm hook to the 3dc cluster of the square, over where you started the chain before. Work 3dc clusters every 2 (3) 4 sts between dc sts (one row of 10 3dc clusters) and join the row with a sl st to the square on the other side. Make 2 sl st in the edge sts of the square, turn the dress, and work a 3dc cluster into each space between the clusters of the previous row.

Attach the black yarn to the front square on the neckline over the front and back connection, ch 2, and start working 3dc clusters in each space of the squares around the back. At both corners at the bottom of the dress, work 2dc into one space and 1 dc into the next one. When you get to the neckline, join with a sl st to the front square, make a sl st in two next sts, and work around the back as before.


Repeat again, but right after the first corner, start alternating 2 dc, dc2tog in each st until the next corner, then continue as before. When you get to the neckline, fo.

Make two tassels to your liking out of colored yarn. Attach black yarn to the top of the back piece, ch 80, attach the tassel, and work sl st into each chain st. Join with a sl st where you started and fo.

Repeat on the other side.
