



KNITTING PATTERN

Fiona

Jumper

MATERIALS

5 (6, 7, 8, 9) balls of Evergreen, Wine (31)

Circular needle 60 and 80 cm, size 3 mm and 3,5 mm (US 2,5 and 4).

Crochet hook 3 mm (US C/2) for the edge (optionally)

YARN QUALITY

 **Evergreen Organic Wool**, Hobbii

100% Wool/ 50 g (1.75 oz) =

230 meter (252 yds)

GAUGE

25 stitches = 10 cm using needle size 3,5 mm (US 4) in stockinette st.

SIZES

S (M, L, XL, XXL)

MEASUREMENTS

This is a wide design

Width: approx. 46 (52, 58, 63, 68) cm,

Length, measured in the middle of front piece: approx. 51 (52, 53, 55, 57) cm

ABOUT THE PATTERN

This jumper has a wide, loose fit with $\frac{3}{4}$ long sleeves.

The jumper is worked top down and you begin with an edge in garter st. After the edge, increase in the following 2 rounds. The sleeves and body are worked separately. You will decrease before finishing with an edge in garter st.

INFO AND TIPS

To make a firm and neat neck edge, you can optionally crochet 1 round sc around the neck edge.

YOKE

Neck Edge

CO 108 (118, 128, 138, 148) stitches on circular needle size 3 mm (US 2,5), 80 cm. Work garter st in the round, using the Magic Loop technique: knit 1 round and purl 1 round, until you have worked 4 ridges (= 8 rounds).

Body

Switch to circular needle size 3,5 mm (US 4) and continue in stockinette st in the round and increase in the following 2 rounds as follows:

Round 1: *k1, yo*, repeat from * to * on entire round = 216 (236, 256, 276, 296) stitches.

Round 2: *k1, yo, k1 tbl, yo*, repeat from * to * on entire round = 432 (472, 512, 552, 592) stitches.

Round 3: *k1, k1 tbl *, repeat from * to * on entire round = 432 (472, 512, 552, 592) stitches.

Continue in stockinette st until piece measures 19 (20, 21, 22, 23) cm.

Now the body and sleeves are separated.

Insert one marker at the beginning of the round.

Insert a marker after 102 (106, 110, 114, 120) stitches for the sleeve and insert one more marker after 114 (130, 146, 162, 176) stitches for the body. Repeat this one more time.

Sleeves

Work approx. 32 cm stockinette st in the round for the sleeve.

Sleeve Edge

Switch to circular needle size 3 mm (US 2,5) and continue as follows: k2tog on entire round = 51 (53, 55, 57, 60) stitches. Continue until you have worked 4 ridges in garter st and BO all stitches. Work the other sleeve in the same way.

Body

Using circular needle size 3,5 mm (US 4), work stockinette st in the round on the 228 (260, 292, 324, 352) stitches for the body.

Continue until the piece measures approx. 32 cm or a desired length, measured from the armhole.

Body Edge

Switch to circular needle 3 mm (US 2,5) and continue as follows: *k2, k2tog *, repeat from * to * on entire round = 171 (195, 219, 243, 264) stitches.

Continue until you have worked 4 ridges in garter st and BO all stitches.
