



KNITTING PATTERN

Letland

Pillow with cross pattern

MATERIALS

2 skeins of Highland Wool col 39 A 2 skeins of Highland Wool col 02 B

Circular needle 4 mm (US 6) - 80 cm (32") Pillow 40 x 50 cm (15.7" x 19.7")

YARN QUALITY

Highland Wool, Hobbii 100 % Peruvian Highland Wool 50 g (1.8 oz) = 175 m (191 yds)

GAUGE

24 sts x 24 rnds = 10 cm (4") in pattern

ABBREVIATIONS

st(s) = stitch(es) rnd(s) = round(s) RS = right side WS = wrong side co = cast on col = color(s)

SIZE

Onesize

MEASUREMENTS

The pillowcase is 46.5 cm (18.3") wide and 38 cm (15") tall, measured when the pillowcase is laid out flat.

ABOUT THE PATTERN

The pillowcase is worked in the round on a circular needle.

The pattern is worked according to the chart with the fair isle technique.

The top and bottom are sewn together while the pillow is inside the pillowcase.

TECHNIQUE VIDEOS

Bind off with 3 needles: Video link






PILLOWCASE

Co 224 sts with col B and work 1 rnd in stockinette stitch. Work in the round according to the chart. Repeat the frame 28 times. Work in the round until the work measures approx 38 cm (15"). Work 2 rnds with col B.

CHART





ENDING

Moisten the pillowcase and let it dry flat. Place the pillow inside the pillowcase and sew it together.

FINISHING

There are multiple ways in which the pillowcase can be sewn together:

- 1. Do not bind off, but sew the seams together with kitchener stitch.
- 2. Bind off with 3 needles either from the RS or the WS.
- 3. Bind off and sew together with kitchener stitch.
