Knitted Wheel

Tour de France

MATERIALS

1 skein of Hobbii Rainbow Sock Wool 8-ply

5 double pointed needles 4.5 mm
60 cm circular needles 4.5 mm
Optional 12 stitch markers

YARN QUALITY

 **Rainbow Sock Wool 8-ply**, Hobbii
75 % Wool, 25 % Polyamide
50 g (1.8 oz) = 75 m (82 yds)

ABBREVIATIONS

St: stitch
K: knit
P: purl
CO: cast on
YO: yarn over
R: row
K2tog: knit 2 together
P2tog: purl 2 together
K3tog: knit 3 together
P3tog: purl 3 together
Work sts as they appear: knit the knit stitches and purl the purled stitches

SIZE

One size

PATTERN INFORMATION

Pimp your ride with this fine decoration.

NOTE! For your own safety we recommend only using the finished item for decoration, and not cycling while it is attached to the wheel.

A certain gauge is not necessary as the finished item can be stretched to the desired length.

Pattern



CO 12 sts and divide on double pointed needles.

- R.1: Knit around. Place marker at the beginning of the round.
 R.2: *YO, k 1, place marker*. Repeat from *to* around (24 sts).
 R.3: Purl the yarn overs and knit the rest of the sts.
 R.4: Yarn over after each marker, work the rest of the sts as they appear (36 sts).
 R.5: Knit the yarn overs and work the rest of the sts as they appear.
 R.6: As R.4 (48 sts)
 R.7: Purl the yarn overs and work the rest of the sts as they appear.
 R.8: As R.4 (60 sts)
 R.9: As R.5
 R.10: As R.4 (72 sts)
 R.11: As R.7

Repeat R.8 to R.11 until you have 192 sts on your needles (16 sts for each leaf). Finish with a R.7. Do not break yarn.

Change to circular needles when needed.

Now you will bind off the 12 leaves one by one.

Change to double pointed needles if you wish, and bind off as follows:

- R.12: 3x(p1,k1), p1, k3tog, 3x(p1,k1). Turn. (14 sts)
 R.13: YO, k2tog, *p1, k1*. Repeat from *to* across. Turn.
 R.14: YO, k2tog, 2x(p1, k1), p3tog, 2x(k1, p1), k1. (12 sts)
 R.15: As R.13
 R.16: YO, k2tog, p1, k1, p1, k3tog, 2x(p1, k1). (10 sts)
 R.17: As R.13
 R.18: YO, k2tog, p1, k1, p3tog, k1, p1, k1. (8 sts)
 R.19: As R.13
 R.20: YO, k2tog, p1, k3tog, p1, k1. (6 sts)
 R.21: As R.13
 R.22: YO, k2tog, p3tog, k1. (4 sts)
 R.23: As R.13
 R.24: YO, k2tog, p2tog (3 sts)
 R.25: YO, k3tog (2 sts)

R.26: k2tog

Break yarn and pull the thread out through the stitch.

Join yarn at the next leaf and repeat R.12-26 until all leaves have been bound off.

Weave in ends or use them to attach your finished item to the wheel of a bike.
