# Paula

Children's dress

Design: Wolle Rapunzel | Hobbii Design

## MATERIALS

2 (2) 3 (3) skeins of Kind Feather, color 19

Circular needles 4 mm (US 6), 60 cm

Knitting needles 4 mm

Stitch markers

## YARN QUALITY



**Kind Feather**

100% Polyacrylic

100g (3.5 oz) = 235 m (257 yd)

## GAUGE

21 sts and 32 rows =

10 x 10 cm (4" x 4") stockinette stitch with

4,0 mm (US 6) needles

## ABBREVIATIONS

St = stitch

K = knit

P = purl

Stockinette stitch in rounds = K all stitches

Stockinette stitch in rows = right side K,

wrong side P

SM = Stitch marker

Edge stitch = always slip the last stitch of the row as if you were to purl the st, always knit the first st.

## SIZE

3 (4) 5 (6) years

## MEASUREMENTS

Width: (under the armholes)

32 (34) 36 (38) cm / 12,5" (13,4") 14 (15")

Length: 48 (49) 50 (51) cm / 19" (19,3") 19,7" (20")

## PATTERN INFORMATION

A cute strap dress, ideal for playing. Can be worn with a T-shirt or a long sleeve sweater on colder days. Requires some knitting experience due to the cutouts.

# Pattern



## INFO AND TIPS

The dress is worked in the round from the bottom and up until the armholes. From there the work is split and the front and back are knitted back and forth in rows. The pocket is made separately and sewn onto the front. From the armholes there is an edge stitch in the beginning and end of each row.

## DRESS

CO 154 (158) 162 (166) sts with 4mm circular needles

Place 2 SM to mark the sides of the dress.

P 5 rounds

From here work in stockinette stitch (K all stitches) while decreasing.

Decrease every 7th round as follow 6 times in total:

Decrease by knitting 2 sts together in both sides of the dress (move the stichmarker, so that the new stitch now marks the side)

After the 6th decrease continue working in stockinette stitch until your work measures:

30 (31) 32 (33) cm / 11,8" (12,2") 12,6" (13").

Now divide the front and back pieces:

Knit 71 (73) 75 (77) sts (back piece) and leave the stitches to rest, while continuing with the other half (front piece).

## FRONT PIECE

Row 1 (wrong side): K 11 sts, P 49 (51) 53 (55) sts, K 11 sts

Row 2 (right side): K 11 sts, K 49 (51) 53 (55) sts, K11 sts

Continue following the pattern knitting in rows while casting off 1x3, 2x2, 1x1 sts on the outer edge for the armholes.

After the last decrease work an edge stitch in the beginning and end of each row.

Continue in stockinette stitch until your piece measures a total length of:

35 (36) 37 (38) cm / 13,8" (14,2") 14,6" (15")

### **Neckline**

Cast off the middle stitch and continue working separately.

#### ***Left neckline***

Work the rest of the row. Work in stockinette sts until the last 3 sts. Work the 3th and 2nd last st in garter st and the last st as an edge stitch.

*Continue working in this pattern*

On the next right side work as follows:

1 edge stitch, 2 garter sts and then work the first dec for the V-neckline as follows:

Slip 1 sts, K 1 sts and pass the slipped stitch over. Knit the rest of the sts in the pattern.

Work the decreases identically in each following row from the right side for a total of 17 times and always follow the pattern.

After that continue following the pattern without any further decreases, until your piece measures a total length of: 48 (49) 50 (51) cm / 19" (19,3") 19,7" (20")

Cast off all sts.

#### ***Right neckline***

Work in the same pattern as for the left neckline.

Work in the opposite direction for the decrease of the V-neckline.

Knit the last 5th and 4th st together for a total of 17 times in every right side row.

### **BACK PIECE**

Put your resting stitches back on the needle and knit 11 garter sts, P 49 (51) 53 (55) sts, 11 garter sts.

Work the rest of the back piece identically to the front piece (follow pattern and knit armholes), but without the V-neckline.

When the piece measures 44 (45) 46 (47) cm / 17,3" 17,7" 18,1" 18,5" work as follows:

Edge stitch, 2 garter sts, 5 stockinette sts, 39 (41) 43 (45) garter sts, 5 stockinette sts, 2 garter sts, edge stitch.

Continue 1 row back and forth in this pattern and then work the neckline.

**Neckline**

Cast off the middle 27 sts and continue working separately.

Continue following the pattern, casting off 2x2 stitches at the neckline in every 2nd row.

When the work measures a length of 48 (49) 50 (51) cm / 19" (19,3") 19,7" (20") cast off all sts.

**FINISHING TOUCHES**

Sew the shoulders and the sides together.

**Pocket**

CO 33 sts and work 22 rows in pattern: 1 edge stitch, 2 garter sts, 27 stockinette sts, 2 garter sts, 1 edge sts

Knit an additional 4 rows in garter stitch and cast off all sts.

Sew the pocket in the center of the front part at a height of approx. 10 cm / 3,9"
