



KNITTING PATTERN

Cozy Celine Jumper

Design: Sanna Mård Castman | Hobbii Design



MATERIALS

4 (4) 5 (5) skeins of Butterfly col. 13

Needles: US 4 / 3.5 mm, 15.7" / 40 cm. US 4 / 3.5 mm, 23.6" / 60 cm. US 6 / 4 mm, 23.6" / 60 or 31.4" / 80 cm.

Double pointed needles: US 4 / 3.5 mm

YARN QUALITY

Butterfly, Hobbii

100% Premium acrylic. 200 g (7.1 oz) = 500m (547 yds)

GAUGE

21 sts and 30 rows in pattern using needles US 6 / 4 mm = 4" x 4" (10 x 10 cm).

Note! Always work a swatch to check your tension. Change to smaller or larger needles if necessary to keep the correct tension/gauge.

ABBREVIATIONS

BO = bind off CO = cast on Cont = continue RS = right side St/sts = stitch / stitches WS = wrong side

EXPLANATIONS

Pattern according to explanations in text.

Edge stitch (edge st) = K first and last st on every row.

Make 1 (m1) = Pick up strand between 2 sts, twist and k.

Slip a stitch knitwise (sl1k) = Sl1k to right hand needle without knitting the st. **Stockinette stitch (St st)** = k from RS, p from WS.

SIZE

XS-S (M-L) XL-2XL (3XL-4XL)

MEASUREMENTS

Bust circumference (user): 31.5-35.4" (35.8-42.1") 42.5-51.1" (51.6-59.9"") / 80-90 (91-107) 108-130 (131-152) cm. The jumper is designed to have a positive ease appr 9.4" / 25 cm compared to your own bust circumference

Sleeve to sleeve: 52,8" (57,5") 63" (66,5")' / 134

(146) 160 (169) cm

Length: 25,2" (26") 26.8" (27.6") / 64 (66) 68 (70) cm

PATTERN INFORMATION

A pretty blouse with a lovely, graphic structure and a beautiful diagonal line on both the front and the back piece, created with knit and purl stitches. It's knit from the bottom up on a 4 mm (US 6) needle and is joined with side seams to finish. Cozy Celine is knit with a strand of Butterfly, given your blouse the most beautiful play of colors.

NB! To get the same colors on the sleeves and shoulders, you may need to cut the yarn to achieve the same color transition on the front and back yoke.

CONSTRUCTION

Sweater is worked in 2 separate pieces, Back and Front, bottom to top.

Sleeves are shaped by increasing new sts in each side.

Textured pattern consists of vertical and horizontal strands worked in k sts.

The shaping of the diagonal: With x-number of rows in between you add 4 k sts in the end of a horizontal strand. In this way strands will meet at an angle.

BACK

With circular needles US 4 / 3.5 mm, 23.6" / 60 cm, CO 118 (138) 158 (188) sts.

Curled edging:

Row 1: WS Purl

Change to circular needles US 6 / 4 mm, 23.6" / 60 or 31.4" / 80 cm

Row 2-7: Work in St st. (remember edge st)

This creates an edge that curls up a bit.

Measure from here.

Next row RS:

Row 1: edge st, sl1k, p4, sl1k *p4, sl1k*, repeat *-* to last st, edge st.

Row 2: work k on k and p on p.

Row 3: edge st, k2, p3, sl1k, repeat *-* (*-* row 1)to last st, edge st.

Row 4: = row 2

Row 5: edge st, k3, p2, sl1k, repeat *-*(*-* row 1) to last st, edge st.

Row 6: = row 2



Row 7: edge st, k4, p1, sl1k, repeat *-*(*-* row 1) to last st, edge st.

Row 8: = row 2

Row 9: edge st, k5, sl1k, repeat *-* (*-* row 1) to last st, edge st.

Row 10: k on k, p on p to last 6 sts. K5, edge st.

Row 11: edge st, k to first *-*, work as follows: k1, p3, sl1k, repeat *-* (*-* row 1) to last st, edge st.

Row 12: = row 2

Row 13: edge st, k to first *-*, work as follows: k2, p2, sl1k, repeat *-*(*-* row 1) to last st, edge st.

Row 14: = row 2

Row 15: edge st, k to first *-*, work as follows: k3, p1, sl1k, repeat *-* (*-* row 1) to last st, edge st

Row 16: = row 2

Row 17: edge st, k to first *-* work as follows: k4, sl1k, repeat *-* to last st, edge st.

Row 18: work k on k and p on p to last 11 sts. K10, edge st.

Repeat rows 11-18.

Note! Every time you work row 18, extend the horizontal k-strand by adding 4 sts to it in the end, k new sts.

SLEEVES

Change to circular needle US 6 / 4 mm, 31.4" / 80 cm, when number of sts increases.

When work measures 14.6" (15") 15.4" (15.8") / 37 (38) 39 (40) cm shape sleeves as follows:

NOTE! Incorporate all new sts into pattern.

RS: Inc-row: edge st, m1, work to last st, m1, edge st.

Repeat inc-row from RS every other row another 19 (19) 21 (21) times = 158 (178) 202 (232) sts.

Next row RS: CO 61 (64) 67 (61) sts, work to end.

WS: CO 61 (64) 67 (61) sts, work to end.

= 280 (306) 336 (354) m. All sts are now inc for sleeves.

Cont straight until edge of sleeve measures 4.7" (4.7") 5.1" (5.1") / 12 (12) 13 (13) cm.

Shape shoulders and neck:

RS: Rightside sleeve/shoulder BO 29 (33) 36 (38) sts, work to end.

WS: Leftside sleeve/shoulder BO 29 (33) 36 (38) sts, work to end.



RS: BO 29 (33) 36 (38) sts, k63 (68) 76 (81) sts, BO 38 (38) 40 (40) sts (= neck), work to end.

Finish each side separately

Left side:

WS: BO 29 (33) 36 (38) sts, work to end.

RS: BO 2 sts (=neck), work to end.

WS: BO 29 (32) 36 (38) sts, work to end.

RS: BO 2 sts (=neck), work to end.

WS: BO 30 (32) 36 (39) sts.

Right side: Work same as left side but mirrored. BO for neck from WS.

FRONT

Work the same as BACK, but mirrored (= the diagonal will meet on shoulder).

You can work it exactly the same as back but then the diagonal will not meet on shoulder, it will be the opposite. Shape sleeves same as back.

NOTE:

Neck: When work measures 22" (22.8") 23.6" (24.4") / 56 (58) 60 (62) cm BO 10 (10) 12 (12) sts in center. Finish each side separately.

Right side:

Shape neck: From RS BO every other row 6-3-2-2-1-1-1 sts.

When the BO for the neck is done, shape sleeve/shoulder:

WS: BO 29 (33) 36 (38) sts, work to end.

RS: Work to end.

WS: BO 29 (33) 36 (38) sts, work to end.

RS: Work to end.

WS: BO 29 (32) 36 (38) sts, work to end.

RS: Work to end.

WS: BO rem 30 (32) 36 (39) sts.

Left side:

Work same as right side but mirrored. BO for neck from WS.

BO for sleeve/shoulder from RS. (First time will be on first row from RS after shaping the neck).



FINISHING

Block pieces to measurements.

Sew sleeve/shoulder seams.

Neckband: With circular needle US 4 / 3.5 mm, 23.6" / 60 cm, from RS, inside edge st, pick up 100 (100) 104 (104) sts along neck. Work k1 p1 rib in the round for 0.8"-1" / 2-2½ cm. BO in rib. Sew seams in sides and sleeves.

Edgings sleeves: With double pointed needles US 4 / 3.5 mm, from RS, inside edge st, pick up sts along the edge. In the round K1 row. BO in purl sts.
