

KNITTING PATTERN

MATERIALS

6 (7) 8 (9) 9 skeins of Panettone, color 03 3 (4) 4 (5) 5 skeins of Diablo, color 59

Circular needles 4 mm, 40 cm and 80 cm Circular needles 7 mm, 40 cm and 80 cm

Buttons "glitter" 18 mm: 5 (5) 6 (6) 6

Stitch markers

YARN QUALITY

Panettone, Hobbii
87% cotton, 7% polyamide, 6% metallic
fibre

50 g (1.75 oz) = 120 m (131 yds)

Diablo, Hobbii 40% acrylic, 30% mohair, 30% polyamide 25 g (0.9 oz) = 225 m (246 yds)

GAUGE

 $10 \times 10 \text{ cm} (4'' \times 4'') = 14 \text{ sts } \times 20 \text{ rows}$

ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit

P = purl

St = stitch(es)

CO = cast on

BO = bind off

K2tog = knit 2 stitches together

St m = stitch marker

m1r = make one right

m1l = make one left

SIZE

S (M) L (XL) 2XL

MEASUREMENTS

Length: 40 (42) 44 (46) 46 cm/ 15.7 (16.5) 17.3 (18.1) inches

Circumference: 104 (110) 118 (124) 130 cm/ 40.9 (43.3) 46.5 (48.8) 51.2 inches

PATTERN INFORMATION

"Happy" is a beginner friendly raglan cardigan in a joyful mix of Panettone and Diablo. The cardigan is short with wide sleeves, a pretty collar and glitter buttons.

TIPS AND INFO

The cardigan is worked top-down in stockinette stitch with one strand of Diablo and one strand of Panettone held together.

The ribbing, button band and collar are worked with just one strand of Panettone.

The sleeves are worked in the round using the "magic loop" technique.

Buttonholes

First you will increase by yarning over, after which you will knit 2 stitches together.

Increasing

M1R (right leaning increase)

Insert the left-hand needle from back to front, under the bar, now knit this bar through the front loop

M1L (left leaning increase)

Insert the left-hand needle from front to back, under the bar between the stitches, now knit this bar through the back loop.

RAGLAN

With circular needles 7 mm, 80 cm and one strand of Diablo and one strand of Panettone held together, CO 64 (68) 72 (76) 80 sts. You will be working flat in stockinette stitch while making raglan increases every right-side row. You will increase your stitch count by 8 for every round of raglan increases.

Purl 1 row.

Divide raglan:

11 (12) 13 (14) 15 sts (front panel), st m, 1 raglan st, st m, 9 (9) 9 (9) 9 sts (sleeve), st m, 1 raglan st, st m, 20 (22) 24 (26) 28 sts (back), st m, 1 raglan st, st m, 9 (9) 9 (9) 9 sts (sleeve), st m, raglan st, st m, 11 (12) 13 (14) 15 sts (front panel)

Work raglan increases as follows:

1. row: *Knit until 1. St m, m1r, move st m, knit the raglan st, move st m, m1l* Repeat increases at the next 6 st markers. Knit until end of row.

2. row: purl



Repeat 1. and 2. row 21 (22) 23 (24) 25 times

= 232 (244) 256 (268) 280 sts on your needles.

Dividing body and sleeves

Note: The 4 raglan sts will be part of the body sts. Remove the stitch markers as you reach them.

Knit 33 (35) 37 (39) 41 sts (front panel), place 51 (53) 55 (57) 59 sts to rest (sleeve), CO 6 (6) 8 (8) 10 sts using the backwards loop method, knit 64 (68) 72 (76) 80 sts (back), place 51 (53) 55 (57) 59 sts to rest (sleeve), CO 6 (6) 8 (8) 10 sts using the backwards loop method, knit 33 (35) 37 (39) 41 sts (front panel)

= 142 (150) 162 (170) 182 sts on your needles.

BODY

Continue working in stockinette stitch until work, measured from the neck, measures 36 (38) 40 (42) 42 cm/14.2 (15) 5.7 (16.5) 16.5 inches - *or desired length*.

End with a purl row.

Ribbing

Work flat in ribbing (k1, p1) using 4 mm circular needles, 80 cm and one strand of Panettone

Start by working 1 row with increases: *k2, M1L * repeat until 2 (2) 2 (2) 2 sts remain, knit.

= 212 (224) 242 (254) 272 sts on your needles

Work 4 cm/1.6" of ribbing. BO

SLEEVES

The sleeves are worked in the round with circular needles 7 mm, 40 cm using one strand of Panettone and 1 strand of Diablo held together.

Move the resting stitches for one sleeve onto your needles. Start beneath the armhole and pick up and knit 6 (6) 8 (8) 10 sts, one in each of the backwards loop CO sts.

= 57 (59) 63 (65) 69 sts on your needles

Place a marker in the middle of the 6 (6) 8 (8) 10 sts you have just picked up. Your round begins here.

Work stockinette stitch in the round until sleeve measures 33 (35) 37 (37) 37 cm/13 (13.8) 14.6 (14.6) 14.6 inches *or desired length*

Ribbing

Work ribbing in the round (k1, p1) using circular needles size 4 mm, 40 cm and 1 strand of Panettone.



Start by working 1 row with increases: *k2, M1L * repeat until 3 (1) 1 (3) 3 sts remain, knit.

= 84 (88) 94 (96) 102 sts on your needles

Work 4 cm/1.6" of ribbing. BO

Make the other sleeve the same way.

Button bands

Work flat in ribbing (k1, p1) using circular needles size 4 mm, 80 cm and 1 strand of Panettone.

The buttonholes are worked on the right side and the buttons are attached on the left.

Left button band

Pick up and knit one st in each stitch along the front edge.

Work 8 rows of ribbing. BO.

Right button band

Measure where to place the buttonholes. For sizes S (M) you will have 5 buttons to place. For sizes L (XL) 2XL you will have 6 buttons.

Pick up and knit one st in each stitch along the front edge.

Row 1-3: Work in ribbing.

Row 4: Work buttonholes evenly along this row. First and last buttonholes are placed approx. 1 cm/ 0.4" from each edge. Measure and place stitch markers where you want your buttonholes.

*Work in ribbing until first buttonhole, *yo, k2tog* repeat 5 (5) 6 (6) 6 times. Work in ribbing until end of row.

Row 5-8: Work in ribbing BO.

Collar

Work flat in ribbing (k1, p1) using circular needles size 4 mm, 40 cm and 1 strand of Panettone. Slip the first stitch of each row.

Pick up and knit 85 (90) 95 (100) 105 sts along the neck opening – in the stitches as well as between the stitches. Work 10 (11) 12 (12) 12 cm/ 4 (4.4) 4.7 (4.7) 4.7 inches of ribbing. BO

Finishing

Weave in all ends.

Attach the buttons aligned with the buttonholes.
