MATERIALS

5 (5) 6 (6) skeins of Baby Cotton Organic Midi color 14

Circular knitting needle (60 cm/ 32"), size 4 mm / US 6 knitting needles, size 4mm / US 6 4 stitch markers crochet hook, size 3.5 mm / E 4 "wooden buttons" w/4 holes 12mm

YARN QUALITY

Baby Cotton Organic Midi, Hobbii
100% Cotton
50g = 105 m / 114 yds

GAUGE

21 stitches and 32 rows = 10 x 10 cm with stockinette stitch (size 4 mm / US 6 needles)

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit p = purl Sts = stitches RS = right side WS = wrong side Stockinette in rounds = knit stitches Stockinette in rows = RS knit, WS purl SIZE

4 (5) 6 (7) years

MEASUREMENTS

Width: approx. 35 (36) 37 (39) cm / 13.8 (14.2) 14.6 (15.4) inch Length: approx. 48 (50) 52 (55) cm / 18.9 (19.7) 20.5 (21.7) inch

PATTERN INFORMATION

The dress is worked in the round from the bottom up to the armholes. The borders of the neck and armholes are crocheted.

Pattern



SKIRT

CO 204 (208) 212 (220) sts with your 4 mm / US 6 circular knitting needle. Join to knit in rounds.

From now on alternate between working 6 rounds in stockinette stitch and 1 round purl. At the same time decrease the skirt in every round with purl stitches (every 7th round).

Purl the following sts together in the first 7th round (1st round with purl stitches): the 1st +2nd, the 101st+102nd (103rd+104th) 105th+106th (109th+110th) the 103rd+104th (105th+106th) 107th+108th (111th+112th) the 203rd+204th (207th+208th) 211th+212th (291th+220th)

Mark the 4 sts you created by working the decreases with a stitch marker and continue decreasing in every 7th round (the p round) for another 11 rounds . Always purl the stitch of the 1st and 3rd stitch marker together with the following stitch and purl the stitch of the 2nd and 4th stitch marker together with the stitch before.

In the 13th round with purl stitches work 4x 2 sts together, as you did before, and purl additional 8x 2 sts together.

TOP

Continue working in stockinette stitch until your piece measures 34 (35) 36 (37) cm / 13.4 (13.8) 14.2 (14.6) inch in total. Now split your work and switch to your 4 mm / US 6 knitting needles. Let half of the stitches rest.

Back

Work a WS row with purl stitches and in the following RS row bind off 1x3, 3x2, 1x1 sts along the edge in every 2nd row.

Continue in stockinette stitch until your piece measures 46 (48) 50 (53) cm / 18 (18.9) 19.7 (20.9) inches in total. Now work the neckline.



Neckline, shoulders

Bind off 22 (22) 24 (24) stitches in the center of the work and continue working separately. Bind off 2x2 stitches in every 2nd row along the neckline edge. Bind off all stitches once your piece measures 48 (50) 52 (55) cm / 18.9 (19.7) 20.5 (21.7) inch

in total.

Work the other side of the shoulder in the same way..

Front

Put your resting stitches back on the needle. Work in stockinette stitch and bind off 1x3, 3x2, 1x1 sts along the edge in every 2nd row.

Work in stockinette until your piece measures 43 (45) 47 (50) cm / 16.9 (17.7) 18.5 (19.7) inch in total. Then work the neckline and shoulders.

Neckline, shoulders

Bind off 10 (10) 12 (12) stitches in the center of the work and continue working separately. Bind of 4x2, 2x1 stitches in every 2nd row along the neckline edge. Bind off all stitches once your piece measures 48 (50) 52 (55) cm / 18.9 (19.7) 20.5 (21.7) inch in total.

Work the other side of the shoulder in the same way.

FINISHING TOUCHES

Sew the shoulder seams and the small side seams.

Work 1 round single crochet along the neckline, starting at the back. Chain 2 and work a double crochet into every single crochet of the previous round. Join the round with a slip stitch into the first chain.

Crochet around both arm openings the same way.

Weave in all ends.

Sew the 4 wooden buttons centered onto the front underneath the neckline.
