## Vest

## MATERIALS

1 (2) 2 (3) 3 (3) 3 (4) 4 skein(s) of Kind Feather Navy Blue 15

All sizes:
1 skein of Kind Feather, Dusty Rose (09)
1 skein of Kind Feather, Dusty Green (19)
1 skein of Kind Feather Light Blue (14)
1 skein of Kind Feather, Dark red (08)
1 skein of Kind Feather, Beige (03)
1 skein of Kind Feather, Camel (23)
If you decide to use less colors you will need $150 \mathrm{~g}(200 \mathrm{~g}) 200 \mathrm{~g}(300 \mathrm{~g}) 300 \mathrm{~g}(300 \mathrm{~g}) 300 \mathrm{~g}$ (400g) 400 g Kind Feather in total for the complimentary colors.

Crochet hook 3.5mm (US E/4)
or 4 mm (US G/6)
or 4.5 mm (US 7)
(hook size depends on vest size - see size chart)

## YARN QUALITY

(33) Kind Feather, Hobbii

100\% acrylic
$100 \mathrm{~g}(3.5 \mathrm{oz})=$ length $235 \mathrm{~m}(257 \mathrm{yds})$

ch $=$ chain
dc = double crochet
tr = treble crochet
sl st = slip stitch
fptr $=$ front post treble
bptr $=$ back post treble

## PATTERN INFORMATION

This is such a fun vest to make! Suitable for beginners and more experienced crocheters alike, the pattern includes sizes XS to 5XL (bust sizes 80 cm up to 170 cm ). The pattern can easily be adjusted for length by adding or subtracting squares at the waistline

## INFO AND TIPS

Start by making a swatch to check for gauge, to do this make a square up to the size indicated on the chart and measure to check it is the same measurement as mine, if it's more than 1 cm larger go down 1 hook size, if it's more than 1 cm smaller, go up a hook size

If you would like a longer vest simply add more squares at the waistline.

## GRANNY SQUARES

Make 48 (48) 57 (48) 56 (38) 44 (38) 44 squares.
Ch4, sl st to first chain to make a ring.

Round 1 ch3, make 2tr in the ring, ch2, *make 3tr in the ring, ch2**, repeat from * to ** twice more, sl st to $3^{\text {rd }}$ of ch3, fasten off

Round 2 join new color in any ch2 space, in the same space make (ch3, 2tr, ch2, 3tr), ch1, *in the next corner make (3tr, ch2, 3tr), ch1**, repeat from * to ** twice more

Round 3 join new color in any ch2 space, in the same space make (ch3, 2tr, ch2, 3tr), ch1, make 3tr in the next space, ch1, *in the next corner make (3tr, ch2, 3tr), ch1, make 3tr in the next space, ch1 **, repeat from * to ** twice more, sl st to $3^{\text {rd }}$ ch of 3 ch , fasten off

Round 4

Round 5 join new color in any ch2 space, in the same space make (ch3, 2tr, ch2, 3tr), ch1, in each of the next 3 spaces make (3tr, ch1), *in the next corner make (3tr, ch2, 3tr), ch1, in each of the next 3 spaces make (3tr, ch1), **repeat from * to ** twice more, sl st to $3^{\text {rd }}$ of ch3, fasten off

Round 6 join new color in any ch2 space, in the same space make (ch3, 2tr, ch2, 3tr), ch1, in each of the next 4 spaces make (3tr, ch1), *in the next corner make (3tr, ch2, 3tr), ch1, in each of the next 4 spaces make (3tr, ch1), **repeat from * to ** twice more, sl st to $3^{\text {rd }}$ of ch3, fasten off

## TRIANGLES

All sizes: Make 4
Follow the same color ways as for squares
Ch4, sl st to first chain to make a ring

Row 1 ch5, make 3tr in the ring, ch2, make 3tr in the ring, ch2, make 1 tr in the ring, fasten off

Row 2 join new color in first ch2 space (made by last row's ch5), ch5, make 3tr in same space, ch1, in the corner make (3tr, ch2, 3tr), ch1, make 3tr in the next ch space, ch1, make 1 tr in same space, fasten off

Round 3 join new color in first ch2 space (made by last row's ch5), ch5, make 3tr in same space, ch1, make 3tr in the next space, ch1, in the corner make (3tr, ch2, 3tr), ch1, make 3tr in the next space, ch1, make 3tr in last space, ch1, make 1 tr in same space, fasten off

Round 4 join new color in first ch2 space (made by last row's ch5), ch5, make 3tr in same space, ch1, in each of the next 2 spaces make (3tr, ch1), in the corner make (3tr, ch2, 3tr), ch1, in each of the next 2 spaces make (3tr, ch1), make 3 tr in last space, ch1, make 1 tr in same space, fasten off

Round 5 join new color in first ch2 space (made by last row's ch5), ch5, make 3tr in same space, ch1, in each of the next 3 spaces make (3tr, ch1), in the corner make (3tr, ch2, 3tr), ch1, in each of the next 3 spaces make (3tr, ch1), make 3 tr in last space, ch1, make 1 tr in same space, fasten off

Round 6 join new color in first ch2 space (made by last row's ch5), ch5, make 3tr in same space, ch1, in each of the next 4 spaces make (3tr, ch1), in the corner make (3tr, ch2, 3tr), ch1, in each of the next 4 spaces make (3tr, ch1), make 3tr in last space, ch1, make 1tr in same space, fasten off

ASSEMBLY

Sizes: XS, S, L


Sizes 3XL, 5XL


Following the above charts for layout (take note of the correct size), double crochet or sew your squares and triangles together, fold in half along the arrow and double crochet or sew the edges together.

To double crochet together: hold 2 squares together right sides facing, join yarn in ch2 space, pulling through both squares, ch1, make 1 dc in same space, make 1 dc in every stitch and ch1 space along, working through the 2 corresponding stitches on both sides, make 1 dc in final ch 2 space of both squares, fasten off.

## Edging

## Neck Edging

Round 1 Re-join yarn in any ch2 space, ch3, work around the edge making 1tr in every ch2 and ch1 space and 1tr in every stitch, sl st to $3^{\text {rd }}$ of ch3

Round 2 ch3, *make 1 fptr around the next stitch, make 1 bptr around the following**, repeat from * to ** all the way around, sl st to $3^{\text {rd }}$ of ch3

Rounds 3-5 repeat round 2, fasten off, weave in ends

## Armhole Edging

Round 1 Re-join yarn in any ch2 space, ch3, work around the edge making 1 tr in every ch 2 and ch1 space and 1 tr in every stitch, sl st to $3^{\text {rd }}$ of ch3

Round 2 ch3, *make 1 fptr around the next stitch, make 1 bptr around the following**, repeat from * to ** all the way around, sl st to $3^{\text {rd }}$ of ch3

Round 3 repeat round 2, fasten off, weave in ends

## Bottom edging

Round 1 Re-join yarn in any ch2 space, ch3, work around the edge making 1tr in every ch 2 space, but not in the ch1 spaces (skip these), and making 1 tr in every stitch, sl st to $3^{\text {rd }}$ of ch3

Round 2 ch3, *make 1 fptr around the next stitch, make 1 bptr around the following**, repeat from * to ** all the way around, sl st to $3^{\text {rd }}$ of ch3

Rounds 3-8 repeat round 2, fasten off, weave in ends
