Alpine Sunflower

Bonnet

MATERIALS

1 skein of Acacia color 17
1 skein of Acacia color 16
1 skein of Acacia color 15
1 skein of Acacia color 14

Crochet hook 4 mm (US G/6)
Crochet hook 3 mm (US D/3)

YARN QUALITY

 Acacia, Hobbii
51 % Acrylic, 49 % cotton
100 g (3.5 oz) = 250 m (273 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 21 sts x 9 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain
sc = single crochet
dc = double crochet
slst = slip stitch
ps = puff stitch yarn over pull up a loop
three times yarn over pull through all 7
stitches on hook and ch1 to finish the
stitch.
fpdc = front post double crochet
blo = back loop only
* * = repeat

SIZE

0-6 months, (6-12 months) 1-2 years

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 17 (19) 21 cm / 6.75" (7.5") 8.25"
Length: 17 (19) 21 cm / 6.75" (7.5") 8.25"

PATTERN INFORMATION

This cute sunflower bonnet is made with two granny squares slip-stitched together to form a bonnet, with crochet ribbed edging and ties.

INFO AND TIPS

If your measurements are not quite the same as mine, you could do an extra round or add a couple more chains to the edging to get the above measurements.

The rib edging of 5 stitches measures about 1 inch, so your finished square should measure about 1 inch less than the above measurement before joining together.

Sunflower Square

Make two starting with color 17 and a 4mm hook

Round 1 ch2 and 12 dc into a magic circle, slst to first. (12)

Round 2 ch2, 2 dc in the same, 2 dc in each stitch to end, slst to first. (24)

Change to color 16

Round 3 ch1, ps in each stitch, slst to first. (48 including ch1s)

Change to color 15

Starting in any ch1 space

Round 4 ch2, 3 dc in same, ***remove hook from stitch and insert in top of first dc from front to back, insert into last dc and pull loop through, ch2, 3 dc into next stitch*** repeat to end, ch2, slst to first. (24 petals)

Change to color 14

Round 5 (Working in the chain spaces) [ch2, 3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc] in the same for the first corner, 3 dc in each of the next five ch2 spaces, [3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc] in the next ch2 space, 3 dc in the next five ch2 spaces, repeat twice more, slst to the first, slst to the chain 2 corner space. (84)

Round 6 [ch2, 2 dc, ch2, 2 dc] in the same, [fpdc, dc] x 10, fpdc, [2 dc, ch2, 2 dc] in the ch2 corner space, [fpdc, dc] x 10, fpdc, [2 dc, ch2, 2 dc] in the ch2 corner space, [fpdc, dc] x 10, fpdc,

[2 dc, ch2, 2 dc] in the ch2 corner space, [fpdc, dc] x 10, fpdc, slst to first, slst to the ch2 corner space.

Round 7 [ch2, 2 dc, ch2, 2 dc] in the same, [dc, fpdc] x 12, dc, [2 dc, ch2, 2 dc] in the ch2 corner space, [dc, fpdc] x 12, dc, [2 dc, ch2, 2 dc] in the ch2 corner space, [dc, fpdc] x 12, dc, [2 dc, ch2, 2 dc] in the ch2 corner space, [dc, fpdc] x 12, dc, slst to first, slst to the ch2 corner space.

Fasten off for 0-6 months - square should measure 13cm / 6"

Round 8 [ch2, 2 dc, ch2, 2 dc] in the same, [fpdc, dc] x 14, fpdc, [2 dc, ch2, 2 dc] in the ch2 corner space, [fpdc, dc] x 14, fpdc, [2 dc, ch2, 2 dc] in the ch2 corner space, [fpdc, dc] x 14, fpdc, [2 dc, ch2, 2 dc] in the ch2 corner space, [fpdc, dc] x 14, fpdc, slst to first, slst to the ch2 corner space.

Fasten off for 6-12 months - square should measure 15cm / 6.75"

Round 9 [ch2, 2 dc, ch2, 2 dc] in the same, [dc, fpdc] x 16, dc, [2 dc, ch2, 2 dc] in the ch2 corner space, [dc, fpdc] x 16, dc, [2 dc, ch2, 2 dc] in the ch2 corner space, [dc, fpdc] x 16, dc, [2 dc, ch2, 2 dc] in the ch2 corner space, [dc, fpdc] x 16, dc, slst to first, slst to the ch2 corner space.

Fasten off for 1-4 years - square should measure 18cm / 7.5"

Joining the squares

Slst together across the top and down the back, place hook into the back loop of the square nearest you and the back loop of the other square (it is the inside loop)

Edging and ties

You may need to add or take away, to the chains for this step to get the right measurements of 17 / 19 / 21 cm or 6.75" / 7.50" / 8.25" squares.

Back bonnet edging

Using a 3mm hook

Start at the outer side and work across one square, then the opposite square.

Row 1 ch6, sc in the second chain from hook, sc in the next 4, join to the next stitch at the edge of the bonnet with a slst, then work one more slst into the next stitch. (2 slsts in total for joining) (5) Turn

Row 2 ch1, sc all in blo. (5) Turn

Row 3 (in blo) ch1, sc all back to the edge of the bonnet, join to the next stitch of the edge of the bonnet using a slst, then work one more slst into the next stitch. (2 slsts in total for joining) (5) Turn

Repeat rows 2 and 3 until you reach the other side.

Then do the front edging below:

Row 1 chain 71 / 76 / 81, sc in the second chain from hook, sc in the next 69 / 74 / 79, join to the next stitch at the edge of the bonnet with a slst, then work one more slst into the next stitch. (2 slsts in total for joining) Turn

Row 2 ch1, sc 5 in blo. (5) Turn

Row 3 (in blo) ch1, sc all back to the edge of the bonnet, join to the next stitch of the edge of the bonnet using a slst, then work one more slst into the next stitch. (2 slsts in total for joining) (5) Turn

Repeat rows 2 and 3 until you reach the other side, then repeat row 1 for the last row to make the second tie.

Fasten off and sew in all the ends.
