



KNITTING PATTERN Sensommer Mittens

MATERIALS

2 (2) 2 (2) 2 skeins Evergreen, Light Sage (27)

Double pointed needles or circular needles size 6 (4 mm) (24" or 60 cm wire) or the needle you need to make gauge.

YARN QUALITY

Evergreen Organic Wool, Hobbii 100% Wool/ 50 g (1.75 oz) = 230 meter (252 yds)

GAUGE

22 sts and 30 rows in stockinette st on needle size 6 (4 mm) = 4" or 10 cm. Knit with two strands held together.

ABBREVIATIONS

st = Stitch **m** = Marker (placed between two sts) **k** = Knit p = Purl k2tog = knit 2 together **SSK improved** = Slip 1 knit-wise, put back on left #HobbiiSensommer needle in it's new direction, knit the first two sts together through back loop only. **sl1p** = Slip 1 purl-wise with the yarn behind the work. **RS** = Right side **WS** = Wrong side

SIZES

0 months (3 months) 6 months (1-2 years) 3-4 vears

MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: 4½" (4½") 5½" (5½") 6" or 12 (12) 13,5 (14) 15 cm **Length**: 3" (3½") 4" (4") 4½" or 8 (9) 9,5 (10) 11,5 cm measured from end of ribbing to end of mitten, ie the hand. **Full length**: 5½" (6") 6" (6½") 7" or 14 (15) 15,5 (16) 17,5 cm measured from start to end of mitten.

ABOUT THE PATTERN

The mittens are knit in the round from the arm and towards the fingers. First, you knit a grafted piece and then switch to stockinette stitch. A thumb is made on the 2 largest sizes.

Pattern



MITTEN

Cast on 26 (26) 30 (32) 34 sts with two threads held together on needle no. 6 (4 mm). Knit 1 round and switch to grafted pattern until the work measures $2\frac{1}{2}$ " (6 cm).

Pattern:

- 1. Round: *k1, sl1p* repeat *_* to end of round.
- 2. Round: *p1, sl1p* repeat *_* to end of round.
- **3.** Round: k around.
- **4.** Round: k around.

Now knit around in stockinette st until the stockinette part measures $2^{1}/_{4}$ " (2½") 2½" (3") $3^{1}/_{4}$ " or 5,7 (6,7) 6,7 (7,3) 8,3 cm in stead. Do please note, that if you are knitting size (1-2 years) or 3-4 years, you have to make room for a thumb when the stockinette part measures $1^{1}/_{4}$ " (3 cm).

Thumb:

Left mitten:

Knit to the last 5 sts, knit the 5 sts in a contrast color, put the sts back on the left needle and knit them again in the working color.

Right mitten:

Knit (16) 17 sts, knit the next 5 sts in a contrast color, put the sts back on the left needle and knit them again in the working color, knit around. Now start decreasing.

Decreases

- 1. round: k1, place m, k2tog, k 7 (7) 9 (10) 11, SSK improved, place m, k2, place m, k2tog, knit to last 3 sts, SSK improved, place m, k1.
- 2. round: knit around.

Repeat these 2 rounds all in all 2 (2) 2 (2) 3 times, and then knit 2 (2) 3 (3) 3 rounds in a row with decreases = 10 (10) 10 (12) 10 sts on the needle.

Next round are knit like this: *k2tog* repeat *_* around = 5 (5) 5 (6) 5 sts on the needle.

Cut the thread and thread a needle with the end. Sew through the last sts, tighten and weave in the end on the WS of the work.



Thumb

Using needle no. 6 (4 mm), pick up the 5 sts under and over the contrast color thread as well as 1 st on each side of the contrast color thread = 12 sts all in all on round.

Remove the contrast color thread and now knit in the round in stockinette st until the thumb measures $1^{1}/_{4}^{"}$ (1½") or (3) 3,5 cm.

K2tog around and cut the thread. Thread a needle with the end of the yarn and sew through the last sts, weave in the end on th WS of the work.

Assembling

Weave in all ends and wash according to the instructions to the yarn.
