



KNITTING PATTERN

Flower Power

Pullover

Design: Wolle Rapunzel | Hobbii Design

MATERIALS

3 (3) 4 (4) skeins of Rainbow Bamboo, colour 01 (A)

1 (1) 1 (1) skeins of Rainbow Bamboo, colour 26 (B)

Straight needles 5mm (US 8)

Crochet hook 4,5 mm (US 7)

YARN QUALITY

 **Rainbow Bamboo**, Hobbii

60% Bamboo viscose, 40% Cotton

100g (3.5 oz) = 250 Meter (273 yd)

GAUGE

18 sts and 24 rows = 10 x 10 cm / 4" x 4"
stockinette stitch with 5,0 mm (US 8)
needles

ABBREVIATIONS

St = stitch

K = knit

P = purl

CO = cast on

Stockinette stitch = right side knit, wrong side purl.

Garter stitch = right side knit, wrong side knit.

SIZE

4 (5) 6 (7) years

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 33 (34) 36 (37) cm / 13" (13,4") 14" (14,6")

Length: 36 (38) 42 (43) cm / 14" (15") 16,5" (17")

PATTERN INFORMATION

Super soft and cheerful summer sweater with a cropped fit. The neckline requires some experience in knitting with colour changes.

TIPS AND TRICKS

The Flower Power sweater is worked with two strands of yarn held together.

When changing the colours, cross the threads at the back and tighten well to avoid any holes.

BACK PANEL

CO 56 (58) 62 (64) sts using straight needles 5,0 mm (US 8) with colour (B).

Work 6 rows in garter stitch.

In the 7th row (Rights side) work in stockinette stitch until the work has a length of 33 (35) 39 (40) cm / 13" (13,8") 15,4" (15,8"), then start knitting the neckline.

Neckline

Work the first 8 (9) 11 (12) sts in stockinette stitch with white, the 40 sts are worked in garter stitch with pink, and the last 8 (9) 11 (12) sts are worked in stockinette stitch with white.

Use a separate skein for each of the white sections on the sides (two strands of yarn!)

Work 6 rows in this pattern and continue throughout the rest of the back panel.

In the 7th row, cast off 30 sts in the middle of the work and separate the work for the shoulder sides.

Continue changing color according to pattern until the whole back panel has a length of 36 (38) 42 (43) cm / 14" (15") 16,5" (17")

Cast off all sts.

Finish the other shoulder side in the same way.

FRONT PANEL

Work the front panel in the same way as the back panel, until your piece has a length of 30 (32) 36 (37) cm / 12" (12,6") 14,2" (14,6"), then work the neckline for the front panel and the shoulders in the same way as the back panel.

The front panel is nearly identical, the only difference is that you start to work the neckline and the shoulders a little earlier.

When the panel has a total length of 36 (38) 42 (43) cm / 14" (15") 16,5" (17") cast off all sts.

SLEEVES

CO 39 (39) 43 (43) sts using straight needles 5,0 mm (US 8), and work 6 rows in garter stitch with pink.

Continue with white in stockinette stitch, increasing with 1 stitch on each side (at the beginning and end) of the 1st row on the right side.

Then increase 2 (2) 4 (4) times with one stitch on each side in every 4th row.

When your piece has a length of 11 (11) 13 (13) cm / 4,3" (4,3") 5,1" (5,1") in total, cast off all sts.

Make a second sleeve.

CROCHET FLOWER

Make four flowers

CO 4 chain stitches in pink with crochet hook 4,5 mm (US 7) and close with a slip stitch to form a ring. Work 10 single crochets in the ring.

Work one single crochet in the first single crochet of the last round, and in the second single crochet from the past round work the following double crochet combination: 1 half double crochet, 2 double crochet, 1 half double crochet

Continue, and alternate between working 1 single crochet and the double crochet combination in the sts of the previous round. After the 6th double crochet combination, close the round with a slip stitch, and pull the thread through. Sew up all threads.

FINISHING TOUCHES

Close the shoulder seams.

Sew the sleeves on by placing the middle of the sleeves to the middle of the shoulders and insert in half over the front and back section.

Sew all other seams together (sides and sleeves) and sew up all threads.

Sew on the flowers on the bottom right corner on the front panel according to your own wishes.
