



KNITTING PATTERN

Betty

Bag

MATERIALS


1 skein of Limonata, col Orange (04) Col A
1 skein of Limonata, col Light Gray (12) Col B

Circular needles *or* straight needles size 5 mm

Circular needles *or* double pointed needles size 4 mm

Lobster lock with d-ring, 48 mm, col Gold
Yarn needle

YARN QUALITY

 **Limonata**, Hobbii
52% recycled cotton, 48% recycled polyester
50 g = 135 m

GAUGE

10 x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 19 sts x 29 rows
(Using needles size 5 mm)

ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit
P = purl
CO = cast on
BO = bind off
col = color
st(s) = stitch(es)

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Length: 18 cm (7")

Width: 18 cm (7")

Betty is a fun and beginner friendly little bag, worked in two colors of Limonata.

TIPS AND INFO

The bag is worked in two separate pieces, which are then joined. If you want a larger bag, you can cast on more stitches and make the pieces longer as you wish but keep the size of the handles the same.

BAG

With needles size 5 mm, CO 35 sts using col A.

Work back and forth in stockinette stitch for 15 cm (6 inches).

BO sts for handles (from the right side of work): k7, BO 21 sts, k7.

On the next row, p7, CO 21 sts using the backwards loop method, p7.

Continue in stockinette stitch until work measures 18 cm (7 inches)

BO on a knit row. Make the other piece the same way using color B.

JOINING

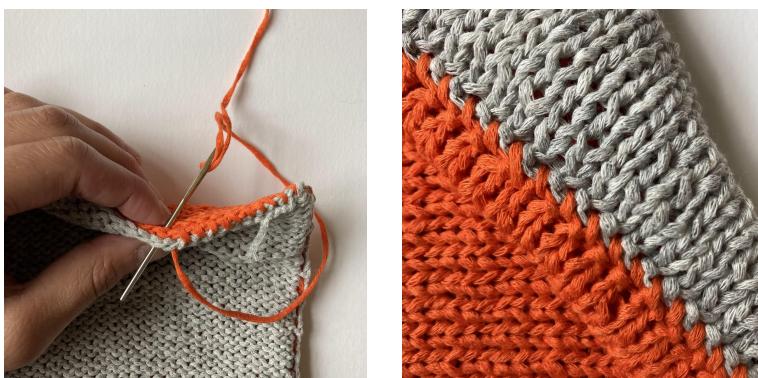
With col A

You will start by joining the sides, using mattress stitches (sew from the right side with the two pieces lined up next to each other).



Pictures: Seaming the sides together.

Then turn work inside out and sew together at the bottom.



Pictures: Sewing the bottom, finished seam from right side of work.

STRAP

With needles size 4 mm and col A, CO 6 sts. Make sure you have a yarn tail of approx. 10-15 cm/ 4-6 inches for seaming later.

Work 9 rows of stockinette stitch.

Increase 1 st in the middle of your row and continue in garter stitch approx. 38 cm/ 15 inches (approx. 130 rows).

Change to col B and continue in garter stitch approx. another 38 cm/ 15 inches (approx. 130 rows). On the next row work 2 sts together in the middle of the row. Work 9 rows of stockinette stitch and bind off leaving approx. 10-15 cm/ 4-6 inches for seaming.

Attach the lobster locks to each end of the strap by folding the part in stockinette stitch around the rings and using the yarn tails for sewing.

FINISHING

Attach the D-rings to the top of the side seam in each side (sew one ring with col A and one with col B). Sew with 8-9 tight stitches around each ring.

Attach the strap to the D-rings and weave in the ends.

Your bag is now finished :)
