Margalida

Dress


Design: Knit Gang | Hobbii Design

MATERIALS

2 skeins of Twister Solid color 110
2 skeins of Twister Solid color 121

Crochet hook 4 mm (US G-6)
Yarn sewing needle

YARN QUALITY

 **Twister Solid**, Hobbii
55% cotton, 45% acrylic
100 g (3.5 oz) = 400 m (437 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 18 sts x 10 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain
sc = single crochet
hdc = half double crochet
dc = double crochet
dc2tog = 2 dc together
sl st = slip stitch
flo = front loop only
blo = back loop only

SIZE

S (M) L

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 45 (50) 55 cm / 17.7" (19.6") 21.6"
Length: 74 (78) 80 / 29.1" (30.7") 31.4"
or as desired

PATTERN INFORMATION

A unique summer dress with a loose fit, very comfortable and cute at the same time.
Very easy to make.

INFO AND TIPS

The dress consists of two pieces sewn together. It is made from the bottom up. Make each piece from separate skeins. You can easily change the dress measurements by adding or deducting sts and rows.

BODY

BACK PIECE

Ch 84 (94) 102, work dc to the end of the row starting from the 3rd st from the hook = 83 (93) 101 sts.

Attach a second color and work 1 dc in each st.

Continue alternating colors until the piece measures the desired length.

Make sure that the number of sts in a row is always the same.

Fasten off.

FRONT PIECE

Work like the back until the piece measures 50 (53) 55 cm / 19.6" (20.8") 21.6".

Then, divide the front into two parts, i.e., work 41 (46) 50 dc on the one side and 41 (46) 50 dc on the other side with 1 st left between the parts. Work 13 rows on every side, and then start forming the neckline by decreasing the number of stitches as follows:

decrease only on the neckline side, by working dc2tog, dc2tog, dc2tog, dc to the end x 8 rows.

Then, work the dc rows straight through on both parts until you get exactly the same length as the back.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Sew the shoulders with sc on the wrong side of the dress.

Next, sew the sides of the dress together with a needle and yarn using an invisible (mattress) stitch, leaving about a 20 cm / 7.8" opening for the arms.

It's up to you what color you finish with, I finished with a light color.



Attach the yarn to the armhole and make one round with sc, then attach the thread again to the sc in the middle of the armhole and do a lace as follows: *in **blo**, 3 hdc in the same st, sl st in the next one* repeat from * to * to the half of the other side. Repeat on the other armhole.

Finish the neckline in the same way, so work one round with sc all over the neckline, the cut-in, and on the back. Next, make the lace on the neckline only, in the same way as on the armholes except that in **flo**.

Make two tassels, attach the yarn at the top of the indentation, to the row before the sts decrease and ch 40. Attach the tassel at the end of the chain, and weave the end. Repeat on the other side.

Weave all the ends and you are done!
