

## MATERIALS

4 skeins of Metallico color Jeans Blue, 16

Crochet hook 5 mm (US H/8)
Yarn needle

## YARN QUALITY

## (63(3) Metallico, Hobbii

70\% Polyamide, 21\% Acrylic, 9\% Wool
$50 \mathrm{~g} / 1.75 \mathrm{oz}=115 \mathrm{~m} / 126 \mathrm{yds}$

## GAUGE

$8 \mathrm{~cm} \times 8 \mathrm{~cm}\left(3^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}\right)=11$ sts $\times 8$ rows within pattern

## ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain
sl st = slip stitch
st(s) = stitch(es)
$\mathrm{sc}=$ single crochet
dc = double crochet
fptr $=$ front post treble crochet
blo = back loop only

## SIZE

One size

## MEASUREMENTS

Width: $10 \mathrm{~cm} /$ 4" $^{\prime \prime}$
Length: $80 \mathrm{~cm} / 31.5^{\prime \prime}$
Circumference: $160 \mathrm{~cm} / 63^{\prime \prime}$

## PATTERN INFORMATION

This is a textured infinity scarf that is worked in a long tube and then the first and last rounds are seamed together to form the loop.

## INFO AND TIPS

This scarf is worked in TURNED rounds.
Beginning round chains do not count as a stitch.
Join each round with a sl st to the first st in that round.
This pattern uses a variation of the Alpine Stitch.

## SCARF

Ch 28, join.
Round 1: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join, do not turn - 28 sc
Round 2: Ch 1 blo sc in each st around, join, turn - 28 sc
Round 3: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join, turn - 28 sc
Round 4: Ch 2, dc in first, fptr around next st 2 rows below, *dc in next, fptr around next st 2 rows below* repeat from *_* around, join, turn $-14 \mathrm{dc}, 14 \mathrm{fptr}$
Round 5: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join, turn - 28 sc
Round 6: Ch 2, fptr around first st 2 rows below, dc in next, *fptr around next st 2 rows below, dc in next* repeat from *_* around, join, turn - 14 fptr, 14 dc
Round 7: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join, turn - 28 sc
Round 8: Ch 1 blo sc in each st around, join, turn - 28 sc
Round 9: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join, turn - 28 sc
Round 10: Ch 2, dc in first, fptr around next st 2 rows below, *dc in next, fptr around next st 2 rows below* repeat from *_* around, join, turn - $14 \mathrm{dc}, 14 \mathrm{fptr}$
Round 11: Ch 1, sc in each st around, join, turn - 28 sc
Round 12: Ch 2, fptr around first st 2 rows below, dc in next, *fptr around next st 2 rows below, dc in next* repeat from *_* around, join, turn - 14 fptr, 14 dc
Rounds 13-168 : Repeat Rounds 7-12.
Fasten off a $61 \mathrm{~cm} / 24^{\prime \prime}$ tail for seaming. With a yarn needle and tail, seam the last round and the first round together. Weave in ends.
