Crochet hook 5 mm (US H/8)
Tapestry needle
Tape measure
Scissors
2 stitch markers

YARN QUALITY

Tweed Delight, Hobbii
85% Wool, 10% Acrylic, 30%, 5% Viscose
50g = 100m

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm $(4'' \times 4'')$ = 13 sts x 8 rows of dc

INFO AND TIPS

This pattern is split into sections for the main body, based on the size you are making, so make sure you follow the right instructions. If you are printing this you won't need to print every page! You can scroll down to the bottom to see photos of how to construct it.

When changing color a lot for the beginning of the sunset I like to float my yarns along the back to save weaving in extra ends. A good way to do this is to cut a long length for each color you need in that row, and as you change color leave that long length so that next time you need it in the row above you can pick that same yarn back up.

Body Panel

Ribbing: With your Ivory yarn and 5mm hook chain 59/65/73/79/85/91/97/103.

R1: Dc in the 3rd ch from the hook and back to the start. 58/64/72/78/84/90/96/102.

R2: Turn, ch2, fpdc in the first st and bpdc in the second. Do this alternating fp and bp stitches until you reach the end. 58/64/72/78/84/90/96/102

R3: Ch2, turn, and repeat post sts (fp in a fp and bp in a bp) to the end again. 58/64/72/78/84/90/96/102

R4: Ch2, turn and sc in each st until the end. 58/64/72/78/84/90/96/102. (Please note: it won't measure wide enough yet but keep going, once you're making the sunset it should be an accurate width!).

Move on to the next step, making sure to follow the instructions for the correct size.



SIZE XS

Swap from the ivory neon yarn to your Amber yarn and ch2. We will now be creating the sun so there will be a lot of color changing. I like to float my yarns across the back of my piece but this can sometimes be tricky, so you may wish to cut your yarn each time you change color and just weave in all the ends when you have finished the panel.

Row 1: (Your ch2 will never count as a st).

Dc in the first 6 sts, then change to your Dijon yarn (I like to change color as I'm making the final part of the dc and pulling the last loop through). Make 46 dc in the next 46 sts, then swap back to Amber for the final 6 sts. For this row and every row your st count will be 58. Turn and ch2.

Row 2: Repeat row 1 with 6 Amber sts, 46 Dijon sts and 6 Amber sts before turning and ch2 again. From here you will follow the instructions below, changing color where necessary.

Geranium = G Rose = R Amber = A Dijon = D

All sts are dc

Front shoulders: Row 1: 16dc, 26sc, 16dc, ch2 turn

Row 2: Repeat Row 1 then fasten off

Move on to 'Join together all Sizes'

SIZE S

Swap from the ivory neon yarn to your Amber yarn and ch2. We will now be creating the sun so there will be a lot of color changing. I like to float my yarns across the back of my piece but this can sometimes be tricky, so you may wish to cut your yarn each time you change color and just weave in all the ends when you have finished the panel.

Row 1: (Your ch2 will never count as a st).

Dc in the first 6 sts, then change to your Dijon yarn (I like to change color as I'm making the final part of the dc and pulling the last loop through). Make 52 dc in the next 52 sts, then swap back to Amber for the final 6 sts. For this row and every row your st count will be 64. Turn and ch2.

Row 2: Repeat row 1 with 6 Amber sts, 52 Dijon sts and 6 Amber sts before turning and ch2 again. From here you will follow the instructions below, changing color where necessary.

Geranium = G Rose = R Amber = A Dijon = D

All sts are dc

Row 2: Repeat Row 1 then fasten off

Move on to 'Join together all Sizes'

SIZE M

Swap from the ivory neon yarn to your Amber yarn and ch2. We will now be creating the sun so there will be a lot of color changing. I like to float my yarns across the back of my piece but this can sometimes be tricky, so you may wish to cut your yarn each time you change color and just weave in all the ends when you have finished the panel.

Row 1: (Your ch2 will never count as a st).

Dc in the first 6 sts, then change to your Dijon yarn (I like to change color as I'm making the final part of the dc and pulling the last loop through). Make 60 dc in the next 60 sts, then swap back to Amber for the final 6 sts. For this row and every row your st count will be 72. Turn and ch2.

Row 2: Repeat row 1 with 6 Amber sts, 60 Dijon sts and 6 Amber sts before turning and ch2 again. From here you will follow the instructions below, changing color where necessary.

Geranium = G Rose = R Amber = A Dijon = D

SIZE L

Swap from the ivory neon yarn to your Amber yarn and ch2. We will now be creating the sun so there will be a lot of color changing. I like to float my yarns across the back of my piece but this can sometimes be tricky, so you may wish to cut your yarn each time you change color and just weave in all the ends when you have finished the panel.

Row 1: (Your ch2 will never count as a st).

Dc in the first 8 sts, then change to your Dijon yarn (I like to change color as I'm making the final part of the dc and pulling the last loop through). Make 62 dc in the next 62 sts, then swap back to Amber for the final 8 sts. For this row and every row your st count will be 78. Turn and ch2.

Row 2: Repeat row 1 with 8 Amber sts, 62 Dijon sts and 8 Amber sts before turning and ch2 again. From here you will follow the instructions below, changing color where necessary.

Geranium = G Rose = R Amber = A Dijon = D

Swap from the ivory neon yarn to your Amber yarn and ch2. We will now be creating the sun so there will be a lot of color changing. I like to float my yarns across the back of my piece but this can sometimes be tricky, so you may wish to cut your yarn each time you change color and just weave in all the ends when you have finished the panel.

Row 1: (Your ch2 will never count as a st).

Dc in the first 8 sts, then change to your Dijon yarn (I like to change color as I'm making the final part of the dc and pulling the last loop through). Make 68 dc in the next 68 sts, then swap back to Amber for the final 8 sts. For this row and every row your st count will be 84. Turn and ch2.

Row 2: Repeat row 1 with 8 Amber sts, 68 Dijon sts and 8 Amber sts before turning and ch2 again. From here you will follow the instructions below, changing color where necessary.

Geranium = G

I like to float my yarns across the back of my piece but this can sometimes be tricky, so you may wish to cut your yarn each time you change color and just weave in all the ends when you have finished the panel.

Row 1: (Your ch2 will never count as a st).

Dc in the first 8 sts, then change to your Dijon yarn (I like to change color as I'm making the final part of the dc and pulling the last loop through). Make 74 dc in the next 74 sts, then swap back to Amber for the final 8 sts. For this row and every row your st count will be 90. Turn and ch2.

Row 2: Repeat row 1 with 8 Amber sts, 74 Dijon sts and 8 Amber sts before turning and ch2 again. From here you will follow the instructions below, changing color where necessary.

Geranium = G Rose = R Amber = A Dijon = D

Row 1: (Your ch2 will never count as a st).

Dc in the first 8 sts, then change to your Dijon yarn (I like to change color as I'm making the final part of the dc and pulling the last loop through). Make 80 dc in the next 80 sts, then swap back to Amber for the final 8 sts. For this row and every row your st count will be 96. Turn and ch2.

Row 2: Repeat row 1 with 8 Amber sts, 80 Dijon sts and 8 Amber sts before turning and ch2 again. From here you will follow the instructions below, changing color where necessary.

I like to float my yarns across the back of my piece but this can sometimes be tricky, so you may wish to cut your yarn each time you change color and just weave in all the ends when you have finished the panel.

Row 1: (Your ch2 will never count as a st).

Dc in the first 8 sts, then change to your Dijon yarn (I like to change color as I'm making the final part of the dc and pulling the last loop through). Make 86 dc in the next 86 sts, then swap back to Amber for the final 8 sts. For this row and every row your st count will be 102. Turn and ch2.

Row 2: Repeat row 1 with 8 Amber sts, 86 Dijon sts and 8 Amber sts before turning and ch2 again. From here you will follow the instructions below, changing color where necessary.

Geranium = G Rose = R Amber = A Dijon = D

Row 29: 102G, ch2, turn Row 30: 102G, ch2, turn Row 31: 102G, ch2, turn Row 32: 102G, ch2, turn Row 33: 102G, ch2 turn Row 34: 102G, ch2 turn Row 35: 102G, ch2 turn

Row 36: 102G, ch2 turn

Row 37: 102G, ch2 turn

Row 38: 102G, ch2 turn

Row 39: 102G, ch2 turn

Row 40: 102G, ch2 turn

Row 41: 102G, ch2 turn but do not fasten off

For your front panel follow 'front shoulder' instructions below. For your back panel make another identical body panel but once you have completed row 41 repeat it 2 more times in Geranium so you have another 2 rows of dc, then FO.

Front shoulders: Row 1: 37dc, 28sc, 37dc, ch2 turn

Row 2: Repeat Row 1 then fasten off

Move on to 'Join together all Sizes'

Join Together All Sizes

Lie your front and back panels out with the shoulders touching (and wrong side facing up for both). Use your Geranium yarn to stitch them together across the dc from your front panel (so 16/19/23/26/29/32/34/37) on each shoulder, then fo and weave in your ends.

Neckband All Sizes

Join your Ivory yarn in any dc along the back of the neck and ch2.

Row 1: Dc in the next st and each st around, then sl st into the top of your ch2. Do not turn.

Row 2: Ch2, repeat row 1 then fasten off.

Sleeves All Sizes

These are worked flat and then sewn on. There are 2 sizes, once sewn on, the smaller measures 17.5cm / 7 inches width when laid flat, by 42cm / 16.5 inches long and the larger measures 18.5cm / 7.3 inches width when laid flat by 45cm / 18 inches. Choose whichever you prefer. Take your ivory yarn (leave a long tail before your starting slip knot (you will use this later to sew the cuff up) and ch 32/34

then in the 3rd ch from the hook dc, and in each st along to the end. (30/32)

Row 1: ch2 and turn, dc in each st (30/32)

Row 2: ch2 and turn, *dc in st, 2dc in next st* repeat until end (45/48)

Row 3: ch2 and turn, dc in each st until end (45/48) then swap to geranium

Row 4: ch2 and turn, dc in each st until end (45/48)



Continue repeating row 4 until your total sleeve length including the cuff is 42/45 cm 16.5/18 inches then fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

Join Sleeves All Sizes

Turn your sweater inside out and use the long tail to sew the sleeve on. Tip - fold the sleeve in half and use stitch markers to mark where the top and bottom of the join should go to keep it even. See photo. Once you have sewn the sleeve on to the arm hole you will need to sew down the length of the sleeve, once you reach the cuff use the Ivory tail to sew this part up,, and fasten off.

Next sew from the armpit down to the waistband to close the side of the sweater (and you will need to sew the waistbands together too).

Weave in your ends, turn the right way around and you're all done!!
