# Beckett 

## Basket Set

## MATERIALS

1 skein of Ribbon 34 Sand (Yarn A)
1 skein of Ribbon 48 Prussian Blue (Yarn B)

Crochet hook 5.5 mm (US I/9)
Stitch marker
Tapestry needle

## YARN QUALITY

(50) Ribbon, Hobbii

100 \% Cotton
$250 \mathrm{~g}=125 \mathrm{~m}$

## GAUGE

$10 \mathrm{~cm} \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}\left(4^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}\right)=14$ sts $\times 10$ rows

## ABBREVIATIONS

beg $=$ begin(ning)
BLO = back loop only
ch(s) = chain(s)
hk = hook
lp(s) = loop(s)
Lsc = Linked single crochet
rep = repeat
Rnd = Round
$\mathrm{sc}=$ single crochet
sl st = slip stitch
st(s) = stitch(es)
yo = yarn over

To work Lsc: Insert hk under left leg of previous st worked, then into next st, yo, pull up look, yo, pull through all 3 lps on hk.

Width: 15.25 (17.75) cm / $6^{\prime \prime}\left(7^{\prime \prime}\right)$
Length: 17.75 (20.3) cm / 7" ( $8^{\prime \prime}$ )
Height: 7.6 (9.5) cm / 3" (3.75")

## INFO AND TIPS

Baskets are worked in the round. Do not join after each round.
All rounds for the sides of the baskets are worked in back loop only (BLO), except the final round.

## SMALL BASKET

## Base

With Yarn A, chain 5.
Rnd 1: Beg in 2nd ch from hook, $3 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{sc}$ in last ch, turning and working into other side of chs, 2 $\mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in same st as 1 st sc , sl st to 1 st sc . (10)
Rnd 2: Work 1st sc in next st after sl st. [2 sc, 2 sc in next st, 3 sc in next st , 2 sc in next st] twice. Note: Place stitch marker in last st and move up with every round. (18)
Rnd 3: 3 sc , [2 sc in next st] twice, $1 \mathrm{sc},[2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st] twice, 4 sc , [2 sc in next st] twice, 1 sc , [2 sc in next st] twice, 1 sc. (26)
Rnd 4: $4 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, $2 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, $2 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, $6 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, $2 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, 2 sc, 2 sc in next st, 2 sc. (34)
Rnd 5: $5 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, $2 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, $1 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, $2 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, $8 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, $2 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, $1 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, $2 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, 3 sc . (42)
Rnd 6: $6 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next $\mathrm{st}, 4 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, $4 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, $10 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next $\mathrm{st}, 4 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, $4 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, 4 sc . (50)
Rnd 7: $6 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, $5 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, $1 \mathrm{sc}, 5 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next $\mathrm{st}, 10 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next $\mathrm{st}, 5 \mathrm{sc}$, 2 sc in next st, $1 \mathrm{sc}, 5 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, 4 sc . (58)
Rnd 8 : $7 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, $5 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, $3 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, $5 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, $12 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, $5 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, 3 sc , [2 sc in next st, 5 sc$]$ twice. (66)
Rnd 9: $8 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, $17 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, $14 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, $17 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next $\mathrm{st}, 6 \mathrm{sc}$.
(70)

## Sides

Rnd 10: (BLO) SI st around.
Rnd 11: (BLO) $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{Lsc}$ around.
Rnds 12-15: Rep Rnds 10 and 11 two more times.

Rads 16-17: Changing to Yarn B, rep Rads 10 and 11 once more. Cut Yarn A.
Rad 18: Rep Rad 10.
Rad 19: Changing to Yarn A, rep Rod 11. Cut Yarn B.
Rad 20: SI st around. Finish off. Weave in ends.

## LARGE BASKET

## Base

With Yarn B, chain 5.
Rad 1: Beg in 2nd ch from hook, 3 sc, 3 sc in last ch, turning and working into other side of chs, 2 sc, 2 sc in same st as 1 st sc , st st to 1 st sc. (10)
Rend 2: Work 1st sc in next st after st st. [2 sc, 2 sc in next st, 3 sc in next st, 2 sc in next st] twice.
Note: Place stitch marker in last st and move up with every round. (18)
Rad 3: 3 sc , [2 sc in next st] twice, 1 sc , [2 sc in next st] twice, 4 sc , [2 sc in next st] twice, $1 \mathrm{sc},[2$ sc in next st] twice, 1 sc . (26)
Rad 4: 4 sc, 2 sc in next st, 2 sc, 3 sc in next st, 2 sc, 2 sc in next st, 6 sc, 2 sc in next st, 2 sc, 3 sc in next st, 2 sc, 2 sc in next st, 2 sc. (34)
Rad 5: 5 sc, 2 sc in next st, 2 sc, 2 sc in next st, 1 sc, 2 sc in next st, 2 sc, 2 sc in next st, 8 sc, 2 sc in next st, 2 sc, 2 sc in next st, 1 sc, 2 sc in next st, 2 sc, 2 sc in next st, 3 sc. (42)
Rad 6: $6 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, $4 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, $4 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, $10 \mathrm{sc}, 2$ sc in next st, $4 \mathrm{sc}, 3 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, 4 sc, 2 sc in next st, 4 sc. (50)
Rad 7: $6 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, $5 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, $1 \mathrm{sc}, 5 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, $10 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, 5 sc , 2 sc in next st, 1 sc, 5 sc, 2 sc in next st, 4 sc. (58)
Rad 8: $7 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, $5 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, $3 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, $5 \mathrm{sc}, 2$ sc in next st, $12 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, 5 sc, 2 sc in next st, 3 sc, [2 sc in next st, 5 sc] twice. (66)
Rend 9: $8 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, $17 \mathrm{sc}, 2$ sc in next st, $14 \mathrm{sc}, 2$ sc in next st, $17 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, 6 sc . (70)

Rad 10: $9 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, $6 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, $3 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, $6 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, $16 \mathrm{sc}, 2$ sc in next st, $6 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, $3 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, $6 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in next st, 7 sc . (78)
Rad 11: 10 sc, 2 sc in next st, 19 sc, 2 sc in next st, 18 sc, 2 sc in next st, $19 \mathrm{sc}, 2$ sc in next st, 8 sc.
(82)

## Sides

Rind 12: (BLO) SI st around.
Rad 13: (BLO) 1 sc, Lsc around.
Rads 14-19: Rep Rads 12 and 13 three more times.
Rads 20-21: Changing to Yarn A, rep Rads 12 and 13 once more. Cut Yarn B.
Rad 22: Rep Rad 12.
Rad 23: Changing to Yarn B, rep Rod 13. Cut Yarn A.
Rad 24: SI st around. Finish off. Weave in ends.
