Beckett

Basket Set

MATERIALS

1 skein of Ribbon 34 Sand (Yarn A) 1 skein of Ribbon 48 Prussian Blue (Yarn B)

Crochet hook 5.5 mm (US I/9) Stitch marker Tapestry needle

YARN QUALITY

Ribbon, Hobbii 100 % Cotton 250 g = 125 m

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 14 sts x 10 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

beg = begin(ning)
BLO = back loop only
ch(s) = chain(s)
hk = hook
lp(s) = loop(s)
Lsc = Linked single crochet
rep = repeat
Rnd = Round
sc = single crochet
sl st = slip stitch
st(s) = stitch(es)
yo = yarn over

To work Lsc: Insert hk under left leg of previous st worked, then into next st, yo, pull up look, yo, pull through all 3 lps on hk.

SIZE

S (L)

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 15.25 (17.75) cm / 6" (7") Length: 17.75 (20.3) cm / 7" (8") Height: 7.6 (9.5) cm / 3" (3.75")

This set of oval nesting baskets is perfect for your kitchen table, bathroom counter, or desk! Beautifully functional, the baskets are created with a linked single crochet stitch that adds a bit of texture and interest, but is still easy to make!

INFO AND TIPS

Baskets are worked in the round. Do not join after each round.

All rounds for the sides of the baskets are worked in back loop only (BLO), except the final round.

SMALL BASKET

Base

With Yarn A, chain 5.

Rnd 1: Beg in 2nd ch from hook, 3 sc, 3 sc in last ch, turning and working into other side of chs, 2 sc, 2 sc in same st as 1st sc, sl st to 1st sc. (10)

Rnd 2: Work 1st sc in next st <u>after</u> sl st. [2 sc, 2 sc in next st, 3 sc in next st, 2 sc in next st] twice. Note: Place stitch marker in last st and move up with every round. (18)

Rnd 3: 3 sc, [2 sc in next st] twice, 1 sc, [2 sc in next st] twice, 4 sc, [2 sc in next st] twice, 1 sc, [2 sc in next st] twice, 1 sc. (26)

Rnd 4: 4 sc, 2 sc in next st, 2 sc, 3 sc in next st, 2 sc, 2 sc in next st, 6 sc, 2 sc in next st, 2 sc, 3 sc in next st, 2 sc, 2 sc in next st, 2 sc, 3 sc in next st, 2 sc, 3 sc in next st, 2 sc, 2 sc in next st, 2 sc, 3 sc in next st, 2 sc in next st, 3 sc in

Rnd 5: 5 sc, 2 sc in next st, 2 sc, 2 sc in next st, 1 sc, 2 sc in next st, 2 sc, 2 sc in next st, 8 sc, 2 sc in next st, 2 sc, 2 sc in next st, 3 sc. (42)

Rnd 6: 6 sc, 2 sc in next st, 4 sc, 3 sc in next st, 4 sc, 2 sc in next st, 10 sc, 2 sc in next st, 4 sc, 3 sc in next st, 4 sc, 2 sc in next st, 4 sc, 2 sc in next st, 4 sc, 50)

Rnd 7: 6 sc, 2 sc in next st, 5 sc, 2 sc in next st, 1 sc, 5 sc, 2 sc in next st, 10 sc, 2 sc in next st, 5 sc, 2 sc in next st, 1 sc, 5 sc, 2 sc in next st, 4 sc. (58)

Rnd 8: 7 sc, 2 sc in next st, 5 sc, 2 sc in next st, 3 sc, 2 sc in next st, 5 sc, 2 sc in next st, 12 sc, 2 sc in next st, 5 sc in next st, 5 sc in next st, 5 s

Rnd 9: 8 sc, 2 sc in next st, 17 sc, 2 sc in next st, 14 sc, 2 sc in next st, 17 sc, 2 sc in next st, 6 sc. (70)

Sides

Rnd 10: (BLO) SI st around.

Rnd 11: (BLO) 1 sc, Lsc around.

Rnds 12 - 15: Rep Rnds 10 and 11 two more times.



Rnds 16 - 17: Changing to Yarn B, rep Rnds 10 and 11 once more. Cut Yarn A.

Rnd 18: Rep Rnd 10.

Rnd 19: Changing to Yarn A, rep Rnd 11. Cut Yarn B.

Rnd 20: SI st around. Finish off. Weave in ends.

LARGE BASKET

Base

With Yarn B, chain 5.

Rnd 1: Beg in 2nd ch from hook, 3 sc, 3 sc in last ch, turning and working into other side of chs, 2 sc, 2 sc in same st as 1st sc, sl st to 1st sc. (10)

Rnd 2: Work 1st sc in next st <u>after</u> sl st. [2 sc, 2 sc in next st, 3 sc in next st, 2 sc in next st] twice.

Note: Place stitch marker in last st and move up with every round. (18)

Rnd 3: 3 sc, [2 sc in next st] twice, 1 sc, [2 sc in next st] twice, 4 sc, [2 sc in next st] twice, 1 sc, [2 sc in next st] twice, 1 sc. (26)

Rnd 4: 4 sc, 2 sc in next st, 2 sc, 3 sc in next st, 2 sc, 2 sc in next st, 6 sc, 2 sc in next st, 2 sc, 3 sc in next st, 2 sc, 2 sc in next st, 2 sc, 3 sc in next st, 2 sc, 3 sc in next st, 2 sc, 2 sc in next st, 2 sc, 3 sc in next st, 2 sc in next st, 3 sc in

Rnd 5: 5 sc, 2 sc in next st, 2 sc, 2 sc in next st, 1 sc, 2 sc in next st, 2 sc, 2 sc in next st, 8 sc, 2 sc in next st, 2 sc, 2 sc in next st, 3 sc. (42)

Rnd 6: 6 sc, 2 sc in next st, 4 sc, 3 sc in next st, 4 sc, 2 sc in next st, 10 sc, 2 sc in next st, 4 sc, 3 sc in next st, 4 sc, 2 sc in next st, 4 sc, 3 sc in next st, 4 sc, 2 sc in next st, 4 sc, 3 sc in next st, 4 sc, 2 sc in next st, 4 sc, 3 sc in next st, 4 sc, 2 sc in next st, 4 sc, 3 sc in next st, 4 sc in next st

Rnd 7: 6 sc, 2 sc in next st, 5 sc, 2 sc in next st, 1 sc, 5 sc, 2 sc in next st, 10 sc, 2 sc in next st, 5 sc, 2 sc in next st, 1 sc, 5 sc, 2 sc in next st, 4 sc. (58)

Rnd 8: 7 sc, 2 sc in next st, 5 sc, 2 sc in next st, 3 sc, 2 sc in next st, 5 sc, 2 sc in next st, 12 sc, 2 sc in next st, 5 sc in next st, 5 sc in next st, 5 s

Rnd 9: 8 sc, 2 sc in next st, 17 sc, 2 sc in next st, 14 sc, 2 sc in next st, 17 sc, 2 sc in next st, 6 sc. (70)

Rnd 10: 9 sc, 2 sc in next st, 6 sc, 2 sc in next st, 3 sc, 2 sc in next st, 6 sc, 2 sc in next st, 16 sc, 2 sc in next st, 6 sc, 2 sc in next st, 7 sc. (78)

Rnd 11: 10 sc, 2 sc in next st, 19 sc, 2 sc in next st, 18 sc, 2 sc in next st, 19 sc, 2 sc in next st, 8 sc. (82)

Sides

Rnd 12: (BLO) SI st around.

Rnd 13: (BLO) 1 sc, Lsc around.

Rnds 14 - 19: Rep Rnds 12 and 13 three more times.

Rnds 20 - 21: Changing to Yarn A, rep Rnds 12 and 13 once more. Cut Yarn B.

Rnd 22: Rep Rnd 12.

Rnd 23: Changing to Yarn B, rep Rnd 13. Cut Yarn A.

Rnd 24: SI st around. Finish off. Weave in ends.
