# Torre

## Beanie

Design: Frosia Knits | Hobbii Design




## MATERIALS

MC: 1 skein of Highland Wool col. 25  
CC: 1 skein of Highland Wool col. 3

Circular needle 3.5 mm (US 4), 40 cm (16")  
Double Pointed Needles 3.5 mm (US 4)  
1 Stitch Marker  
Pom-Pom Maker (optional)  
Tapestry Needle  
Scissors

## YARN QUALITY

 **Highland Wool**, Hobbii  
100 % Peruvian Highland Wool  
50 g (1.8 oz) = 175 m (191 yds)

## GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 28 sts x 36 rows

## ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit  
p = Purl  
CO = Cast On  
st(s) = Stitch(es)  
K2tog = knit two stitches together  
mc = main color yarn  
cc = contrast color yarn

## SIZE

Adult S (M) L

## MEASUREMENTS

Width (flat, measured just above brim): 21  
(24) 25.5 cm / 8.25" (9.5") 10"  
Length (brim unfolded): 19.5 (23) 26 cm /  
7.75" (9") 10.25"

## PATTERN INFORMATION

This knitted beanie with color work is inspired by all of the medieval towers that line the city skylines of the towns in Tuscany, Italy. The beanie is great for all sexes. Happy knitting!

# Pattern



## INFO AND TIPS

This beanie pattern is knit bottom up with a folded, ribbed brim. Make sure not to pull your colorwork too tight but do try and keep an even tension throughout the colorwork section.

## BRIM

CO 120 (136,144) sts using the long tail cast on method. Place marker and join in the round being careful not to twist your sts

Round 1: \*k2, p2, repeat from \* to end of round

Repeat Round 1 until piece measures 3.5 (4, 4.5) inches / 9 (10, 11.5) cm or desired brim length

## BODY

Rounds 1-9: k to end of round

Rounds 10-13: \*k2 in cc, k6 in mc, repeat from \* to end of round

Rounds 14-17: \*k3 in cc, k4 in mc, k1 in cc, repeat from \* to end of round

Rounds 18-21: \*k4 in cc, k2 in mc, k2 in cc, repeat from \* to end of round

Round 22: \*k across in cc, repeat from \* to end of round

Repeat round 22 until piece measures 9 (10, 11) inches / 23 (25.5, 28) cm from CO edge for or desired length

## CROWN DECREASES

Round 1: \*k2, k2tog, repeat from \* to end of round = 90 (102,108) stitches

Rounds 2-3: k to end of round

Round 4: \*k1, k2tog, repeat from \* to end of round = 60 (68, 72) stitches

Round 5-6: k to end of round

Round 7: \*k2tog, repeat from \* to end of round = 30 (34, 36) stitches

## FINISHING

Cut yarn leaving an 8 inches /20 cm tail and thread it onto a tapestry needle. Thread tail through remaining stitches. Pull tight, thread through stitches a couple more times, and bring tail to inside of hat to weave in. Block as desired.

Create and attach a pom-pom if desired.
