Wavy

Children's vest

MATERIALS

Hobbii Acacia

- 1 skein of color Curry (16)
- 1 skein of color Blue (08)
- 1 skein of color Teal (12)
- 1 skein of color Seafoam (14)
- 1 skein of color Mauve Ash (21)
- 1 skein of color Ecru (02)

Knitting needles 4 mm (US 6)
Tapestry needle

YARN QUALITY

-  **Acacia**, Hobbii
- 51% acrylic, 49% cotton
- 100 g (3.5) = 250 m (273 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 24 sts x 32 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

- st/s = stitch/es
- k = knit
- p = purl
- edge st = edge stitch
- k2tog = knit 2 sts together
- CO = Cast On
- BO = Bind Off

SIZE

2-4 yrs (4-6 yrs) 6-8 yrs

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 35 (38) 42 cm / 13.7" (14.9") 16.5"
Length: 36 (39) 42 cm / 14.1" (15.3") 16.5"

PATTERN INFORMATION

A chic and comfortable vest with a fun pattern.
Thanks to the used yarn, it is soft and elastic.

INFO AND TIPS

The vest consists of two parts, front and back, sewn together at the end.

Stitches used in the pattern:

Stockinette stitch: knit in odd rows, purl in even rows

Garter stitch: k in every row

BODY

BACK PIECE

CO 84 (90) 98 sts with yarn in color 16. Knit 8 rows in garter stitch. Then start working in stockinette stitch according to diagram 1. Use a separate thread for each plane of color. Pay attention when changing the color, to cross the threads tightly on the wrong side of the vest to avoid holes.

Once the wave pattern is complete, work straight through until you reach the 65th row counted from the beginning of the stockinette stitch.

Edge-stitch

Work rows 66, 67, 68 (all sizes) as follows: 1 edge st, k5, stockinette stitch, k5, 1 edge st.

Decreasing for the armholes

Row 69: 1 edge st, k5, k2tog, stockinette stitch, slip 1 st, k1, pass the slipped st through the worked k, k5, 1 edge st.

Work the next even rows as row 68 (repeat 10 times).

Work the odd rows with decreases as row 69 (repeat 10 times).

Work the rest of the back piece in pattern: 1 edge st, k5, stockinette stitch, k5, 1 edge st.

In the 97th (107th) 117th row, BO the middle 20 sts for the neckline. Then work the shoulders separately and BO 1 st 4 times in every other row.

Work straight through to the 115th (124th) 134th row. BO the remaining sts on the shoulders.

FRONT PIECE

Work just like the back. On the fourth wave, insert the sailboat pattern following diagram 2.

Start the neckline in the row 93rd (103rd) 113th and work the shoulders separately.

Work through as the back piece to the 115th (124th) 134th row.

BO the remaining sts on the shoulders.

Sew the two pieces of the vest together at the sides and the shoulders on the wrong side.

Neckline

Pick up 150 sts (all sizes). Work 5 rows in stockinette stitch, BO.

Weave in all ends.

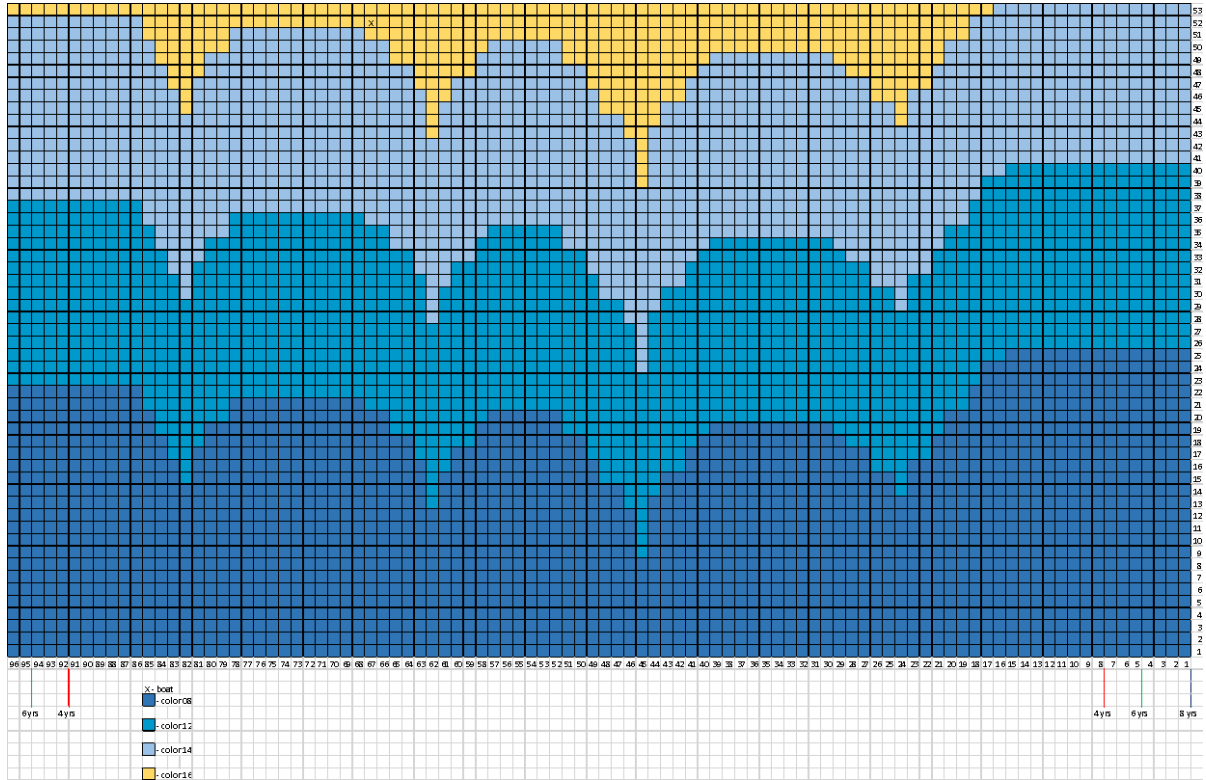
