MATERIALS

1 skein of Kind Feather color 27 – Yarn A 1 skein of Kind Feather color 28 – Yarn B 1 skein of Kind Feather color 4 – Yarn C 1 skein of Kind Feather color 14 – Yarn D

Straight needle 3.75 mm (US 5) Safety eyes 6 mm Polyester filling 2 stitch markers

YARN QUALITY

Kind Feather, Hobbii 100 % Premium Acrylic 100 g (3.5 oz) = 235 m (257 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm $(4'' \times 4'')$ = 19 sts x 30 rows (For the main part)

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Length: 36 cm / 14.17"

PATTERN INFORMATION

Now you can knit the cutest little bear. This sweet bear has removable dungarees, a scarf and backpack. Made in Kind Feather it is soft and cuddly.

ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit

P = Purl

St(s) = Stitch(es)

C/on = Cast on

C/off = Cast off

Dec c/off = Decrease cast off - K2tog from the back of the loop then slip the stitch back to the left needle, repeat to the end of the row

K2tog = Knit two stitches together

P2tog = Purl two stitches together

PM = Place your marker

RM = Remove your marker

SM = Slide your marker

M = Marker

YIF = Yarn in the front of your work

Kf&b = knit in the front and then the back of the same stitch with the yarn at the back of the work

K3tog = Knit three stitches together

INFO AND TIPS

This project is demanding an intermediate level of knitting with different increase and decrease techniques as well as making an Icord.

HEAD

C/on 20 sts with yarn A

Row 1 – (Kf&b) repeat until the end of the row (40 sts)

Row 2 - P row

Row 3 – (K1, Kf&b) repeat until the end of the row (60 sts)

Row 4 - Prow

Row 5 - K row

Repeat the last 2 rows 5 more times

Row 16 - P row



Row 17 - K29, PM, Kf&b, Kf&b, PM, K29 (62 sts)

Row 18 - P row

Row 19 – K up to the first M, SM, Kf&b, K up to 1 st before 2nd M, Kf&b, SM, K to the end of the row (64 sts)

Row 20 - P row

Repeat the last 2 rows 3 more times (70 sts)

Row 27 – K29, RM and attach it to the last st worked to mark the eye placement, K12, RM and attach it to the last st worked to mark the second eye placement, K29

Row 28 - P row

Row 29 - K row

Repeat the last 2 rows 8 more times

Row 46 - P row

Row 47 – (K2tog, K1) repeat until the last st, K1 (47 sts)

Row 48 - P row

Row 49 – (K2tog, K1) repeat until the last 2 sts, K2tog (31 sts)

Row 50 – P row

Row 51 – (K2tog) repeat until the last 3 sts, K1, K2tog (16 sts)

Row 52 - P row

Row 53 – (K2tog) repeat until the end of the row (8 sts)

Thread through the remaining sts, cut the yarn and make secure.

EARS (make 2)

C/on 15 sts with yarn B

Row 1 - K row

Row 2 - P row

Repeat the last 2 rows 2 more times

Row 7 – K2tog, K up to the end of the row

Row 8 - P2tog, P up to the end of the row

Repeat the last 2 rows until you have 9 sts left

Keep these 9 sts on your needle, get the P side facing you and pick up 8 sts with yarn A starting at the bottom left, turn your work and K9 sts from the needle, then pick up 8 sts on the other side down towards the other corner (25 sts).

Continue working with yarn A for the rest of the ear.

Next row - P row

Next row - K row

Next row - P row

Dec c/off the remaining 25 sts, cut the yarn and make secure.

Repeat for the second ear.



BODY

C/on 22 sts with yarn A

Row 1 - Prow

Row 2 – (K1, Kf&b) repeat until the end of the row (33 sts)

Row 3 - Prow

Row 4 – (K1, Kf&b) repeat until the last st, K1 (49 sts)

Row 5 - Prow

Row 6 - K row

Repeat the last 2 rows until your piece measure 11 cm

Now you are dividing the torso to make the legs

Next row - K22, c/off 5, K22

Continue working on the last 22 sts only

** Next row - P row

Next row - K row

Next row - P row

Repeat the last 2 rows 9 more times

Now you are creating the foot

Next row - K16, (TURN, P10, TURN, K10) x 4 TURN, P10

Cut the yarn and re-join to:

Next row – With K side facing you pick up up 5 sts along the new vertical part that you have just created, K10 from the needle, pick up up 5 sts on the other side, K6 from the needle

Next row - P row

Next row - K row

Next row - P row

Repeat the last 2 rows 3 more times

C/off the remaining sts, cut the yarn and make secure, leaving a long tail to sew** Repeat for the second leg from ** to **

ARMS (make 2)

C/on 10 sts with yarn A, leaving a long tail to sew

Row 1 - Prow

Row 2 – (Kf&B) repeat until the end of the row (20 sts)

Row 3 - P row

Row 4 - K row

Row 5 - Prow

Repeat the last 2 rows 2 more times

Row 10 – (K1, K2tog) repeat until the last 2 sts, K2 (14 sts)

Row 11 - Prow

Row 12 - K row

Row 13 - Prow

Repeat the last 2 rows 9 more times



Row 32 – K2tog, K to the last 2 sts, K2tog (12 sts)

Row 33 - Prow

Repeat the last 2 rows until you have 4 sts left

Thread through the remaining 4 sts, cut the yarn and make secure.

DUNGAREES

C/on 26 sts with yarn C, leaving a long tail to sew

Row 1 – (K1, P1) repeat until the end of the row

Row 2 – (P1, K1) repeat until the end of the row

Repeat the last 2 rows 6 more times

Cut the yarn, keep the 26 sts on the needles and start again for the 2nd leg.

Both set of legs should be next to each other but not joined yet (52 sts), the next row will put them together.

Next row – (K1, P1) repeat until the end of the row

Next row – (P1, K1) repeat until the end of the row

Repeat the last 2 rows 15 more times

Next row - Dec c/off 20, K12, dec c/off, cut the yarn

Re-join the middle 12 sts

Next row - P row

Next row - K row

Repeat the last 2 rows 1 more time

You are now going to start the straps for the dungarees

Next row - K3, TURN

Repeat the last row until your strap measure 6cm

C/off the 3 sts, cut the yarn and make secure, leaving a tail to sew to the garment

Re-join your 9 sts on the needle

Next row - Dec c/off 6, P3, TURN

Next row - K3, TURN

Repeat the last row until your second strap measure 6cm

C/off the 3 sts, cut the yarn and make secure, leaving a tail to sew to the garment

POCKETS (make 2)

C/on 16 sts with yarn D

Row 1 - K row

Row 2 - Prow

Repeat the last 2 rows 5 more time



Row 13 – K2tog, K to end Row 14 – P2tog, P to end Repeat the last 2 rows until you have 12 sts left

Dec c/off the 12 sts, cut the yarn and make secure

BACKPACK

BAG

C/on 40 sts with yarn D

Row 1 - K row

Row 2 - Prow

Now we are going to make the holes for the string of the bag

Row 3 - (K2, YIF K2tog, K2, YIF K2tog, K2) x 3

Row 4 – P row

Row 5 - K row

Repeat the last 2 rows 9 more time

Row 24 - Prow

Row 25 - K9, K2tog, K18, K2tog, K9

Row 26 - Prow

Row 27 - K8, K3tog, K16, K3tog, K8

C/off the sts, cut the yarn and make secure

STRING

C/on 4 sts with yarn C

Create an Icord for 40cm

Icord = Knit your row as usual and instead of switching your needles just slip all your stitches back onto your left needle. Then repeat with the next row. If you are working this with DPN you just need to slide all the stitches to the other end of the same needle

C/off the sts, cut the yarn and make secure

SCARF

C/on 6 sts with yarn B

Row 1 - K row

Repeat row 1 until your piece measure 43 cm

C/off the sts, cut the yarn and make secure



FINISHING UP

HEAD - Replace the stitch markers for the eyes with the safety eyes. Join the edges and stuff generously, then close the opening. Embroidered few horizontal line between the eyes for the nose with yarn B then continue with 2 vertical lines down to where the increase of the face started and then add 2 diagonal lines along the increase on each side to form the mouth as per the picture.

EARS - Thread through c/on edge and pull to form a cup and fold the edges in place as per the picture. Finish by sewing both ears at the top of the head as shown in the picture.

BODY - Join the seams of both feet and legs and start stuffing as you go. Continue to the top of the body in the same way. Then sew the head to the body.

ARMS - Thread along the c/on edge and pull to form the hands, then join the seams along the arms and start stuffing as you go. Then attach the arms to the body.

DUNGAREE - Join the seam at the back and the inside of the legs. Then attach both straps at the back of the garment. Add both pockets to each side of the dungarees making sure that they are at the right level for the hands.

BACKPACK – Fold the bag in half and join the back seam, thread the string through the holes and sew the ends at the bottom rear of the backpack.

Weave in all other ends
