# Solstice

Garland

## MATERIALS

Yarn A: 1 skein of Rainbow 8/8, col 02  
Yarn B: 1 skein of Rainbow 8/8, col 05  
Yarn C: 1 skein of Rainbow 8/8, col 06  
Yarn D: 1 skein of Rainbow 8/8, col 20  
Yarn E: 1 skein of Cocktail Deluxe, col "Gold" (17541)

Crochet hook 4 mm (US G/6)  
Tapestry needle  
Stitch markers

## YARN QUALITY

 **Rainbow Cotton 8/8**, Hobbii  
100 % Cotton  
50 g (1.8 oz) = 75 m (82 yds)

 **Cocktail Deluxe**, Go Handmade  
100 % Polyester  
25 g (0.9 oz) = 90 m (98 yds)

## GAUGE

Exact gauge is not essential for this project, just try to keep it consistent throughout.

## ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain  
slst = slip stitch  
sc = single crochet  
dc = double crochet  
tr = treble crochet

## SIZE

One size

## MEASUREMENTS

Finished garland will measure roughly 190cm.

A crocheted winter garland to celebrate the solstice and the return of the light.

# Pattern



## INFO AND TIPS

You will make 2 of each motif, except for the sun of which you will make 3. The embroidered details are optional and all use Yarn E. Weave in the ends as you go, however you may wish to leave one end for attaching the motif to the chain.

## OAK LEAF x2

Using Yarn C, 17ch.

Row 1: 1sl st in the 1<sup>st</sup> ch from hook, 5sl st, 9sc, 3sc in last ch, now working down the other side of your ch, 9sc, 1sl st, ch, turn.

Row 2: \*1sc, 1dc, (1dc, 1tr) in next st, 2sl st along the edge of the tr \* 3 times, (1sc, 1dc) in next st, (3dc in next st), (1dc, 1sl st) in next st, \*2ch, (1tr, 1dc) in next st, 1dc, 1sl st, \* 3 times, ch.

Fasten off. Weave in the ends. Pick out the stem or the edge of the oak leaf in gold using a running stitch or back stitch if you wish.

## SUN x3

Using Yarn A and Yarn E held double, make a magic ring.

Round 1: 12 dc into the magic ring, join, ch. (12sts)

Round 2: 2dc into each st, join, ch. (24 sts)

Round 3: \*(1sc, 1dc) in next st, ch, 2sl st along the edge of the dc you have just made, sl st in next st \* 12 times, ch.

Fasten off. Weave in the ends.

## MISTLETOE x2

Using Yarn D, 23ch.

You will begin by working on the first leaf, 2dc in 1<sup>st</sup> ch from hook, 2dc in next st, 3dc, 3sc. Now you will move on to the second leaf, 9ch, 2dc in 1<sup>st</sup> ch from hook, 2dc in next st, 3dc, 3sc.

Finally you will work on the mistletoe stem, sl st into the next st (this is the 12<sup>th</sup> ch you made at the start), 11 sl st, ch. Fasten off.

### **Berries x6**

Using Yarn A, make a magic ring. 3sc into magic ring. Pull ring tight. Join your last sc to the ch you made at the start, make one more ch and fasten off. Sew in the end catching the stitches as you go around to form a berry shape. Sew on the berries where the leaves meet. You may wish to embroider a dot of gold on each berry.

### **ACORN x2**

Using Yarn C, make a magic ring.

Round 1: 12dc into magic ring, join, ch.

Round 2: 2dc into each of the next 2sts, (2dc, ch, 2dc) in next st, 2dc into each of the next 3sts, 3dc into next st, 2dc into each of the next 3sts, (2dc, ch, 2dc) in next st, 2dc in next st, join, ch. Fasten off. Weave in the ends.

Join Yarn B in one of the ch spaces. You will now work towards the other ch space.

Row 1: 1ch, 1sc in ch space, 10sc, 2sc in ch space, ch, turn.

Row 2: 1ch, miss 2 sts, 9sc, miss a st, slst, ch, turn.

Row 3: 1ch, miss 2 sts, 6sc, miss a st, slst, ch, turn.

Row 4: 1ch, miss 2 sts, 3sc, miss a st, slst, ch, turn.

Row 5: 1ch, miss 2 sts, slst, 4ch, 3sc starting in 1st ch from hook, slst to join.

Fasten off. Weave in the ends. Pick out the edge of the acorn in gold using a running stitch or back stitch if you wish.

### **CHAIN**

Using Yarn A, 321ch. Then, starting in 1<sup>st</sup> ch from hook, sl st into every ch st. fasten off. Weave in the ends.

### **ASSEMBLING THE GARLAND**

Count 40 sts from the end of your chain and place a stitch marker, you will attach your first sun motif here. Then, place 8 stitch markers at 30 st intervals along the chain. The order of the motifs will be: sun/acorn/mistletoe/oak leaf/sun/oak leaf/mistletoe/acorn/sun. Sew the motifs to the chain, replacing the stitch markers.
