#### **MATERIALS**

Col. A: 7 (7) 8 (8) skeins of Woolpower Big (01)

Col. B: 1 (1) 2 (2) skeins of Woolpower Big (22)

Circular needle 7 mm (US 10.75), 100 cm Circular needle 8 mm (US 11), 100 cm Crochet hook 5.0 mm (H/8) Stitch markers Stitching needle

## YARN QUALITY

**Woolpower Big**, Hobbii 100% Wool 100 g (3.5 oz) = 75 m (82 yds)

#### **GAUGE**

10 cm x 10 cm (4'' x 4'') = 11 sts x 15 rows

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

k = knit p = purl sts = Stitch(es) cn = cable needle SI = slip stitch(es) SM = Stitch marker

#### SIZE

S (M) L (XL)

#### **MEASUREMENTS**

Width: 77 (79) 79 (81) cm / 30.3" (31.1") 31.1"

Length: 59 (61) 63 (65) cm / 22.4" (23.2") 24.8"

### **PATTERN INFORMATION**

A super comfortable poncho for the winter months made with 100% wool. It is a simple cable mix pattern knitted worked flat with simple embroidery stitches and crocheting.

**INFO AND TIPS** 

This pattern is worked flat, however it's easier to knit with the long circular needle. To make sure that you don't lose count, highlight your row in the chart as you go.

	RS: Cable 4 back: slip next 2 sts to cn and hold in back of work, k2, then k2 from cn WS: p 4
Slip 3 sts to cn and hold in front of work, p1, k3 from cn	
Slip 3 sts to cn and hold in back of work, p1, k3 from cn	
<b>&gt;</b>	Slip 4 sts to cn and hold in front of work, k4, k4 from cn
>	Slip 4 sts to cn and hold in back of work, k4, k4 from cn



#### **BACK PIECE**

#### Rib edge

Cast on 100 (100) 100 (102) sts on a 7 mm, 100 cm needle Rows 1-4 with color A: k4, rib (1 k, 1 p) until the last 4 stitches, k4 Rows 5-8 with color B: k4, rib (1 k, 1 p) until the last 4 stitches, k4 Rows 9-10 with color A: k4, rib (1 k, 1 p) until the last 4 stitches, k4

Change to 8 mm, 100 cm needle and knit according to chart

#### **FRONT PIECE**

#### Rib edge

Cast on 100 (100) 100 (102) sts on a 7 mm, 100 cm needle Rows 1-4 with color A: k4, rib (1 k, 1 p) until the last 4 stitches, k4 Rows 5-8 with color B: k4, rib (1 k, 1 p) until the last 4 stitches, k4 Rows 9-10 with color A: k4, rib (1 k, 1 p) until the last 4 stitches, k4

Change to 8 mm, 100 cm needles and knit according to chart

#### **NECKLINE SHAPING**

Shape the right side of the neckline first. Continue to follow the chart until cast off. On the Left shoulder, start on the wrong side and follow the chart

#### COLLAR

Change to 7 mm, 100 cm needles and pick up 54 (56) 56 (56) stitches around the collar.

Work the collar in rib sts (1 k, 1 p)

Rows 1-2: Color A

Rows 3-4: Color B

Rows 5-6: Color A

Rows 7-8: Color B

Row 9: Color A

Cast off





#### **FINISHING**

Use the stitching needle and slip in your loose end to finish your garment. Make sure to stitch 3-4cm / 1-1.5 inches away from the knot.

#### **EMBROIDERY**

Use the stitching needle and embroider your cables. Feel free to be creative and do it your way. There are no rules when it comes to embroidery.







#### **SIDE STRAP**

Use crochet hook 5.0 mm (H/8)


- 1. Count 4 diamonds from the shoulder down and start the crochet chain there
- 2. Make a 20 sts chain (or the length you prefer) from the inner side of the garter sts on both the back and front piece










# **SIZE S: FRONT**






# **SIZE M: BACK**






# **SIZE M: FRONT**






# **SIZE L: BACK**






# **SIZE L: FRONT**




