# Bunko

Bloomers

Design: Knit Gang | Hobbii Design




## MATERIALS

2 skeins of Acacia color Seafoam (14)

Knitting needles 4 mm (US 6)  
Tapestry needle  
2 buttons approx. 15 mm (0.6")

## YARN QUALITY

 **Acacia**, Hobbii  
51% acrylic, 49% cotton  
100 g (3.5 oz) = 250 m (273 yds)

## GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 25 sts x 34 rows

## ABBREVIATIONS

st/s = stitch/es  
k = knit  
p = purl  
edge st = edge stitch  
k2tog = knit 2 sts together  
CO = Cast On  
BO = Bind Off  
yo = yarn over

## SIZE

2 yrs (2.5 yrs) 3 yrs

## MEASUREMENTS

Width: 21 (23) 25 cm / 8.2" (9") 9.8"  
Length without suspenders: 18 (20) 22 cm /  
7" (7.8") 8.6"  
Suspenders: 40 / 15.7"

## PATTERN INFORMATION

Cute and comfortable bloomers for the little ones. Thanks to the used yarn it is soft and elastic.

# Pattern



## INFO AND TIPS

The bloomers consist of two parts, front and back, sewn together at the end.

Stitches used in the pattern:

- stockinette stitch: knit on the right side, purl on the wrong side,
- reverse stockinette stitch: knit on the wrong side, purl on the right side,
- seed stitch: single knits and purls worked alternately horizontally and vertically.

## BLOOMERS

The front and the back are made the same way.

CO 52 (58) 64 sts.

Work 10 rows in seed stitch, then work 30 (35) 40 rows in stockinette stitch.

From the 31 (36) 41 row you will start forming the leg opening. To do this, BO first 3 sts, work straight through to the end of the row, turn, BO first 3 sts of the next row. Repeat until you BO sts 6 (7) 8 times in total on each side. Then work 10 rows of the remaining sts.

Make the second piece in the same way.

## FINISHING

Sew the two parts together on the sides. Pick up sts around the leg opening. Work through by increasing in each st. Then work this doubled number of sts- 3 rounds in stockinette stitch and 2 rounds in seed stitch.

BO, and repeat on the second leg opening.

## SUSPENDERS

The suspenders have the same length for all sizes and can be adjusted to the child's height depending on where the button is sewn, can be worn crossed, or straight.

CO 92 sts, work 2 rows in seed stitch.

Row 3: 1 edge st, 5 sts in seed stitch, k2tog, yo, 5 sts in seed stitch, k2tog, yo, seed stitch to the end of the row, 1 edge st.

Rows 4-10: work all sts in seed stitch.

Row 11: BO the first 5 sts, inc every st to the end of the row.

Rows: 12-19: work in stockinette stitch.

Rows 20-21: work in seed stitch.

BO all sts.

Work the second suspender in the same way as the first one, but in the 11<sup>th</sup> row, after BO the first 5 sts, work in **reverse** stockinette stitch.

Sew the bloomers in the crotch, sew the suspenders so that the frill is on the outside, and then, sew the buttons.
